EIU Hosts Nationally Ranked SEMO For Senior Day

Eastern Illinois vs. Southeast Missouri O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. Nov. 16, 2019 • 12 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois picked up its first win of the 2019 season last Saturday at Tennessee State as the Panthers rallied from a halftime deficit to win 49-38. EIU improved to 1-9 on the season, 1-5 in the OVC. The Panthers host Southeast Missouri which is currently tied for first in the OVC race with a 5-1 record. SEMO is 7-3 overall.
- Jaelin Benefield was named the Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week following his efforts in the win at Tennessee State. Benefield rushed for 105 yards while catching four passes for 32 yards. Benefield had three touchdowns (2 rushing / 1 receiving) in the game as he now leads EIU in scoring with 42 points.
- Darshon McCullough heads into the final two games of his Eastern Illinois career on a high note after rushing for a career high 155 yards in the win at Tennessee State. It was the first time in his career McCullough had gone over 100 yards in a contest. His previous high was 94 yards as a sophomore (2017) against Murray State. McCullough now has 773 career rushing yards with five touchdowns.
- Freshman linebacker Jason Johnson had a big day for the Panthers at Tennessee State as he finished with a team high nine tackles. Johnson would add a sack and forced fumble in the fourth quarter which EIU converted into an insurance touchdown. He also had a fumble recovery. Johnson has made three straight starts and has 40 tackles this season.

THE SERIES

• Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri will be meeting for the 27th time on Saturday afternoon with the Redhawks in the hunt for a second straight FCS playoff appearance. EIU leads the all-time series 18-8 but SEMO won last year in Cape Girardeau 38-32. The Panthers have won four straight at home in the series and are 11-1 all-time at home against the Redhawks. SEMO's lone win in Charleston was in 2010, a 28-13 victory.

- Eastern Illinois had two running backs finish with more than 100 yards rushing in a game for the 23rd time in school history as Darshon McCullough (155) and Jaelin Benefield (105) both cracked the century mark. The last time EIU had two backs over 100 yards in the same game was Sept. 24, 2016 against Austin Peay with Devin Church (139) and Christopher Anderson (129).
- Dytarious Johnson was all over the field at Tennessee State as he finished with seven tackles in the contest. Johnson also tipped a pass that was intercepted by Edwyn Brown and forced two TSU fumbles. Johnson ranks fourth in the FCS this season in forced fumbles with four and has eight career forced fumbles to rank fourth on the Panthers career list. Johnson is already eighth on the career tackles for loss list with 36 including 13 this season.
- Mark Williams broke up a pass in the end zone on Saturday at Tennessee State as the junior moved into a tie for ninth on the EIU career list with 21 pass break-ups. He joins Antonie Johnson and Jeff Mills in that slot. Williams is second on the EIU team this season with six pass break-ups. His teammate Corneliuss Page has 10 pass break-ups and ranks 31st in the FCS in passes defended.
- James Sheehan moved closer to joining a career list at EIU as the senior super back had five catches for 46 yards and two touchdowns at Tennessee State. Sheehan has 986 career yards and needs 14 more to become the 33rd player in EIU history with 1,000 career receiving yards. He has 92 career receptions and needs eight catches to become only the 25th player in school history with 100 receptions.
- Eastern Illinois fourth down mentality continued on Saturday at Tennessee State as the Panthers were successful on four out of five opportunities including a 45-yard Jaelin Benefield touchdown from the wildcat formation for EIU's first score. On the season EIU has attempted and converted more fourth down chances than any other FCS school going 25-of-42. Davidson is the only other FCS school with 20 or more successful conversions (22) and no other team has 40 or more attempts.
- Eastern Illinois played turnover free football at Tennessee State with 79 offensive plays and 36:50 in time of possession. EIU had its best offensive performance of the season finishing with 490 yards of total offense. It was the third time this season that EIU had played a turnover free game. The Panthers did not commit any turnovers at Indiana or against Illinois State.
- While EIU's offense did not turn the ball over against Tennessee State, the Panthers defense was effective with three turnovers gained with two fumble recoveries and an Edwyn Brown interception. EIU now has 18 turnovers gained this season which ranks 30th in the FCS and fourth in the OVC. EIU has now forced at least one opponent turnover in seven straight games.
- Eastern Illinois had a rare onside kick at Tennessee State as the Panthers attempted and successfully completed the onside kick with five seconds remaining in the third quarter and EIU trailing 38-35. Josh Delgado would kick the ball 11 yards and Charles Shelton recovered the onside kick with no TSU players near the play. EIU's last successful onside kick was in the 2018 season finale at Southeast Missouri when Camden Meade recovered one of two attempts by the Panthers.
- Eastern Illinois defensed stepped up in the third and fourth quarters of the win at Tennessee State. The Panthers allowed only three points in the second half and 62 yards of offense. In the fourth quarter EIU limited TSU to negative ten yards of total offense. At the end of the day EIU held TSU to just 97 yards rushing as the Panthers now rank 31st in total defense. EIU has held three opponents under 100 yards rushing this season with a low of 51 yards by Tennessee Tech. The Panthers have held two teams under 50 yards passing with a low of 14 yards by Eastern Kentucky.
- Harry Woodbery was 21-of-34 for 206 yards and three touchdowns as he played his second straight game without a turnover. Woodbery has now thrown for 1,514 yards and nine touchdowns this season. For his EIU career the signal caller has passed for 2,888 career yards and 22 touchdowns. Woodbery ranks 15th on the career passing yards list and 14th on the career touchdown passes list. He needs three more touchdown passes to tie Jalen Whitlow for tenth with 25.
- Christiaan Masucci was successful on all seven extra point attempts at Tennessee State as the freshman is now 8-of-8 on extra points this season. He also made his lone field goal attempt of the season at UT Martin when he took over place kicking duties. EIU had been 8-of-10 on extra point attempts and 3-of-6 on field goals.
- EIU will be facing a ranked FCS opponent for the 93rd time when they host No. 15/17 Southeast Missouri. EIU is 25-67 all-time in those games but the Panthers have fared better at home with an 18-25 record against ranked opponents at O'Brien Field. EIU has lost six straight to ranked teams with the last win over a ranked opponent, Sept. 30, 2017, a 19-16 overtime win vs. Tennessee State.

• Eastern Illinois will have 13 players dressing for the final time at O'Brine Field today as the Panthers host Southeast Missouri for senior day. EIU is 5-2 in its last seven senior day games including two straight wins in 2017 and 2018.

#3 Corneliuss Page - (6-1, 165, CB, Camden, Ark.)

Five-year member of team... has played in 39 career games... has 28 tackles this season with three tackles for loss... ranks 31st in FCS in passes defended with 12 (2 INT / 10 PBU)...

#13 Chris Walker - (6-1, 210, RB, Lewisburg, Tenn.)

Joined team as a graduate transfer... played in nine games this season... ranks second on team with 261 rushing yards... had one touchdown... ten receptions for 26 yards...

#24 Darshon McCullough - (5-9, 190, RB, Chicago, III.)

Four-year member of team... has started at both running back and safety during Panther career... rushed for career high 155 yards at Tennessee State last week... has 773 career rushing yards and five touchdowns... 14 career tackles...

Two-year member of team after transferring from Concordia College Chicago... has been on special teams both seasons serving on kickoff coverage and kickoff return...

Four-year member of team... has played on both offense and defense as running back and safety... has time on special teams unit... 96 career rushing yards and 63 career receiving yards...

#45 Joe Caputo - (6-2, 235, LB, Mount Prospect, III.)

Five-year member of team... recently named OVC Academic Scholar-Athlete Award winner... led team in tackles as a junior... team captain... has 214 career tackles with 18 career tackles for loss... 48 tackles this season...

#48 Alex Smith- (6-2, 225, SB, Pompano Beach, Fla.)

Four-year member of team... has played super back on offense and on special teams units... has two career receptions for 12 yards... has made one special teams tackle...

#54 BJ Ojo - (6-3, 215, LB, Houston, Texas)

Two-year member of team after transferring from Riverside City College... has played on defense and special teams units... has 11 career tackles with one tackle for loss and two forced fumbles...

#60 Aaron Miller - (6-5, 290, OL, Kaneohe, Haw.)

Four-year member of team... started at offensive tackle as a redshirt freshman before missing 2018 season with injury... started three games at offensive tackle this season...

#68 Luther Harris - (6-6, 375, OL, Oklahoma City, Okla.)

Four-year member of team... played in four games in 2018 before suffering season ending injury... has not played due to injury in 2019... has appeared in 25 career games...

#86 James Sheehan - (6-3, 220, SB, Flossmoor, III.)

Five-year member of team... second team All-OVC selection in 2018 leading OVC tight ends in receptions and yards... has 92 career receptions for 986 yards and five touchdowns... needs 14 yards to become 33rd EIU player with 1,000 career receiving yards... team captain...

#93 Ronell Deo - (6-2, 265, DL, Elk Grove, Calif.)

Three-year member of the team after transferring from Sierra College... has appeared in 16 career games with two starts... has 13 carer tackles with a half tackle for loss and one pass break-up...

#96 Terrell Greer - (5-10, 305, DL, Chicago, III.)

Four-year member of team... starter at defensive tackles and nose guard during career... preseason All-OVC defensive line in 2019... has played in 42 games with 130 career tackles, 16.5 tackles for loss and two blocked kicks... team captain...

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players this season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. SOUTHEAST MISSOURI HEAD COACH TOM MATUKEWICZ

Tom Matukewicz is in his sixth season as the head coach at Southeast Missouri with the Redhawks currently tied for first in the OVC standings after making the FCS playoffs last season.. In his first season the Redhawks climbed into the national rankings following two early Top 20 upset wins but finished the season 5-7. Matukewicz was a long time assistant coach as a member of head coach Jerry Kill's staff at both Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois. He was the defensive coordinator at Toledo for two seasons before taking over at SEMO. Matukewicz is a 1997 graduate of Fort Hays State in Kansas. He is 31-37 overall, 23-22 in the OVC.

SCOUTING SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Southeast Missouri enters the final two weeks of the regular season in a tie for first place in the Ohio Valley Conference standings. SEMO was an at-large selection for the FCS playoffs last season and is nationally ranked this year. The Redhawks are led by returning Buck Buchanan Award winner Zach Hall with 91 tackles. Justin Swift has also made an impact on defense with 11 tackles for loss as the Redhawks have forced 20 turnovers. On offense wide receiver Kristian Wilkerson is chasing the OVC career touchdowns record as he has 32 for his career including nine this season on 51 catches for 1,085 yards.

ON THIS DATE IN EIU HISTORY

Nov. 16, 2002 - Running back J.R. Taylor became the first and only running back in Eastern Illinois history to pass the 300 yard rushing mark for a game as he racked up 308 of the Panthers 379 rushing yards during a 47-6 win over Florida Atlantic. Taylor found the end zone four times during the game as EIU won its eighth straight game climbing to No. 2 in the NCAA National Rankings.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS
