# Panthers Looking For First Win On The Road At Murray State

#### NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois had its best offensive production of the season on Saturday but two second quarter turnovers cost the Panthers 14 points during a 40-29 loss to Tennessee Tech. EIU dropped to 0-5 on the season, 0-1 in the OVC. The Panthers face a Murray State team that is 2-3 on the year, 0-1 in the OVC after a 40-7 road loss at UT Martin.
- Quarterback Harry Woodbery set a school record for passing attempts in a game as he had 68 passing attempts against Tennessee Tech. The previous record was 61 by Jimmy Garoppolo during the 2012 season against Illinois State. Woodbery completed 34-of-68 for 334 yards and two touchdowns. He did throw one interception.
- Freshman JJ Ross picked off a pass for the second straight week as he came up with one of two turnovers gained by the Panthers defense on Saturday. Ross is now the team leader with two interceptions this season which ranks 48th in the FCS. He is third among FCS freshmen behind Omar Brown (Northern Iowa) and Jaylon Jimmerson (Incarnate Word).
- Eastern Illinois was successful on a two-point conversion in the fourth quarter during Saturday's game against Tennessee Tech. Harry Woodbery connected with Xander Richards for the successful conversion. EIU's last successful two-point conversion was last season against Southeast Missouri with Woodbery hitting Alexander Hollins for two.

#### THE SERIES

• Eastern Illinois and Murray State will be meeting for the 35th time on Saturday afternoon with both teams looking for their first Ohio Valley Conference win of the 2019 season. The Panthers hold a 19-15 all-time series lead with the two teams splitting the last four meetings. Last year Murray State won in Charleston 48-41 as the last three contests have been decided by a touchdown or less. The road team has won each of the last four contests. MSU's last home win in the series was Oct. 23, 2010, a 38-28 victory.

- Eastern Illinois head coach Adam Cushing has had a gambler's mentality on offense this season as the Panthers lead the FCS in fourth down attempts. This season EIU has an FCS high 23 fourth down attempts with 14 successful conversions. The 60.9 percent conversion rate ranks 34th in the FCS. UC Davis is the only FCS team in the nation with 20 or more fourth down attempts this season with 21.
- The Panthers offense has been able to find pay dirt on fourth down this season adding two more fourth down touchdowns to their season total on Saturday. Entering the game against Tennessee Tech, both of EIU's touchdowns this season had come on 4th-and-4 situations. On Saturday against TTU, EIU scored on a 4th-and-5 when Harry Woodbery hit Xander Richards for a touchdown and then on a 4th-and-9 when Woodbery connected with DeWayne Cooks.
- Junior Robbie Lofton finished with a career day against Tennessee Tech as he hauled in ten passes for 124 yards. Lofton became the first EIU player since James Sheehan last season to finish with 100 or more yards. Sheehan had 108 last season against Eastern Kentucky. Aaron Gooch was the last Panther to haul in ten or more passes in a game when he had 11 last year against Southeast Missouri. Lofton is second on the team this season with 20 catches for a team high 209 yards. Entering the game Lofton had 12 career catches for 106 yards.
- Harry Woodbery passed for 334 yards on Saturday against Tennessee Tech as it marked his second career 300-yard passing game and the second straight season that the junior quarterback has passed for 300 or more yards against the Golden Eagles. Last season Woodbery was 32-of-49 for 339 yards and five touchdowns against Tennessee Tech.
- Running back Jaelin Benefield was again a top target for the Panthers offense as the freshman back had eight catches for 69 yards on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. The eight catches were two shy of tying the school record for catches by a running back in a game. Devin Church set that record with 10 catches in the 2015 FCS playoff game against Northern Iowa. Benefield is currently the Panthers leading receiver with 22 catches for 148 yards.
- In addition to catching the ball out of the backfield, Jaelin Benefield was again the Panthers leader on the ground as he finished with 14 carries for 46 yards and two short touchdowns. Benefield has rushed for 153 yards this season with a high of 49 in the season opener at Chattanooga. EIU has now gone five straight games without a 100-yard individual rusher in a game. The last to go over the century mark was Isaiah Johnson with 105 yards last season against Southeast Missouri.
- Eastern Illinois offense ran 94 plays from scrimmage on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. It marked the highest number of plays the Panthers had run since running 96 against Minnesota in the 2014 season opener. EIU has now run 90 or more plays in three of the last four seasons. Last season EIU had 93 plays against Murray State with 92 plays against the Racers during the 2016 season.
- Transfer wide receiver Isaiah Hill was in action for the first time this season on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. Hill, a transfer from South Dakota State, was granted a transfer waiver by the NCAA on Thursday, Sept. 26. He then started as the Panthers kick and punt returner in addition to time at the wide receiver position. Hill had two punt returns for ten yards and one kick return for 26 yards. He caught seven passes for 38 yards with a long of 13 yards.

# **2019 OVC Players of the Week**

- Linebacker Sean Williams had his second straight start of the season and turned in his second big performance. Williams led the Panthers defense with seven tackles including one tackle for loss against Tennessee Tech. The previous week Williams registered nine tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss. Entering the season Williams had been primarily a special teams player with nine career tackles.
- Dytarious Johnson added two tackles for loss to his season total last Saturday as he now has six tackles for loss this season. Johnson is the team leader in that category and ranks third in the OVC. For his career Johnson now has 29 career tackles for loss. He needs three more this season to move into a tie for 9th on the Panthers career list with Kamu Grugier-Hill and Mike Carlin.
- Corneliuss Page picked off a pass on Saturday against Tennessee Tech giving the senior defensive back his third career interception. It was one of two interceptions on the evening for the Panthers defense as they currently rank 22nd in the FCS with five team interceptions. Page's previous interceptions came his freshman year against Austin Peay and sophomore season against Murray State.
- Eastern Illinois forced two turnovers on Saturday against Tennessee Tech as the Panthers had interceptions from JJ Ross and Corneliuss Page. EIU now has six turnovers gained on the season. However the Panthers turned the ball over three times in the game leading to 14 Tennessee Tech points. For the season EIU is at a minus four in turnover margin which has led to 30 points off turnovers for the Panthers opponents (7 UTC / 9 INST / 14 TTU).
- Eastern Illinois run defense held Tennessee Tech to only 51 yards rushing on Saturday night as it marked the second time this season EIU has held an opponent to less than 100 yards rushing in a game. EIU currently ranks 39th in the FCS in rushing defense. The Panthers have only allowed one 100-yard individual rusher this season with Illinois State's James Robinson rushing for 146 yards.
- Senior linebacker Joe Caputo was named a semifinalist for this year's William Campbell Award which is given to the top academic collegiate football player. The 12 finalists for the award will be named later in the football season. Caputo was one of four players from the OVC that were selected. A team captain, Caputo has a 3.89 GPA in accounting. He has missed the last two games due to injury but still ranks fourth on the team with 22 tackles this season.
- After not collecting any sacks in the opening two games this season or the final two games last year, EIU has now collected five in the last three games. On Saturday against Tennessee Tech, Dytarious Johnson and Austin Johnson both picked up sacks for the Panthers. Dytarious Johnson is currently ninth in the OVC in sacks.
- Eastern Illinois continues to be the least penalized team in the OVC as the Panthers rank 23rd in the nation in fewest penalties per game and 19th in fewest penalty yards per game. EIU has been flagged for 25 penalties (5 per game) this season for 203 yards (40.6 yards per game).
- Eastern Illinois pass defense came away with six pass break-ups on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. It was the Panthers highest game total of the season with Mark Williams breaking up two passes. Corneliuss Page is the current team leader for EIU with four pass break-ups as he ranks sixth in the OVC this season in passes defended.

#### EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players this season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. #### MURRAY STATE HEAD COACH MITCH STEWART

When Murray State hired Mitch Stewart as their head coach he became the youngest coach at the NCAA Division I level in 2015. A 2005 graduate of Valdosta State Stewart served four seasons as the offensive coordinator for Murray State under former head coach Chris Hatcher and still runs the up-tempo offense that he learned as a player and assistant coach. Stewart is 17-32 overall, 13-19 in the OVC as the Racers head coach with two wins over Top 25 teams. He is 2-2 against Eastern Illinois.

#### **SCOUTING MURRAY STATE**

Murray State is off to a 2-3 start to the season and 0-1 in the Ohio Valley Conference after a 40-7 road loss at UT Martin last weekend. The Racers two wins this season are over Pikeville College and Morehead State with 59 points of offense in each of those games. Murray State has scored 24 total points in the other three games combined. Quarterback Preston Rice has passed for 1,074 yards with eight touchdowns. Six Murray State receivers have double figure catches this season. Anthony Koclanakis is the leader on defense with 47 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss.

## ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

*Oct.* 5, 1935 - Eastern Illinois opened the season with a 19-6 win over Oakland City College in what would prove to be the Panthers only win of the season. EIU used a balanced scoring attack with all three touchdowns coming in the first quarter on a touchdown pass, end run and fumble recovery.

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

James Robinson scored three rushing touchdowns while the Illinois State defensive line applied pressure all day long on Eastern Illinois quarterbacks as the 12th ranked Redbirds won the 108th Mid-America Classic, 21-3.
