#### Panthers Hit The OVC Road With Trip To Southeast Missouri

Eastern Illinois (1-7, 1-2 OVC) at Southeast Missouri (2-6, 2-1 OVC) Houck Field (5,000) • Cape Girardeau, Mo. Oct. 30, 2021 • 1 p.m. • TV: ESPN3

#### NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois closes out the month of October on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. The Panthers are looking to snap a three game losing skid including back-to-back losses at home the last two weeks to UT Martin and Tennessee State. EIU is 1-7 overall, 1-2 in the OVC. Southeast Missouri also looks to snap a losing skid as the Redhawks have lost two straight non-OVC games to Murray State and UT Martin falling to 2-6 overall, 2-1 in the OVC.
- Jordan Miles added to his season total for tackles for loss as the second year defensive lineman ranks first in the OVC this season with 10.5 tackles for loss. He needs five tackles for loss in the Panthers final three games to crack the EIU single season Top 10 list. Miles is currently fourth on the EIU team with 35 tackles including 3.5 sacks.
- Jaelin Benefield returned to the Panthers line-up for the first time this season on Saturday against Tennessee State. Benefield had nine carries on the day and finished as EIU's leading rusher with 56 yards. Two years ago Benefield was the Panthers leading rusher with 402 yards and during the spring he added 258 yards in five games played. Benefield now has 716 career rushing yards.
- Mark Aitken picked up a sack for the Panthers defense on Saturday against Tennessee State as one of his three tackles as a defensive back. Aitken became the fifth different Panther to record at least a half sack this season as EIU now has 11 sacks as a team to rank fourth in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois was 3-of-3 on 4th down attempts on Saturday against Tennessee State as the Panthers rank sixth in the FCS this season in 4th down attempts with 23. EIU is converting at 52 percent (12-of-23). The Panthers led the FCS in 4th down attempts during both the 2019 season and 2020 season going 38-of-82.

- Eastern Illinois pass defense continues to be ranked among the best in the nation as the Panthers are fourth in the FCS allowing just 159 yards per game. EIU has only allowed one team to pass for more than 175 yards in a game this season with two opponents held below the 100-yard mark (Indiana State 87 yards and Illinois State 54 yards).
- Linebacker Jason Johnson has been a big part of the Panthers defense this year that is ranked second in the OVC in total defense and 32nd in the FCS. Johnson leads the OVC with 80 tackles including 46 solo stops. He is ranked 15th in the FCS in total tackles and seventh in solo tackles. He is on pace to finish with more than 100 tackles this season, the last Panther to accomplish that was Seth McDonald with 109 tackles in 2015. Johnson went over the 200 career tackle mark last weekend against Tennessee State and now has 205 career tackles.
- Cameron Leach had one of the best games of his EIU career on Saturday finishing with a career high nine tackles including a half tackle for loss on a Panthers goal line stand on fourth and goal. For the season Leach has 24 total tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and two pass break-ups.
- Safety Jordan Vincent made eight tackles on Saturday against Tennessee State including six solo stops. Vincent is current second on the team with 38 solo tackles which ranks second in the OVC. Vincent is one of just five players in the league this season with 30 or more solo tackles two of the others are teammates Jason Johnson (1st with 46 solo tackles) and Colin Bohanek (5th with 30 solo tackles).
- Eastern Illinois had its streak of games forcing multiple turnovers snapped against Tennessee State as the Panthers were not able to force Tigers miscue. EIU had forced nine turnovers in its previous three games with four turnovers in the win at Tennessee Tech, three at Murray State and two against UT Martin. For the season EIU has 11 turnovers gained to rank fourth in the OVC and 58th nationally.
- Eastern Illinois defense tacked on seven more tackles for loss to its season total as the Panthers lead the OVC with 6.8 tackles for loss per game (55 total). That total ranks 19th in the FCS this season. Jordan Miles is the team leader with 10.5 tackles for loss with Colin Bohanek second on the team with eight. A total of 18 players have at least a half tackle for loss this season with six players collecting four or more TFL's this season.
- Logen Neidhardt continues to be a special teams weapon for the Panthers as the graduate student leads the OVC in punting with a 42.0 yards per punt average. On Saturday against Tennessee State, Neidhardt averaged 38 yards per punt with a long punt of 43 yards. He pinned two punts inside the 20-yard line. For the season Neidhardt has 11 punts over 50 yards with a long of 72 yards. He has pinned 16 of 44 punts inside the 20-yard line.
- Cooper Willman played in several roles on Saturday against Tennessee State as he took over return duties for the injured Matt Judd. Willman had two punt returns for 21 yards and one kick return for 21 yards. He would also see time at wide receiver catching two passes for 19 yards.
- Eastern Illinois was shutout on Saturday by Tennessee State marking the second time this season that the Panthers have been shutout, also a 46-0 loss at South Carolina. It marked the first time EIU had been shutout in an OVC game since Oct. 11, 2003, a 41-0 loss to Eastern Kentucky.

- Superback Anthony Manaves hauled in two passes for a team high 38 yards on Saturday against Tennessee State. Manaves was one of eight players to catch at least one pass in the game. On the season Manaves has now caught six passes for 68 yards to average 11.3 yards per reception.
- Isaiah Hill continues to make his slow return to the Eastern Illinois line-up. The 2019 All-OVC Newcomer selection had three catches for 17 yards on Saturday against Tennessee State. He returned last week against UT Martin with two catches for 19 yards. Hill missed all of last season with an injury.
- Zach Weir was the third of three quarterbacks that saw time under center on Saturday against Tennessee State. Weir was 3-of-6 passing for 26 yards during the fourth quarter. It was the second time this season Weir has appeared in a game and the third time in his two-year collegiate career.
- Daniel Luoma had just one kickoff on Saturday against Tennessee State with his one kick sailing 56 yards. This season Luoma is averaging 59.5 yards per kickoff with eight touchbacks. The Panthers currently rank fifth in the FCS in kickoff return defense allowing just 13.6 yards per kick return.
- Defensive back Tyris Harvey had one of the Panthers four pass break-ups on Saturday against Tennessee State. The second year player is now tied for the team lead with Blake Ruffin with four pass break-ups this season. Kaelin Drakeford has four total passes defended with one interception and three break-ups.
- Eastern Illinois had four turnovers in the loss on Saturday to Tennessee State with 14 of the Tigers 28 points coming off turnovers. On the season EIU has committed 15 turnovers (11 interceptions / 4 fumbles) resulting in 57 points off turnovers for opponents. The last time EIU turned the ball over four or more times was the Spring 2021 opener against Southeast Missouri (3 INT / 1 FUM).
- Eastern Illinois has 12 players on its current roster that have already completed their undergraduate degree and are playing as graduate students this fall. The list includes Ben Solomon, Isaiah Hill, James Ubaike and Steven Frank who all completed their undergraduate degrees at EIU. Joining that list as graduates from other schools now playing at EIU are Jay Vallie, Elijah Benoit, Justin Growel, Chris Katrenick, Logen Neidhardt, Markenzy Pierre, Tyler Ringwood and Kobe Rodgers.
- Ben Solomon was a nominee for this year's Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Solomon was one of three nominee's from the Ohio Valley Conference and 17 players from the FCS ranks. Solomon has been a leader for the Panthers Uplifting Athletes Chapter spearheading two campaigns over the last two summers (Walk for Life & Lift for Life).
- Eastern Illinois has a strong tradition of NFL players as several former Panthers get opened the NFL season last weekend. Former Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo is with the San Francisco 49ers while linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill plays with the Houston Texans. In addition the Panthers have alumni serving in administrative and coaching roles with New Orleans Saints head coach Sean Payton, Chicago Bears general manager Ryan Pace and Houston Texans offensive coordinator Tim Kelly. EIU was once again the only school in the nation with an alumnus as an NFL general manager, head coach and starting quarterback on opening day.

#### EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players that first season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. #### SOUTHEAST MISSOURI HEAD COACH TOM MATUKEWICZ

Tom Matukewicz is in his eighth season as the head coach at Southeast Missouri having led the Redhawks to back-to-back FCS playoff appearances in 2018 and 2019. In his first season the Redhawks climbed into the national rankings following two early Top 20 upset wins but finished the season 5-7. Matukewicz was a long time assistant coach as a member of head coach Jerry Kill's staff at both Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois. He was the defensive coordinator at Toledo for two seasons before taking over at SEMO. Matukewicz is a 1997 graduate of Fort Hays State in Kansas. He is 39-48 overall, 31-27 in the OVC.

#### SCOUTING SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Southeast Missouri enters the game with a 2-6 record, 2-1 in the OVC after a pair of close losses the last two weeks to OVC teams in non-conference contests. SEMO lost by one point to Murray State and by eight points at UT Martin. They will face the Racers and Skyhawks later this season in OVC action. Geno Hess leads a potent ground game as he has rushed for 899 yards and 12 touchdowns this season to rank fourth in the FCS in rushing. Quarterback CJ Ogbonna has passed for 885 yards and seven touchdowns. Bryce Norman has 55 tackles with seven tackles for loss to lead the Redhawks defense.

#### THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri will be meeting for the 29th time on Saturday with the Panthers holding a 18-10 all-time series lead. SEMO has won three straight in the series including a 47-7 win over the Panthers in late February to open up the spring season for the conference. EIU's last win in Cape Girardeau was on Oct. 18, 2014 when the Panthers won 52-13 over the Redhawks. It marked the second straight season that EIU had scored 50 or more points against the Redhawks. The two schools first met in a home-and-home series in 1956 and 1957 with SEMO winning both of those contests.

#### SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

#### **OVC SUCCESS**


