EIU Wraps Up 2019 Season At Austin Peay

Eastern Illinois at No. 20/19 Austin Peay Fortera Stadium (10,000) • Clarksville, Tenn. Nov. 23, 2019 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois wraps up the 2019 season this Saturday as the Panthers play at No. 19 Austin Peay. EIU led No. 15 Southeast Missouri at the half last week but could not hold on as the Panthers dropped to 1-10 on the season, 1-6 in the OVC. Austin Peay enters the weekend tied with SEMO for first place in the OVC standings at 8-3 overall, 6-1 in the OVC. APSU is looking to lock up its first-ever bid to the FCS playoffs.
- Isaiah Hill was named the Ohio Valley Conference Offensive Player of the Week following his efforts against No. 15 Southeast Missouri. Hill hauled in 13 passes for 152 yards and a touchdown. It was the second time this season that Hill has caught 13 or more passes this season and finished with 150 or more yards in a game.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing 12 regular season games this season as the NCAA schedule allows an extra game for FCS schools this year. This is the seventh time in program history that the Panthers have played 12 regular season games. The last time was the 2014 season with EIU posting a 5-7 record, 5-3 in the OVC.
- Corneliuss Page picked up an extra point blocked by James Ubaike in the fourth quarter against Southeast Missouri and returned it the length of the field for a two-point conversion. It marked only the second time in school history that EIU has had a player do that. The first was Bradley Dewberry on Sept. 3, 2015 at Western Illinois.

THE SERIES

• Eastern Illinois and Austin Peay will be meeting for the 20th time this Saturday as the Panthers hold a 15-4 all-time series lead. APSU won two years ago in Clarksville to snap an eight game win streak in the series by the Panthers. EIU has scored 50 or more points in five of its last seven games against APSU including a 52-21 win last season. In the Panthers four all-time losses to the Governors. EIU has scored 13 or less points in each loss.

- Senior linebacker Joe Caputo was named a CoSIDA Academic All-District V selection last week and will now go on the ballot for consideration for Academic All-America honors. This is on the heels of being named one of six Ohio Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete of the Year honorees. Caputo currently has a 3.89 GPA in accounting & finance. He is second on the team with 59 tackles including 11 last week against No. 15 Southeast Missouri.
- Freshman linebacker Jason Johnson has come on as the season has progressed moving up to third on the EIU roster with 52 tackles this season. Johnson has been the Panthers leading tackler in three of the last four games making 36 tackles with 3.5 tackles for loss in those contests. Two weeks ago Tennessee State, Johnson had a sack and forced fumble against the Tigers that set up the Panthers insurance touchdown in the 49-38 win.
- Mark Williams picked off a pass in the first quarter against Southeast Missouri for his first interception of the season. Williams now has six career interceptions as EIU's defense picked off a pass for the third straight game. Williams has seven pass break-ups this season and 22 for his career as he ranks ninth on the Panthers all-time list. Williams needs one more pass break-up to move into a tie for sixth with Terrence Sanders, Ray McElroy and James Dorsey.
- Senior defensive back Corneliuss Page added another pass break-up to his season stat sheet on Saturday as he now has 11 on the season to go with a team high two interceptions. Page currently ranks 27th in the FCS in passes defended this season and second in the OVC. Page now has 18 career pass break-ups. His 11 this season are tied for fifth on the EIU single season list with Rashad Haynes (2009) and Kourtney Young (2001). Ben Brown holds the EIU single season record with 16 during the 2004 season.
- Dytarious Johnson added a half-tackle for loss on Saturday against Southeast Missouri as the junior linebacker leads the Panthers this season with 13.5 tackles for loss to rank 45th in the FCS and third in the OVC. Johnson needs two tackles for loss to crack the EIU single season top ten. Earlier this season he moved into the EIU career top ten for tackles for loss as his 36.5 career TFL rank seventh.
- Raymond Crittenden finished with a season high nine tackles on Saturday against Southeast Missouri as the junior has made the transition from safety to linebacker this year. Crittenden is third on the EIU roster with 52 tackles this year, passing his season total of 51 last year. Crittenden's career high for tackles in a game came last season with 11 against Indiana State.
- Jordan Jackson made his third start of the season on Saturday against Southeast Missouri making one tackle with a pass break-up. Jackson made starts earlier this year against Tennessee Tech and Murray State. Prior to this season Jackson had appeared in 13 career games primarily on special teams. He had five career tackles with two coming last season at Arkansas. This season Jackson has 17 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss.
- A season after earning Freshman All-American honors, Edwyn Brown has battled injuries this season and appeared in only six games. He has been slowly returning to form at his safety position the last two weeks as he had three tackles against Southeast Missouri. The week before at Tennessee State he had an interception that set up an EIU score.
- Senior Terrell Greer will be wrapping up his collegiate career this weekend. Greer was the lone EIU player on the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team being selected at defensive line. This season Greer has been steady in the middle of a defensive unit that ranks 26th in the FCS in total defense. Greer has made 37 tackles with 7.5 tackles for loss.
- Eastern Illinois defense forced a turnover for the eighth straight game as Mark Williams picked off a pass in the first quarter against Southeast Missouri. EIU now has 19 turnovers gained on the season as the Panthers rank 39th in the FCS as a team and fifth in the OVC. Last season EIU forced 15 turnovers to rank 89th in the FCS. The Panthers record for turnovers gained in a season is 52 set during the 1980 season.

2019 OVC Players of the Week

Nov. 10 - Jaelin Benefield (Newcomer) Nov. 17 - Isaiah Hill (Offensive)

- True freshman Jonah O'Brien had his first collegiate action last Saturday against Southeast Missouri as he was called to action early in the second half. O'Brien's first career pass was a 2-yard completion to James Sheehan. O'Brien finished the game 12-of-21 passing for 84 yards. He had one interception in the game on the Panthers final drive.
- Isaiah Hill finished with 13 receptions against Southeast Missouri marking the second time this season that Hill has caught 13 or more passes in a game. Since being granted his NCAA waiver at the start of OVC play, Hill has caught 53 passes for 535 yards and four touchdowns. He currently ranks 24th in the FCS in receptions per game and second in the OVC. Hill would need 12 catches this weekend to crack the EIU single season top ten.
- Senior super back James Sheehan joined a milestone group at Eastern Illinois last Saturday as he became the 33rd player in school history to pass the 1,000 yard mark for career receiving yards. Sheehan now has 95 catches for 1,013 yards. Sheehan was a second team All-OVC selection at tight end last season and needs five catches in the Panthers final game to become the 25th player in school history with 100 or more receptions.
- Freshman kicker Christiaan Masucci remained perfect on field goal attempts this season as he knocked home a 27-yard field goal against Southeast Missouri. Masucci is now 2-of-2 on field goal attempts since taking over place kicking duties. He made a 31-yard attempt at UT Martin. Masucci is also 9-of-9 on extra point attempts this season. Prior to Masucci taking over place kicking duties, EIU was 8-of-10 on extra points and 3-of-6 on field goals.
- Eastern Illinois offense had one of its longest scoring drives in recent memory in terms of number of plays as the Panthers went 65 yards on 21 plays to set up a field goal against Southeast Missouri. EIU's previous longest scoring plays this season had been 13 plays, twice, against Chattanooga and Indiana State. It was only the third time in the last 15 years that EIU has had a scoring drive of 18 or more plays (18 in 2014 vs Murray State and 19 in 2013 vs. Illinois State).
- Eastern Illinois heads into the final weekend of the regular season with freshman Jaelin Benefield the team's leading rusher on the season with 359 yards. Benefield was named the OVC Newcomer of the Week two weeks ago against Tennessee State when he rushed for 105 yards and scored three touchdowns (2 rushing / 1 receiving). Benefield is looking to become the first freshman to lead EIU in rushing for a season since Vincent Webb in 2003.
- Jaelin Benefield also heads into the final week of the season leading the Panthers in scoring this season. Benefield has scored seven touchdowns for a team-high 42 points. Isaiah Hill is second on the team with 38 points with six touchdowns and a two-point conversion. Benefield is looking to become the first freshman to lead EIU in scoring since 2003 when Vincent Webb scored 36 points on six touchdowns.
- Quarterback Harry Woodbery was off to a career day against No. 15 Southeast Missouri before suffering a game ending injury on the final play of the first quarter. Woodbery was 6-of-9 for 118 yards and a touchdown. On the season Woodbery has passed for 1,632 yards and ten touchdowns. He currently has passed for 3,006 yards to rank 15th on the Panthers career list while his 23 touchdown passes are 12th on the EIU all-time list.
- EIU will be facing a ranked FCS opponent for the 94th time when they visit No. 20/19 Austin Peay. EIU is 25-68 all-time in those games. EIU has lost seven straight to ranked teams with the last win over a ranked opponent, Sept. 30, 2017, a 19-16 overtime win vs. Tennessee State. Excluding FCS playoff years this will mark the first time EIU has played nationally ranked teams in back-to-back weeks since the 1992 season (Oct. 24 No. 14 Missouri State & Oct. 31 No. 10 Youngstown State).
- Eastern Illinois offense continues to utilize all four downs as the Panthers were 3-of-6 on 4th down against Southeast Missouri. EIU currently leads the FCS in 4th down attempts having gone for it 48 times. Only Brown and Davidson have had 40 or more 4th down attempts this season with both at 40. The Panthers have been successful 28 times this year with their 4th down conversion rate of 58.3 percent ranking 29th in the FCS.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players this season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. AUSTIN PEAY HEAD COACH MARK HUDSPETH

Mark Hudspeth is in his first season as the head coach at Austin Peay having led the Governors program to a current first-place standing in the Ohio Valley Conference race and a national ranking. Hudspeth is a veteran head coach with stops at ten different schools. He previously served as the head coach at then NCAA Division II North Alabama and FBS member Louisiana Lafeyette. He currently has a 103-62 record in 15 years as a collegiate head coach. Hudspeth was the Assistant Head Coach at Mississippi State last season prior his hiring in Clarksville. He is a 1992 graduate of Delta State.

SCOUTING AUSTIN PEAY

Austin Peay enters in the final weekend of the season with a chance to make program history as a win over EIU would lock up the OVC title and the school's first-ever FCS playoff appearance. The offense has had a balanced attack led by quarterback JaVaughn Craig who has passed for 2,332 yards and 19 touchdowns. DeAngelo Wilson has been the top target with 1,184 yards and 11 touchdowns. Kentel Williams paces the ground game with 773 yards On defense two players have more than 80 tackles on the year but Josephus Smith and Kordell Jackson have standout specialty numbers. Smith has 16 tackles for loss and six sacks. Jackson has seven interceptions.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Nov. 23, 2013 - Eastern Illinois high powered offense ran a program record 112 plays as the Panthers blitzed UT Martin 70-22 to cap an 8-0 run in the Ohio Valley Conference. Jimmy Garoppolo has six touchdown passes as EIU scored 70 or more points in a game for only the third time in program history. The Panthers finished with 704 yards of total offense, the second time during the season EIU has gone over the 700 yard mark in a game.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS
