Panthers Open Cushing Era At Chattanooga

Eastern Illinois at Chattanooga Finley Stadium (20,668) • Chattanooga, Tenn. Aug. 29, 2019 • 6 p.m. • TV: ESPN3

NOTES TO KNOW

- As college football celebrates its 150th season, Eastern Illinois opens its 115th year of collegiate football on Thursday night as the Panthers kickoff the season at Chattanooga with the game televised on ESPN3. EIU has played at the NCAA Division I (FCS) level since the 1981 season and ranks seventh in all-time FCS playoff appearances.
- Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in EIU football history in December of 2018. A long time assistant at Northwestern, he will be coaching his first game as a head coach this Thursday. The last EIU coach to win their head coaching debut was Dino Babers in 2012 with a 49-28 win over Southern Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois will open with three of its first four games on the road and the Panthers have the sixth toughest schedule in FCS as rated by HeroSports. Four teams on the EIU schedule are ranked in the preseason FCS Top 25 with Thursday's opponent, Chattanooga, ranked 30th in the FCS Coaches poll. EIU will also face Big Ten member Indiana in week two.
- Eastern Illinois returns only two starters on offense from last year in second team All-OVC selection James Sheehan and All-OVC Newcomer Team selection Johnathan Brantley. Sheehan ranked first in the OVC for receptions and yards for a tight end. Brantley set the OVC & EIU record for consecutive passes thrown without an interception at 230.

THE SERIES

• Eastern Illinois and Chattanooga will be meeting for the first time on Thursday night as the opening game of a home-and-home series. The Mocs will return to O'Brien Field on Sept. 10, 2022. This will only be the second time EIU has played a Southern Conference member. The Panthers lost at Marshall in 1992. EIU is 4-1 against current Southern Conference member Samford when both schools were members of the Ohio Valley Conference.

- · Senior Terrell Greer was named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team on the defensive line as the Panthers lone representative on the squad. Greer had 48 tackles last season with three tackles for loss and one fumble recovery. Greer has played in all 33 games during his Panther career making 20 starts up front. He had five tackles for loss as a sophomore.
- Linebacker Dytarious Johnson was one of the top play makers in the OVC last season ranking second in the conference with 15 tackles for loss. Johnson was second on the team with 78 total tackles and two forced fumbles. In two seasons, Johnson has 23 tackles for loss and needs just nine this season to join the Panthers career top ten list.
- Senior Joe Caputo led the Panthers in tackles last season finishing the year with 86 tackles. Caputo ranked ninth in the OVC in overall tackles. He added 7.5 tackles for loss and two fumble recoveries. Caputo registered double digit tackles in three games with a high of 13 against UT Martin and Illinois State. He was named to the FCSADA Academic All-Star team following the season.
- Eastern Illinois returns an experienced defense to open the 2019 season as the Panthers have 14 players that started at least one game last season with six of those starting in eight or more contests. EIU returns its two top tacklers from last season and six of its eight top tacklers overall. Those six returning players combined for 368 tackles, 29.5 tackles for loss and five interceptions.
- Edwyn Brown was a second team Freshman All-American last season starting the final eight games of the season at safety. Brown ranked fourth on the team in tackles with 55 while adding 2.5 tackles for loss and two interceptions. Brown is one of two former Freshman All-Americans in the Panthers defensive backfield. Mark Williams earned the honor in 2017.
- Eastern Illinois had two quarterbacks start games last season that both return to the roster this season. Johnathan Brantley started nine games for the Panthers last season passing for 2,016 yards and 14 touchdowns with just two interceptions in 307 passing attempts. Harry Woodbery made two starts for the year passing for 1,374 yards and 13 touchdowns. Both players have been in competition for the starting spot through the spring and fall camp along with Jaylon Banks and Scotty Gilkey Jr. who started five games during the 2017 season.
- Eastern Illinois will have a new look in the backfield as the Panthers top returning rusher from last season is quarterback Johnathan Brantley with 310 yards. EIU's top true running back returning from last year is Robert Columbus with 58 yards. Last season due to some injuries on defense the Panthers converted running backs Darshon McCullough and Courtney Rowell to defensive backs. Both have now returning to running back.
- Darshon McCullough started one game at running back as a sophomore finishing the year with 368 yards on the ground. Last season he rushed for 27 yards and a touchdown before moving to the defensive side of the ball to help with some depth issues. He would end the year as a starter at safety making 13 tackles. McCullough moved back to running back in the spring.
- Eastern Illinois must replace all three starting wide receivers from lat season and four of the Panthers top five pass catchers. The top two returning wide receivers from last season are Matt Reyna and Teriq Phillips. Reyna had 21 catches for 274 yards before missing the last three games to injury. Phillips had 22 catches for 209 yards and a TD.
- James Sheehan was a second team All-OVC selection last season at tight end as he was third on the team in receptions (50) and yards (544). He led OVC tight ends in both categories. This season Sheehan is listed as a Super Back, a description for a combination of positions (TE, WR, FB) developed by the Northwestern football staff.

- Eastern Illinois will be opening the football season on a Thursday night for the 19th time in school history. The Panthers are 11-7 in those previous Thursday night season openers including 10-4 against FCS programs. EIU's last Thursday night opener was two years ago when EIU beat Indiana State, 22-20, with a last second touchdown pass.
- Eastern Illinois will be facing a new head coach for the fifth straight season when the Panthers open the season against Chattanooga and first-year head coach Rusty Wright. EIU played Western Illinois (2015 & 2016) with new coaches each season before facing Indiana State in 2017 and Arkansas last season. This season, EIU also falls in the category of new coach as Adam Cushing begins his inaugural campaign guiding the Panthers.
- Redshirt junior quarterback Scotty Gilkey Jr., was named a nominee for this year's AFCA Good Works Team which recognizes football players for both their community service initiatives in addition to their athletic skill. Gilkey spearheaded a toy campaign to donate to area children during Christmas time in December 2017 & 2018 while adding a backpack & school supply drive at the start of the last two school years.
- EIU graduate transfer Chris Walker is the only player on the Panthers roster from the Volunteer State returning home for the season opener. Walker played at Cornell University and was an All-Ivy League selection as a sophomore. Walker is from Lewisburg, Tenn., which is 50 miles south of Nashville and about 2-hours from Chattanooga.
- Eastern Illinois was selected to finish eighth in the Ohio Valley Conference preseason poll. The Panthers finished in a tie for fifth last season at 3-5 after finishing third in the league in 2017. EIU has won seven OVC regular season titles with the last coming during the 2013 season.
- Eastern Illinois will have a new group of special teams performers as the season opens on Thursday night. Stephen Elmore returns as the Panthers long snapper and Josh Delgado will once again handle kickoff duties. However the role of place kicker and punter has been up for grabs in fall camp. Nick Roessler, a redshirt freshman, is listed as the starting place kicker while Delgado is currently listed as the team's punter.
- In addition to having a new crop of running backs in the Panthers backfield, EIU will also have a new group paving the way up front. The Panthers have two linemen (Cole Hoover and Luther Harris) that started a combined three games last year returning to the group up front. The Panthers brought in eight freshmen to compete with four returning linemen that played primarily on field goal and extra point units.
- Eastern Illinois does regain the services of offensive tackle Aaron Miller. Miller missed all of last season due to injury. Two years ago Miller made nine starts at right tackle helping block for a second team All-OVC rusher (Isaiah Johnson). Miller is the most experienced offensive lineman on the Panthers roster.
- Two starters from last season at the safety position will see the field in a new role this year as Iziah Gulley and Raymond Crittenden shifted to linebacker in spring ball. Gulley made three starts last year at safety finishing the season with 31 tackles. Crittenden made seven starts at safety last season after missing the 2017 season due to injury. He finished the year with 51 tackles to rank sixth on the team.
- The Eastern Illinois coaching staff has a distinct Northwestern feel as eight of the Panthers assistant coaches worked or played for the Big Ten program. Deonte' Gibson and Mark Philmore II were both players at Northwestern while Adam Cushing was on the staff. Chris Bowers, John Kuceyeski, Chris Batti, Dan Hernandez, Neal Renna and Jesse Walton all worked in some capacity with the NU program developing a relationship with Cushing. In addition Director of Football Performance Joe Orozco was on the strength staff with the Wildcats last year when they won the Big Ten West Division championship.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players this season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. CHATTANOOGA HEAD COACH RUSTY WRIGHT

Rusty Wright is in his first season as the head coach at Chattanooga. An alumnus of the program having graduated in 1996, this is his first collegiate head job. In addition to playing for the Mocs, Wright has had two different stints as an assistant at Chattanooga (1996-02 & 2013-16). He most recently was on the staff at Georgia State where he coached inside linebackers and special teams.

SCOUTING CHATTANOOGA

Chattanooga has a new coaching staff as alumnus Rusty Wright takes over a program that was 6-5 last season, 4-4 in the Southern Conference. The Mocs return their top three weapons on offense in quarterback Nick Tiano (2,710 yards passing / 15 touchdowns), running back Tyrell Price (697 yards / 9 touchdowns) and receiver Bryce Nunnelly (79 receptions / 1,237 yards). The defense returns top tackler Marshall Cooper as the linebacker made 98 stops last season.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Aug. 29, 1996 - Eastern Illinois won its second-ever game over an FBS opponent as the Panthers beat Western Michigan, coached by former Panthers head coach Al Molde, 28-20 to open the 1996 season. Mike Simpson passed for 321 yards and four touchdowns. Rodney Wilson led the EIU defense with 11 tackles, two sacks and one fumble recovery.

EIU HEAD COACH DEBUTS

Adam Cushing becomes the 25th head coach to open a season leading the Panthers on the sidelines as the Panthers kickoff the season on August 29. Below are other results from Panther head coaches in their EIU coaching debut over the last 80 years.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS
