EIU Visits Austin Peay For Last Road Game Of 2021 Season

Eastern Illinois (1-8, 1-3 OVC) at Austin Peay (3-5, 1-2 OVC) Fortera Stadium (10,000) • Clarksville, Tenn. Nov. 6, 2021 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois will play its final road game of the 2021 season as the Panthers travel to Austin Peay on Saturday afternoon. EIU led Southeast Missouri at the half last weekend but could not hold off a big third quarter by the Redhawks as EIU fell to 1-8 on the season, 1-3 in the OVC. Austin Peay lost last week to league leader UT Martin as the Skyhawks scored in the final minutes and blocked a late APSU field goal attempt as time expired. APSU fell to 3-5 overall, 1-2 in the OVC. The two schools did not meet in the spring as their game was canceled at the end of the season due to COVID-19.
- Isaiah Hill had the biggest game of his EIU career on Saturday at Southeast Missouri as the 2019 All-OVC Newcomer selection continues his return to the EIU line-up. Appearing in just his third game this season, Hill hauled in 11 passes for 207 yards on Saturday including one touchdown reception. He scored EIU's other touchdown in the contest on a 5-yard run giving him his second career game with a rushing and receiving touchdown. He became just the ninth player in school history with a 200-yard receiving game with his total the eighth most in school history. It was his third career double figure reception game with a high of 15 against UT Martin during the 2019 season.
- Jason Johnson finished with 14 tackles on Saturday at Southeast Missouri as the third year linebacker continues to lead the OVC in tackles this season. Johnson now has 94 tackles on the year and is on pace to become the first EIU player with 100 tackles in a season since Seth McDonald during the 2015 season. Johnson ranks 14th in the FCS in total tackles and his 50 solo tackles this season rank 13th in the FCS. Saturday's game marked the eighth double figure tackle game of Johnson's career.
- Saturday's game at Southeast Missouri marked the fourth time this season that Eastern Illinois has held the lead at halftime in a game. The Panthers were leading 9-7 at the half at SEMO when the Redhawks returned the opening kickoff of the second half for a touchdown to take the lead. EIU has also held leads at the half against Dayton, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Panthers were able to hold on to the lead in the road game at Tennessee Tech outscoring the Golden Eagles 14-7 in the second 30 minutes of action.

- Eastern Illinois may have one of the most active linebacker tandems in the FCS with Jason Johnson and Colin Bohanek. While Johnson is the OVC leader in tackles, Bohanek ranks just behind Johnson in many categories. Bohanek has 71 tackles this season which ranks second in the OVC and 59th in the FCS. He has eight tackles for loss which is fifth in the OVC this season and 62nd in the FCS. Bohanek made nine tackles in Saturday's loss at Southeast Missouri. His season high was 14 tackles against Illinois State while adding a 12 tackle performance at Murray State.
- Jordan Vincent finished with eight tackles on Saturday at Southeast Missouri as the second year safety ranks third on the team with 56 tackles including five tackles for loss. Of Vincent's 56 tackles, 43 of those are solo as he ranks second in the OVC in solo tackles this season trailing only teammate Jason Johnson (50). At SEMO Vincent forced the lone turnover of the game as he stripped away the ball from a Redhawks receiver and returned it 51 yards to set up the Panthers first score of the game.
- Defensive lineman Jordan Miles had three tackles including a half tackle for loss on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. Miles is the Panthers leader with 11 tackles for loss this season adding four sacks, which is tied for the team lead. Miles ranks 52nd in the FCS and third in the OVC in tackles for loss this season. He needs 4.5 tackles for loss over the final two games of the season to crack the EIU single season Top 10. Miles was named the OVC Defensive Player of the Week earlier this year for his performance in EIU's win at Tennessee Tech.
- Eastern Illinois pass defense continues to be ranked as one of the top units in the FCS. The Panthers are currently seventh in the FCS and first in the OVC in pass defense allowing 163.2 yards per game. EIU has held eight of its nine opponents below 200 yards passing this season and seven of nine below 175 yards. Two schools Indiana State (87 yards) and Illinois State (54 yards) have been held under 100 yards in their contests against EIU. EIU is currently ranked 35th in the FCS in total defense, 2nd in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois was held to just three team tackles for loss during Saturday's game at Southeast Missouri. It matched the Panthers lowest output of the season tying a three tackle for loss performance in the opener at Indiana State. EIU had entered the SEMO contest leading the OVC in tackles for loss per game and ranked 19th in the FCS. EIU had a season high 11 tackles for loss in the road win at Tennessee Tech and added a ten tackle for loss performance at Murray State.
- Transfer defensive lineman Justin Growel picked up one of the Panthers tackles for loss on Saturday at Southeast Missouri with a quarterback sack and forced fumble. Growel has appeared in eight of the nine games this season for EIU with 20 tackles and five tackles for loss. He ranks third on the team in quarterback hurries with four.
- Eastern Illinois defensive front welcomed back a couple of players over the last two weeks as senior James Ubaike and second year player Jaron Hacha both returned. Ubaike had two tackles at Southeast Missouri and now has nine tackles this season in four games played. Hacha had two tackles at Southeast Missouri returning from an injury earlier this season. On the year Hacha now has ten tackles in five games played including one start during the win at Tennessee Tech.

- Kicker Stone Galloway knocked home a 41-yard field goal at Southeast Missouri as the kicker was 1-for-2 on field goal attempts. His miss was from 40-yards. On the season Galloway is now 4-of-9 on field goal attempts with a long of 44 yards against Illinois State. Galloway took over field goal duties last season and is now 9-of-16 for his career.
- Isaiah Hill's 200-yard receiving performance at Southeast Missouri on Saturday marked the fourth time this season a receiver has finished with more than 100 yards in a game. The Panthers now have four different receivers with top performances this season. Tyler Ringwood caught five passes for 116 yards in the season opener at Indiana State. DeAirious Smith and Arron Foulkes had 100-yard receiving performances in back-to-back weeks. Smith had six catches for 109 yards and two touchdowns at Tennessee Tech. Foulkes hauled in seven passes for 132 yards and one score at Murray State.
- Jaelin Benefield was the Panthers top rusher for the second straight week as he made his return from a preseason injury in the Oct. 23 game against Tennessee State. Last Saturday he rushed for 33 yards on 12 carries while catching one pass for ten yards. Benefield was EIU's leading rusher as a freshman in 2019 and ranks third on the team this season with 89 yards in two games played.
- Zach Weir played in his second straight contest late in the game passing for 64 yards on 3-of-8 passing. It was the third game Weir has played in this season as he is now 6-of-17 for 90 yards. Otto Kuhns made the start against Southeast Missouri passing the 1,000 yard passing mark for the season as he had 211 yards in the game. He is now 91-of-193 for 1,127 yards and six touchdowns this season. Chris Katrenick has also seen time under center going 40-of-88 for 389 yards and one touchdown.
- Eastern Illinois has 12 players on its current roster that have already completed their undergraduate degree and are playing as graduate students this fall. The list includes Ben Solomon, Isaiah Hill, James Ubaike and Steven Frank who all completed their undergraduate degrees at EIU. Joining that list as graduates from other schools now playing at EIU are Jay Vallie, Elijah Benoit, Justin Growel, Chris Katrenick, Logen Neidhardt, Markenzy Pierre, Tyler Ringwood and Kobe Rodgers.
- Ben Solomon was a nominee for this year's Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Solomon was one of three nominee's from the Ohio Valley Conference and 17 players from the FCS ranks. Solomon has been a leader for the Panthers Uplifting Athletes Chapter spearheading two campaigns over the last two summers (Walk for Life & Lift for Life).
- Eastern Illinois has a strong tradition of NFL players as several former Panthers get opened the NFL season last weekend. Former Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo is with the San Francisco 49ers while linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill plays with the Houston Texans. In addition the Panthers have alumni serving in administrative and coaching roles with New Orleans Saints head coach Sean Payton, Chicago Bears general manager Ryan Pace and Houston Texans offensive coordinator Tim Kelly. EIU was once again the only school in the nation with an alumnus as an NFL general manager, head coach and starting quarterback on opening day.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players that first season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. AUSTIN PEAY HEAD COACH SCOTTY WALDEN

Scotty Walden was the newest head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference when he was hired during the fall of 2020 replacing an interim head coach that led the Governors during the three nonconference games in the fall. Walden came to APSU after working at Southern Miss where he served as the interim head coach for a portion of the fall 2020 season. He also has one year of head coaching experience at East Texas Baptist. Walden played collegiate football at three different schools finishing his degree and playing career at Sul Ross State. Now in his second season of competition leading the Governors he has a 7-7 record with APSU, 5-4 in OVC games.

SCOUTING AUSTIN PEAY

Austin Peay opened the year in the Top 25 rankings and picked up a win over No. 18 Chattanooga during the opening weekend. The Governors remained ranked until late September before falling out of both FCS polls. Quarterback Draylen Ellis leads the APSU offense passing for a league high 1,709 yards this season with ten touchdowns and eight interceptions. Baniko Harley has been the top target with 43 catches for 645 yards and six touchdowns. Koby Perry leads the defense with 61 tackles. Johnathon Edwards has four interceptions.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Austin Peay will be meeting for the 21st time this Saturday as the Panthers hold a 15-5 all-time series lead. The schools did not meet in the spring of 2021 as their game was canceled due to COVID-19. APSU has won two of the last three meetings with both wins coming in Clarksville. The win in 2017 snapped an eight game win streak in the series by the Panthers. Austin Peay has won one time in Charleston with a 15-13 win on Nov. 8, 2008. In the Panthers five all-time losses to the Governors, EIU has scored 13 or less points in each loss including 35-7 in 2019.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS


