Panthers Step Back Out Of OVC Play at Murray State

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois and Murray State will become quite familiar with each other during the 2021 calendar year as the school's will meet this Saturday for a non-conference contest. EIU is 1-0 in the Ohio Valley Conference standings after a win at Tennessee Tech last weekend. The Panthers are 1-4 overall. Murray State is 1-2 on the year and will open OVC play on Oct. 9. The two schools will meet in the final game of the 2021 regular season on Nov. 20 marking three meetings between the programs in 237 calendar days.
- Jordan Miles was named the Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week following his performance at Tennessee Tech. He finished with four tackles but three of those were sacks. On his final two sacks he forced fumbles that were recovered by EIU's defense to end TTU drives. Miles leads the OVC in both tackles for loss (7.5) and sacks (3) while ranking 32nd in the FCS in forced fumbles. The last EIU player with three or more sacks in a game was Kory Lothe with four against Tennessee Tech in 2003.
- DeAirious Smith hauled in six passes for 109 yards and two touchdowns on Saturday at Tennessee Tech. Smith is the second EIU wide receiver to pass the 100 yard mark in a game this season joining Tyler Ringwood who had five catches for 116 yards in the Week Zero game at Indiana State. For Smith it was the second straight game he has found the end zone after he scooped up a blocked punt and returned it for touchdown last week against Illinois State. He leads the team in scoring and now has seven catches for 133 yards this year.
- Jason Johnson posted a big tackle game against Tennessee Tech for the second straight season. In Saturday's game Johnson finished with 16 tackles as he now leads the OVC with 45 tackles this season. Last season against TTU, Johnson had 15 tackles as he earned OVC Defensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts. It was the sixth time in Johnson's career that he has collected double figure tackles. In the spring of 2021, Johnson ranked 9th in the FCS in tackles per game finishing the year with 66 tackles. He had a streak of four straight double figure tackle games to end the spring season.

- Safety Bryce Dewberry scooped up a fumble by Tennessee Tech at the EIU 10-yard line and raced 90 yards for a score midway through the fourth quarter to push EIU's lead to 28-14. The 90-yard fumble return was the longest in EIU school history passing the previous mark of 70-yards set by Anthony Goodman in 2013. It was the second defensive touchdown of Dewberry's career as he had a long interception return against UT Martin during the 2018 season. Dewberry has 12 tackles with one tackle for loss this season.
- Tim Varga was able to get home to the quarterback on Saturday at Tennessee Tech as he had two of the Panthers five sacks in the game. Varga is tied for the team lead in quarterback hurries this season with six and had 20 total tackles. It was the first time EIU had picked up five sacks as a defense since Oct. 7, 2017 when the Panthers had five sacks against Tennessee Tech. EIU came back the following week with four sacks against Murray State.
- Eastern Illinois defense had four turnovers gained on Saturday at Tennessee Tech with three fumble recoveries and one interception. The last time EIU had four or more turnovers gained in a contest was Oct. 5, 2019 when the Panthers had four fumble recoveries at Murray State. EIU now has six turnovers gained on the season to rank 42nd in the FCS.
- Eastern Illinois offensive line was able to provide solid protection for the quarterback as the Panthers did not allow a sack at Tennessee Tech. It marked the fourth time under head coach Adam Cushing that EIU has not allowed a sack in a game. The last time was in the spring on Feb. 28 against Southeast Missouri.
- Eastern Illinois converted on a two-point conversion at Tennessee Tech as quarterback Otto Kuhns connected with DeWayne Cooks on the short passing play. The last time EIU scored on a two-point conversion was Oct. 19, 2019 when Harry Woodbery hit Isaiah Hill for a pass against UT Martin. EIU has not scored on a rushing two-point conversion since J.R. Taylor scampered in during the 2002 season against Murray State.
- Running back Harrison Bey-Buie rushed for a season high 79 yards as the Panthers had 121 yards on the ground at Tennessee Tech. For the season Bey-Buie has rushed for 208 yards and ranks 8th in the OVC. The last EIU running back to rush for more than 100 yards in a game was Jordan Smith (142 yds) during the spring season at Murray State.
- Otto Kuhns passed for 183 yards and two touchdowns on Saturday at Tennessee Tech. In the game Kuhns went over the 1,000 yard mark passing for his career. Both of his touchdown passes were to DeAirious Smith as Kuhns has now thrown four touchdowns this season to rank 52nd in the FCS.
- Jordan Vincent finished the Tennessee Tech game with seven tackles and two tackles for loss. All seven of Vincent's tackles were solo stops as the second year safety leads the Panthers with 28 solo tackles (36 overall). He currently ranks 16th in the FCS in solo tackles and first in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois pass defense continues to lead the OVC as the Panthers are allowing 155 yards pass per game this season which ranks 16th in the FCS. EIU's defense is ranked 29th in total defense, second in the OVC behind Murray State. Kaelin Drakeford had EIU's first interception of the season during the win at Tennessee Tech.
- Eastern Illinois kickoff return defense has once again been one of the best in the nation during the early part of the 2021 season. After ranking second in the FCS during the spring season allowing 10.3 yards per kick return, EIU is currently seventh in the FCS this season allowing just 13.1 yards per kick return. A big part of that success has been the play of kicker Daniel Luoma who is averaging 60.4 yards per kick with six touchbacks.
- Wide receiver Arron Foulkes scored in the third quarter at Tennessee Tech on a 24-yard end sweep. He would add one pass reception for 32 yards. In the Panthers win over TTU during the spring season, Foulkes had a breakout game finishing with three catches for 60 yards and two touchdowns. This season he has five receptions for 82 yards.

2021 OVC Players of the Week

Sept. 12 - Logen Neidhardt (Special Teams) Sept. 26 - Jordan Miles (Defense)

- Eastern Illinois defense finished with 11 tackles for loss on Saturday at Tennessee Tech. EIU now has 32 tackles for loss this season which ranks 44th in the FCS and 1st in the OVC. Jordan Miles is the Panthers leader with 7.5 tackles for loss which ranks 22nd in the FCS and 1st in the OVC. The last time EIU's defense posted double figure tackles for loss in a game was Oct. 20, 2018 with 10.5 TFL against UT Martin.
- Punter Logen Neidhardt boomed another 50-yard punt on Saturday at Tennessee Tech as he averaged 37.5 yards per punt on the day. He had three pinned inside the 20-yard line including one punt that checked-up and was downed at the 1-yard line. For the season Neidhardt ranks 29th in the OVC in punting with a 44.3 yards per punt average. He has eight punts over 50 yards with a long of 72. He has had ten of his 24 punts inside the 20-yard line. EIU's single season record for punting average is 44.6 yards per punt set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season.
- Robbie Lofton leads the Panthers in receptions with 14 this season which ranks 9th in the OVC. He had one catch at Tennessee Tech and now caught at least one pass in seven straight games dating back to last season including four games with multiple catches and three games with touchdowns. Lofton's two receiving touchdowns this season rank him 54th in the FCS in touchdown receptions.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing a team twice in the regular season for the first time since the 1921 season when the Panthers faced Rose Poly (now Rose-Hulman) twice under head coach Charles Lantz. Since that time EIU has had four other seasons when they have faced the same team twice in a year (once in the regular season and once in the post season). EIU has done that in 1978 (Youngstown State), 1983 (Indiana State), 2006 (Illinois State) and 2013 (Tennessee State).
- Saturday's game against Murray State will mark the latest in a season that EIU has played a non-conference game since the 2012 campaign. That year EIU traveled to Central Arkansas for the final game of the regular season after EIU had already locked up a post-season bid as the OVC regular season champion.
- Eastern Illinois field goal kicker Stone Galloway missed on two field goal attempts at Tennessee Tech on Saturday as the third year player is now 2-of-5 on field goals this season. One of his missed attempts was from 38-yards marking the first time in his career he has missed from inside of 40-yards. Galloway has a career long of 44 yards and is 7-of-12 for his career
- Eastern Illinois has 12 players on its current roster that have already completed their undergraduate degree and are playing as graduate students this fall. The list includes Ben Solomon, Isaiah Hill, James Ubaike and Steven Frank who all completed their undergraduate degrees at EIU. Joining that list as graduates from other schools now playing at EIU are Jay Vallie, Elijah Benoit, Justin Growel, Chris Katrenick, Logen Neidhardt, Markenzy Pierre, Tyler Ringwood and Kobe Rodgers.
- Ben Solomon has been named a nominee for this year's Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Solomon is one of three nominee's from the Ohio Valley Conference and 17 players from the FCS ranks. Solomon has been a leader for the Panthers Uplifting Athletes Chapter spearheading two campaigns over the last two summers (Walk for Life & Lift for Life).
- Eastern Illinois has a strong tradition of NFL players as several former Panthers get opened the NFL season last weekend. Former Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo is with the San Francisco 49ers while linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill plays with the Houston Texans. In addition the Panthers have alumni serving in administrative and coaching roles with New Orleans Saints head coach Sean Payton, Chicago Bears general manager Ryan Pace and Houston Texans offensive coordinator Tim Kelly. EIU was once again the only school in the nation with an alumnus as an NFL general manager, head coach and starting quarterback on opening day.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players that first season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. MURRAY STATE HEAD COACH DEAN HOOD

Veteran coach Dean Hood was hired as Murray State's head coach in the spring of 2020, one year later he had the Racers in the national rankings for the first time since the 2011 season. MSU got off to a 5-0 start last year before ending the season 5-2. Hood spent eight years as the head coach at Eastern Kentucky leading the Colonels to two OVC Championships and three FCS playoff appearances. A graduate of Ohio Wesleyan University, Hood has a head coaching record of 61-42 overall including a 49-21 record in OVC contests.

SCOUTING MURRAY STATE

Murray State is 1-2 on the season as the Racers are coming off a bye week following back-to-back games against FBS opponents. Quarterback Preston Rice is the key to the Murray State offense as the dual-threat player has rushed for 102 yards and five touchdowns while throwing for 297 yards. Running backs Damonta Witherspoon and Cortezz Jones are both over 100 yards rushing early in the season while LaMartez Brooks has been the top receiver with 12 catches for 151 yards. Murray State's defense has been balanced with eight players with eight tackles or more this season. The leader is Levi Metheny with 13 tackles. DaVontae McKee has two of the Racers three interceptions this season.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Murray State will be meeting for the 37th time on Saturday in what will be the second of three meetings between the two schools in an eight month span. The Panthers hold a 19-17 all-time series lead with Murray State winning the last three games in the series. Four of the last five games have been decided by a touchdown or less including a 2019, 24-17 win by Murray State where the Racers stopped EIU short of the goal line on the final play. Last spring EIU built a lead early in the second half before Murray State rallied to win 41-27.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.


