Panthers Open OVC Play at Tennessee Tech

Eastern Illinois (0-4) at Tennessee Tech (0-3) Tucker Stadium (16,500) • Cookeville, Tenn. Sept. 25, 2021 • 1:30 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech will meet on Saturday afternoon in the Ohio Valley Conference opener for both schools. EIU fell to 0-4 on the season after a 31-24 loss to Illinois State in the 109th Mid-America Classic on Saturday evening at O'Brien Field. The Panthers have played three of their first four games on the road including a loss at SEC member South Carolina. Tennessee Tech fell to 0-3 on the season with a loss at SEC member Tennessee. TTU has been shutout in its last two losses.
- Eastern Illinois will be opening its 26th season as a member of the Ohio Valley Conference. The Panthers are 18-7 all-time in OVC openers including five league openers against Tennessee Tech. EIU is 3-2 when opening the league slate against TTU with the last conference opening meeting between the schools in 2019, a 40-29 TTU win. EIU and TTU also opened OVC play against each other in 1998, 2002, 2007 and 2011.
- Eastern Illinois special teams had two blocked kicks on Saturday against Illinois State as the Panthers blocked both a punt and field goal in the game. Last season EIU blocked three kicks during the season with two blocked punts and one blocked field goal. The last time EIU blocked multiple kicks in the same game was Sept. 9, 2017 when EIU blocked two field goals at Northern Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois blocked a punt and returned it for a touchdown on Saturday night against Illinois State to tie the contest at 17-17. Charles Shelton IV blocked the punt while DeAirious Smith scooped up the loose ball and returned it seven yards for a touchdown. It was the second straight year EIU has blocked a punt and returned it for a score.
- Eastern Illinois pass defense limited Illinois State to just 54 yards passing on Saturday night as the Panthers are ranked sixth in the FCS in passing defense allowing just 115 yards per game. It was the second time this season EIU has held an opponent under 100 yards passing after Indiana State had 87 yards in the Week Zero opener.

- Robbie Lofton hauled in three passes for 25 yards and a touchdown on Saturday against Illinois State. Lofton is the team leader with 13 receptions which ranks 9th in the OVC. Lofton has now caught at least one pass in six straight games dating back to last season including four games with multiple catches and three games with touchdowns. Lofton's two receiving touchdowns this season rank him 32nd in the FCS in touchdown receptions.
- Kicker Stone Galloway tied his career long with a 44-yard field goal on Saturday against Illinois State. It was his second field goal this year as he is now 2-of-3 this season and 7-of-7 on extra point attempts. For his career Galloway is 7-of-10 on field goals including 4-of-4 on attempts inside of 40 yards.
- Jordan Miles blocked the field goal attempt by Illinois State on Saturday as the second year player finished the game with five tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss and two quarterback hurries. For the season Miles is the Panthers team leader with 4.5 tackles for loss, ranking second in the OVC. Last season Miles was tied for the EIU team lead with six tackles for loss. Miles is currently fifth on the team with 16 tackles.
- DeAirious Smith was in on his second big special teams play in his young EIU career as he scooped up the blocked punt against Illinois State and returned it for a touchdown. Last season, Smith blocked a punt at UT Martin which went out of the back of the end zone for a safety. Smith also saw time at wide receiver in Saturday's game with one catch for 24 yards. He is one of 12 players in the FCS this season with a punt return touchdown.
- Charles Shelton IV had the Panthers blocked punt on Saturday against Illinois State. It was the second time in his career Shelton has made a big special teams play for the Panthers. In 2019 during EIU's win at Tennessee State, Shelton recovered an onside kick by EIU's special teams unit. In addition to his time on special teams Shelton has seen time as a back-up defensive back with four tackles this season.
- Harrison Bey-Buie scored his second rushing touchdown of the season with a 2-yard plunge in the fourth quarter against Illinois State. Bey-Buie finished with 36 yards on 14 carries in the game. For the season he is the Panthers leading rusher with 129 yards ranking sixth in the OVC. Bey-Buie rushed for a season high 57 yards in the Week Zero opener at Indiana State with his first touchdown of the season.
- Quarterback Otto Kuhns is approaching the 1,000 yard passing mark for his career as the second year player has passed for 990 career yards. On Saturday against Illinois State, Kuhns was 16-of-32 for 168 yards and a touchdown. He has passed for 481 yards this season after throwing for 509 yards during four games in the spring. Kuhns now has seven career touchdown passes.
- Punter Logen Neidhardt averaged over 50 yards per punt for the second straight week as the transfer graduate student averaged 52 yards on Saturday with both of his punts traveling 52 yards. Neidhardt is currently 19th in the FCS in punting average at 46.6 yards per punt with seven kicks over 50 yards and seven inside the 20-yard line. EIU's single season record for punting average is 44.6 yards set by Kevin Cook in 2007.
- Wide receiver Tyler Ringwood returned to the Panthers line-up on Saturday against Illinois State after missing the last two weeks with an injury. Ringwood caught three passes for 17 yards against ISU. In his debut in the Week Zero game at Indiana State, Ringwood had five catches for 116 yards. His 133 yards receiving leads the Panthers and ranks 10th in the OVC.
- Eastern Illinois defense was able to force a turnover on Saturday against Illinois State as Jason Johnson recovered a fumble in the opening half. The turnover resulted in points for EIU as Johnson finished with a team high eight tackles in the game. Last season Johnson earned first team All-OVC honors after leading the conference with 66 tackles. He ended the season with four straight double figure tackle games including a season-high 15 in the win over Tennessee Tech. Johnson is fifth in the OVC in tackles this season with 28.

2021 OVC Players of the Week

Sept. 12 - Logen Neidhardt (Special Teams)

- Daniel Luoma, who hails from Finland, continues to handle most of the kickoff duties for Eastern Illinois in the early portion of the season. Luoma this season has had ten kickoffs for an average of 61.7 yards per kick. He has sent six of his ten kicks for touchbacks this year.
- Jordan Vincent had five tackles on Saturday against Illinois State including four solo stops. Vincent currently leads the Panthers with 29 tackles this year with 21 of the 29 tackles coming as a solo tackle. He ranks 38th in the FCS in solo tackles. Vincent had ten solo tackles earlier this in the Panthers game at Dayton.
- Eastern Illinois had six tackles for loss on Saturday against Illinois State with Kaelin Drakeford and Jordan Miles each leading the way with 1.5 tackles for loss. Colin Bohanek and Jordan Vincent each added a solo tackle for loss with Alton Jefferson and Russell Dandy credited with a half tackle for loss. This season 14 different Panthers have picked up a tackle for loss with five players racking up 2.5 TFL or more this season.
- After ranking first in the FCS in number of fourth down attempts over the previous two seasons, Eastern Illinois is once again among the nation's leaders in fourth down attempts this year. EIU is 4-of-10 on 4th down this season with the ten fourth down attempts ranking eighth in the FCS. EIU opened the year 3-of-3 on fourth down conversions but is 1-of-7 in the last two games. In 2019 and 2020 EIU converted on 38-of-82 fourth down attempts good for 46.3 percent. The Citadel (47 conversions) and Davidson (43 conversions) were the only schools with more fourth down conversions in the last two seasons.
- Eastern Illinois defense has once again been active this season as the Panthers have four players ranked in the top 20 in the OVC in tackles including three in the top five. Jordan Vincent is the Panthers leader in tackles with 29 which ranks fourth in the OVC. He is followed by linebackers Jason Johnson and Colin Bohanek, both with 28 tackles to rank in a tie for fifth. Kaelin Drakeford is 18th in the OVC in tackles with 19. Vincent, Johnson and Bohanek have all led the Panthers in tackles for at least one game this season. Drakeford has EIU's lone sack of the year at South Carolina.
- Eastern Illinois has 12 players on its current roster that have already completed their undergraduate degree and are playing as graduate students this fall. The list includes Ben Solomon, Isaiah Hill, James Ubaike and Steven Frank who all completed their undergraduate degrees at EIU. Joining that list as graduates from other schools now playing at EIU are Jay Vallie, Elijah Benoit, Justin Growel, Chris Katrenick, Logen Neidhardt, Markenzy Pierre, Tyler Ringwood and Kobe Rodgers.
- Ben Solomon has been named a nominee for this year's Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Solomon is one of three nominee's from the Ohio Valley Conference and 17 players from the FCS ranks. Solomon has been a leader for the Panthers Uplifting Athletes Chapter spearheading two campaigns over the last two summers (Walk for Life & Lift for Life).
- Eastern Illinois has a strong tradition of NFL players as several former Panthers get opened the NFL season last weekend. Former Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo is with the San Francisco 49ers while linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill plays with the Houston Texans. In addition the Panthers have alumni serving in administrative and coaching roles with New Orleans Saints head coach Sean Payton, Chicago Bears general manager Ryan Pace and Houston Texans offensive coordinator Tim Kelly. EIU was once again be the only school in the nation with an alumnus as an NFL general manager, head coach and starting quarterback on opening day.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players that first season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. TENNESSEE TECH HEAD COACH DEWAYNE ALEXANDER

Dewayne Alexander is in his fourth season as the head coach at Tennessee Tech. Alexander played football at TTU and earned his degree from the school in 1989. He later served three different stints as an assistant coach for the program, most recently under head coach Watson Brown. He returned to Cookeville after working the 2017 season as the offensive line coach at East Tennessee State. He was a head coach at NAIA member Cumberland University from 2006-13 posting a 41-33 record. In his first season Tennessee Tech posted a 1-10 record including a 1-7 record in the OVC. In 2019 TTU got off to a 4-1 start, the best start since the 2011 season. The Golden Eagles are now 9-24 under Alexander.

SCOUTING TENNESSEE TECH

Tennessee Tech is off to an 0-3 start to the season as the Golden Eagles prepare to open Ohio Valley Conference play. TTU was shutout at Tennessee last weekend marking the second straight shutout loss for TTU (lost 26-0 to Furman in week two). TTU has had three different players take snaps at quarterback with Drew Martin expected to start this week. David Gist has been the top rusher with 119 yards while Quinton Cross is the top receiver with 15 catches for 167 yards. Josh Reliford has been the leader on defense with 27 tackles including three pass break-ups. Devin Squires has a team-high 2.5 tackles for loss including one of two Golden Eagles sacks this season.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech will be meeting for the 28th time as the two schools open Ohio Valley Conference play against each other. EIU holds a 20-7 all-time series lead after winning 28-20 during the spring season. During the 2019 season TTU won 40-29 to snap a sevengame win streak in the series by EIU. EIU's last loss in Cookeville was Oct. 16, 2010. The first meeting between the two schools was in 1975.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

Eastern Illinois was the OVC's most successful school in terms of wins during the first decade of the 2000's as the Panthers posted 72 wins during that span. EIU leads the conference with the most post-season appearances since the Panthers joined the league in 1996.


