EIU Opens Most Unique Season At UT Martin

Eastern Illinois at UT Martin
 Graham Stadium (7,500) • Martin, Tenn.

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois opens up what will be a most unique season as many teams from the FCS level compete during the spring for the 2020-21 season. The Ohio Valley Conference will have eight teams competing in a seven-game schedule. EIU will host four of its seven games this season at O'Brien Field.

- When Eastern Illinois takes the field again on Feb. 21 at Graham Stadium in Martin, Tenn., it will be the first football game action for the Panthers since Nov. 23, 2019 - a span of 456 days. The last time EIU had a gap that big or bigger between games was in the midst of World War II when EIU went 686 days between games (1942-44).

- The seven game schedule this season for the Panthers will be the fewest number of games EIU has played in a season since the 1945 season when EIU played seven games under head coach James "Pim" Goff. EIU posted a 2-3-2 record that season playing a regional schedule.

- Eastern Illinois is coming off a 1-11 season last year as head coach Adam Cushing rebuilds the Panthers program. The last time EIU won only one game during a season was in 1977 with the Panthers responding the next season and winning the 1978 NCAA Division II National Championship.

- Eastern Illinois had two players selected to the All-Ohio Valley Conference preseason football team for this year. Defensive lineman/linebacker Dytarious Johnson and wide receiver Isaiah Hill both were named to the preseason All-OVC squad.

- This will mark the sixth time that Eastern Illinois and UT Martin have met to open Ohio Valley Conference play for the Panthers. EIU holds a 4-1 lead in the previous meetings. The last was in 2010, a UT Martin win. EIU won in 1996, 1997, 1999 & 2000.

- Senior offensive lineman Cole Hoover was selected as a 2020 Lincoln Student Laureate Award Winner which is presented to the top students representing Illinois' colleges and universities. Hoover will be a third year starter for the Panthers and has seen time at all three offensive line positions (center, guard & tackle). Hoover is majoring in Early Childhood Special Education and holds a 3.83 grade point average.

- Senior quarterback Harry Woodbery was a semifinalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy in the fall despite EIU not participating in football in 2020. Woodbery was one of two players from the Ohio Valley Conference (Blake Mitchell - Austin Peay) to be selected as semifinalists for the award. He earned his Bachelor's Degree with a 3.70 grade point average in Philosophy and is currently enrolled in EIU's MBA program.

- Harry Woodbery will enter his third year in the Eastern Illinois football program and is on the verge of cracking the Panthers career Top 10 in a pair of categories. Woodbery enters the season ranked 12th on the EIU career touchdown passes list with 23. He needs two to join the Top 10. Woodbery enters the season ranked 15th in career passing yards with 3,006 and needs 817 yards this season to crack the Top 10.

- Running back Jaelin Benefield was a key part of the Panthers offense last season as a true freshman. Benefield ended the year with 402 rushing yards and 42 points (7 touchdowns). He was named to the All-OVC Newcomer team as he became the first freshman to lead the team in rushing and scoring since the 2003 season. That season 2020 EIU Athletic Hall of Fame inductee Vincent Webb led EIU in both categories. Benefield's best single game effort last year was 105 yards with two touchdowns at Tennessee State.

- Eastern Illinois returns several key producers from last year's offense as four of the top five receiving leaders return from last season. Isaiah Hill, Jaelin Benefield, Robbie Lofton and Dewayne Cooks Jr., all caught 12 or more passes last year and combined for 136 receptions, 1,260 yards and seven touchdowns. Those totals represent 60 percent of EIU's receptions, 61 percent of EIU's receiving yards, and 64 percent of touchdown receptions from last year.

- Isaiah Hill was one of EIU's most dynamic weapons last season as he became eligible via an NCAA waiver at the start of conference play. Hill appeared in eight games last season and led EIU with 57 receptions for 569 yards and four touchdowns. He added two rushing touchdowns as he had a streak of five consecutive games during the season with a touchdown. Hill earned All-OVC Newcomer Team honors and is a preseason All-OVC selection this year. He ranked 31st in the FCS in receptions per game with a 15-catch, 157 yard performance last season at UT Martin. The 15 catches were the fourth most in a single game in EIU school history.

- Eastern Illinois had a youth movement on the offensive line last season as at times during games the Panthers lined up five true freshmen. From that group left tackle Chad Strickland made ten starts earning second team Freshman All-American honors. Also returning from that core group of freshmen linemen are Elkhanan Tanelus who started nine games at left guard and Anthony Imperio who started seven games at right tackle.

- EIU returns senior Matt Reyna who suffered a season ending injury the week prior to the Panthers season opener in 2019. In 2018 he was one of the top returners in the OVC before injuries set him back at the end of that year. Reyna ranks 55th in the FCS in total return yards in 2018 despite missing the final three games of the year. He averaged 23.8 yards per return including a 96-yard touchdown return against Indiana State. Reyna added 21 receptions for 274 yards.

- While EIU has Harry Woodbery slated as the returning starter at quarterback, a host of newcomers will battle to secure the No. 2 quarterback spot on the depth chart. Currently freshman Otto Kuhns has won the job. EIU did add junior college transfer Tyler Selvig at the January break with freshman Zach Weir and JUCO transfer Steven Frank on the roster.

• Eastern Illinois returns four of its top five tacklers from last season on a defense that improved as the year went on. Dytarious Johnson, Jason Johnson, Raymond Crittenden and Bryce Dewberry all ranked in the EIU top five for tackles last season combining for 235 total tackles, more than a quarter of EIU's total output. EIU has 12 total defensive returners that started two or more games last season.

• Eastern Illinois had 21 turnovers gained last season with 11 interceptions and ten fumble recoveries. The Panthers converted one of those turnovers into a touchdown with a Raymond Crittenden fumble return for touchdown at UT Martin. Dytarious Johnson is the Panthers top returner with two fumble recoveries while JJ Ross is the team leader returning with four interceptions.

• JJ Ross made an impact as a freshman last season appearing in all 12 games with six starts at corner. Ross finished the season with four interceptions which was second in the OVC and 33rd in the FCS. He earned third team Freshman All-American honors after registering 24 tackles (19 solo) with two additional pass break-ups.

• Mark Williams is the Panthers other starter at corner as the senior enters the 2020 season. During his career Williams has been an effective corner with 134 tackles and six interceptions. Last season Williams had seven pass break-ups to rank second on the team as he now has 22 career pass break-ups to rank ninth on the EIU career list.

• Dytarious Johnson ranked among the OVC leaders in tackles for loss last season as he earned second team All-OVC honors. Johnson was third in the OVC with 13.5 tackles for loss despite missing the Panthers final game of the season. A preseason All-OVC selection this year, Johnson enters the season seventh on the EIU career tackles for loss chart with 36.5. He has 198 career tackles with eight career forced fumbles.

• Linebacker Jason Johnson came on late in the season for EIU as he earned both All-OVC Newcomer team honors and second team Freshman All-American honors. Johnson finished third on the team with 59 tackles making 54 of those stops in OVC action to lead EIU in conference only tackles. He added 4.5 tackles for loss and forced a key fumble late in the Panthers game at Tennessee State which helped EIU secure its first win of the year.

• Eastern Illinois will have a pair of new coaches on the defensive side of the ball as the Panthers open up the season. Cliff Odom Jr., was hired in early 2020 and will coach the defensive backs. Adam Morris was hired in early February 2021 and will coach the Panthers defensive line. Morris replaces Justin Manning who was hired in early 2020 but never coached in a game due to the postponement of the 2020 fall season. Manning was hired on the staff at Duke in late January 2021.

• Bryce Dewberry will have a unique distinction in EIU football history when the Panthers open the season this weekend as he will become the first player to wear the No. 0 in a game. The NCAA granted teams the ability to use the No. 0 for players for the first time for the 2020 season. Dewberry ranked fifth on the team last season with 53 tackles.

• Eastern Illinois will have a young group up front on the defensive line as Kylan Cole is the Panthers top returner in terms of production. Cole had 26 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss. He is joined by returners Jayden O'Neal, James Ubaikie and Tim Varga up front as those four players combined for 72 tackles and nine tackles for loss last season.

• Eastern Illinois will have a new host of players handling kicking duties this season as freshman Will Orth is slated to be the place kicker while Daniel Luoma will handle kickoffs. Luoma is from Finland and becomes the Panthers first international player since Pascal Matla (Netherlands) in 2005.

• EIU led the FCS in 4th down attempts and 4th down conversions last season as the Panthers were 28-of-51 on the season for 54.9 percent. EIU ranked 35th in conversion pct.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players this season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. UT MARTIN HEAD COACH JASON SIMPSON

Jason Simpson is currently the longest tenured head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference entering his 15th season with UT Martin. In his debut season of 2006, Simpson earned OVC Coach of the Year honors as he led the Skyhawks to a share of the OVC Championship and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance. He has posted a record of 87-73 with an OVC mark of 69-42. Last season he became UTM's career leader in coaching wins. Simpson is a 1995 graduate of Southern Mississippi where he played baseball.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

UT Martin was leading the Ohio Valley Conference race when these two teams met last season in Martin, Tenn. UT Martin would finish the year 7-5 with a 6-2 record in the OVC. On offense the Skyhawks return quarterback John Bachus II who passed for more than 2,500 yards and 18 touchdowns last season. UTM also returns leading rusher Peyton Logan and second leading receiver Colton Dowell. On defense UTM lost three of its top four tacklers from last season with safety JaQuez Akins the returning leader with 92 tackles. Last year UT Martin was second in the OVC in sacks with 28 but gave up a league high 37 sacks.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will be meeting for the 26th time as the two schools play in Martin, Tenn., for the second straight season. UTM won during the Oct. 2019 meeting holding off the Panthers, 27-18. EIU won the previous season in Charleston, 24-21 in overtime. EIU's last win at Graham Stadium was on Nov. 14, 2015 as the Panthers provided some stellar fourth quarter defense in a 23-21 win.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS
