CAMP DIRECTOR



Jason Anderson, Head Coach Eastern Illinois University Panther Baseball heads up this summer's baseball showcases. A former Major League pitcher with 11 years of professional experience, Anderson will begin his eighth year as head coach at EIU. Anderson served three years as the Panthers top assistant.

ACCOLADES:

- Hired as 13th head baseball coach at Eastern Illinois on June 24, 2016
- Begins seventh season at head coach in 2023, 10th season as a coach at EIU
- Won first career game as a head coach on March 5, 2016 with 10-8 (12 inning win) over No. 12 Arkansas
- Won 100th career game as head coach on March 7, 2021 with 14-7 win over Kansas State giving EIU series win over Big 12 Conference team
- Has coached four first-team All-Ohio Valley Conference performers (Jimmy Govern 2017 & 2019), Christian Pena (2019), Trey Sweeney (2021)
- Coached OVC Player of the Year Trey Sweeney in 2021
- Coached All-American Trey Sweeney in 2021, third EIU NCAA Division I All-American selection (first, first-team selection at D1)
- Coached All-American Jimmy Govern in 2019, second EIU NCAA Division I All-American selection
- Coached Trey Sweeney, 2021 1st round MLB Draft Selection by New York Yankees (20th pick overall - EIU's 3rd highest draft selection in history)
- Coached Will Klein, 2020 5th round MLB Draft Selection by Kansas City Royals
- Had two players selected in 2019 MLB Draft (Michael YaSenka 17th round / Jimmy Govern 30th round)
- Has coached seven second-team All-OVC selections
- Has coached three All-OVC Freshman team selections
- Coached Freshman All-American outfielder Grant Emme (2019)
- Has coached seven players who have been drafted or signed free agent contracts with major league clubs
- Has coached six players who signed professional contracts with independent league teams.
- Team ranked fourth in NCAA in home runs in 2017 with 83
- Team ranked in top 50 in scoring offense in 2017 and 62nd in 2021
- Team ranked in the top 35 in NCAA in doubles in 2016
- Team ranked 41st in NCAA in strike outs per nine innings in 2019
- Team ranked 21st in batting average in the NCAA in 2019
- Team ranked in the top 50 for offense in scoring, on-base percentage and slugging percentage in 2019
- Coached team to OVC Tournament appearances in 2018 and 2019
- Coached team to 8-6 record in shortened 2020 season, RPI of 60 (highest in OVC)
- Coached team to 25-23 record in 2021 season giving EIU back-to-back winning seasons

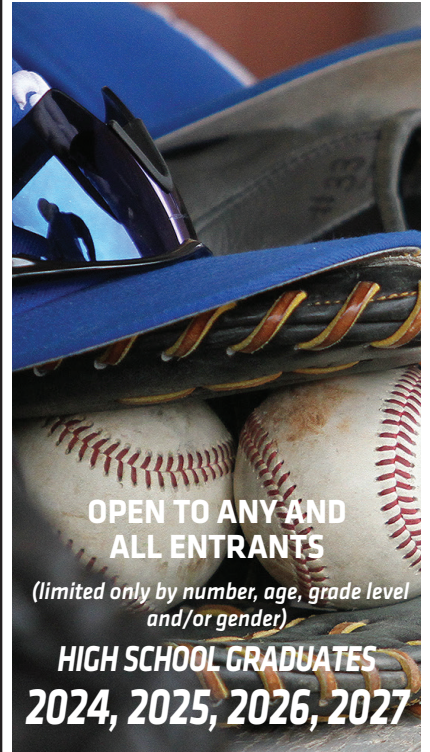

SHOWCASE DATES: TUESDAY, JULY 18 or TUESDAY, JULY 25, 2023 for HIGH SCHOOL PLAYERS ONLY who will graduate in 2024, 2025, 2026, 2027.

REGISTRATION: Registration will be held from 8:15-9:00 am for All Skills and 11:45-12:30 pm for Pitchers at **Coaches Stadium**.

FACILITIES: The **SHOWCASE** will be held on the campus of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Illinois.

MEALS: NO MEALS ARE INCLUDED.

WHAT TO BRING: Bring your position equipment.

SUPERVISION and SECURITY: Adult supervision is provided and includes the following: campus security provided by the EIU Police Department, access to medical attention, certified athletic trainers and lifeguard on duty, professional residential supervision, and attendance checks.

SHOWCASE REGULATIONS: Good conduct is expected of all participants with respect to social and moral responsibilities. General training rules will be in effect for all campers. Any breach in good conduct or training rules (as judged by the Showcase staff) will result in immediate expulsion from camp.

SHOWCASE COST: EACH DAY, EACH CAMP-\$125.00 or \$150 for both camps, each day

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Eastern Illinois Coaches Stadium is located on Highway 16 in Charleston, Illinois. It is approximately six miles from Interstate 57.

FROM INTERSTATE 57: Take exit 190A (Charleston Exit) East towards Charleston. When you get to Charleston, turn right on 4th street. Go through stop sign and turn into parking lot next to softball diamond. Coaches Stadium is approximately one block.
