EIU / UT Martin Battle For OVC Lead This Weekend

Eastern Illinois (1-5, 1-0 OVC) vs. No. 17/16 UT Martin (4-1, 1-0 OVC) O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. Oct. 16, 2021 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN3

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will meet on Saturday afternoon with the winner emerging as the lone undefeated team in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Panthers are 1-5 overall, but 1-0 in the OVC following a conference opening win at Tennessee Tech on Sept. 25. EIU is coming off a bye week in the schedule after playing a non-conference game at Murray State. UT Martin won its OVC opener last weekend with a home win over Murray State as the Skyhawks improved to 4-1 overall, 1-0 in the OVC.
- Russell Dandy was named the Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player and Newcomer of the Week following the Panthers last contest on Oct. 2 at Murray State. Dandy had seven solo tackles in the game with a pair of interceptions. He single-handedly forced all three turnovers for EIU's defense adding a tackle for loss with a forced and recovered fumble. Dandy is 31st in the FCS in interceptions this season. The last EIU player with multiple interceptions in a game was JJ Ross with a pair of picks at Austin Peay on Nov. 22, 2019.
- Jason Johnson turned in his second straight big tackle performance finishing with 12 tackles at Murray State. Johnson now leads the OVC in tackles with 57 including 33 solo tackles and five tackles for loss. His season high was a 16-tackle performance in the road win at Tennessee Tech. Johnson currently ranks 23rd in the FCS in total tackles. He is on pace to finish the season with more than 100 tackles, the last EIU player with 100 or more tackles in a season was Seth McDonald with 109 in 2015.
- Arron Foulkes hauled in seven passes for 132 yards in the Panthers last game at Murray State. The day included a 54-yard touchdown reception from Chris Katrenick early in the fourth quarter. Foulkes is currently second on the EIU team with 12 receptions but leads the Panthers with 214 receiving yards. His 17.8 yards per reception ranks third in the OVC and 33rd in the FCS this season. Foulkes is the third EIU wide receiver to post a 100-yard receiving day this season joining Tyler Ringwood (5 catches, 116 yards at Indiana State) and DeAirious Smith (6 catches, 109 yards, 2 touchdowns at Tennessee Tech).

- Eastern Illinois pass defense has been one of the best in the nation this season as the Panthers currently rank eighth in the nation in the FCS allowing just 157.5 yards per game through the air. EIU has held five of its six opponents to less than 175 yards passing with two opponents passing for less than 100 yards. EIU has allowed just two touchdown passes in its last four games.
- Eastern Illinois has found a knack for making plays in the defensive backfield as the Panthers have climbed to 31st in the FCS and 1st in the OVC averaging 6.8 tackles for loss per game. Over the last two games, EIU's defense has racked up 21 tackles for loss for 94 yards with eight quarterback sacks. EIU had 11 tackles for loss in the win at Tennessee Tech and ten at Murray State. The last time EIU had double figure tackles for loss in backto-back games was October 2015 in games against Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri.
- Linebacker Colin Bohanek finished with 12 tackles in the Panthers game at Murray State. It was the second double figure tackle game this season for Bohanek who had a season high 14 tackles at Dayton. Bohanek is currently fourth in the OVC in tackles with 47. Last spring he was 10th in the OVC with 40 tackles, most among OVC freshmen.
- Jordan Miles continues to be disruptive in the backfield as the second year defensive lineman leads the OVC in both tackles for loss (9.5) and sacks (3.5). Miles had two tackles for loss at Murray State after earning OVC Defensive Player of the Week for his performance at Tennessee Tech (3 sacks, 2 forced fumbles). Miles has 24 tackles this season with six quarterback hurries and a blocked kick.
- Tim Varga finished with 1.5 sacks in the Panthers game at Murray State as the defensive lineman is tied for the OVC lead for sacks at 3.5 with teammate Jordan Miles. Varga is fourth on the Panthers team with 27 tackles including five tackles for loss and six quarterback hurries. Varga had one career sack in 16 career games entering the season.
- Eastern Illinois defense forced three turnovers in the game at Murray State as the Panthers now have nine turnovers gained this season to rank 37th in the FCS. EIU has three interceptions and six fumble recoveries this season. The Panthers defense has forced seven of those nine turnovers in the last two games. On the season EIU has scored 22 points off of the nine turnovers. EIU's opponents this season have scored 36 points off ten EIU turnovers.
- EIU punter Logen Neidhardt averaged 38.2 yards per punt during five punt attempts at Murray State. His long punt on the day was 52 yards as the graduate transfer has nine punts this season over 50 yards with a long of 72. He pinned another two punts inside the 20-yard line giving him 12 of 29 punts inside the 20 this year. Neidhardt is averaging 43.3 yards per punt with the school record 44.6 by Kevin Cook in 2007.
- EIU's kick return defense continues to rank among the nation's best this season. The Panthers are currently sixth in the FCS in kick return defense allowing 13.6 yards per kick return. EIU kicker Daniel Luoma has been a big part of that success averaging 60.7 yards per kick with seven touchbacks. Last spring EIU ranked second in the FCS allowing opponents just 10.31 per kick return.
- Eastern Illinois has blocked two kicks this season with one blocked punt and one blocked field goal. The Panthers blocked punt was against Illinois State by Charles Shelton IV with the block returned for a touchdown by DeAirious Smith. The blocked field goal was also against Illinois State by Jordan Miles. Last spring EIU had three blocked kicks leading to one touchdown and one safety. Under head coach Adam Cushing, EIU's special teams have seven blocked kicks over the last three seasons.
- Saturday will mark the 98th time that Eastern Illinois will face a nationally ranked team as the Panthers play No. 17/16 UT Martin. EIU is 25-72 all-time against nationally ranked teams. EIU's last win over a nationally ranked team was Sept. 30, 2017 vs. Tennessee State (W, 19-16 in ot). This will be the second time EIU has faced a nationally ranked UT Martin squad, the other was a 15-9 loss in 2006 when UTM was ranked 12th.

- Chris Katrenick entered the game at Murray State in the second quarter following an injury to starter Otto Kuhns. Katrenick finished the contest 12-of-35 for 175 yards with a 54-yard touchdown strike to Arron Foulkes. For the season Katrenick has now passed for 364 yards with two starts at South Carolina and Dayton. He is 37-of-83.
- Harrison Bey-Buie rushed for 41 yards on 13 carries at Murray State. For the season the freshman running back leads EIU with 249 yards to rank 8th in the OVC. Bey-Buie's top game this season was 79 yards at Tennessee Tech.
- DeAirious Smith finished with four catches for 48 yards at Murray State giving the second year wide receiver ten receptions for 157 yards over the last two games. Smith had two touchdown receptions in the win at Tennessee Tech. He leads EIU with three total touchdowns with a blocked punt return for touchdown against Illinois State. Last year at UT Martin, Smith blocked a punt that resulted in a safety.
- After leading the nation in fourth down attempts the last two seasons, the Panthers are once again among the nation's leaders in fourth down attempts this season. EIU currently ranks seventh in the FCS with 17 4th down attempts this year, converting on seven of those for a 41 percent success rate. EIU had 82 4th down attempts in head coach Adam Cushing's first two seasons, the most in the FCS.
- Robbie Lofton leads the Panthers in receptions with 15 this season giving him 54 career receptions. He had one catch at Murray State and now caught at least one pass in nine straight games dating back to last season including four games with multiple catches and three games with touchdowns.
- Eastern Illinois made an adjustment on its offensive line midway through the Panthers game at Dayton switching Ivan Gleyzer and Ben Solomon on the offensive line. Gleyzer has started at center with Solomon playing guard. In the three games since the change EIU is averaging 289 yards per game in offense allowing just four sacks. EIU is also averaging 19.3 points per game in those three contests.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing its annual Hall of Fame Game on Saturday against UT Martin with classes for both 2020 and 2021 being inducted this weekend. The 2020 Hall of Fame Class includes former EIU football standouts Vincent Webb and Adam Drake as part of the class being inducted. Class of 2020: R.C. Johnson (Admin), Chandra Golden (Track), Olivia Klaus (XC/Track)... Class of 2021: Amber May (Softball), Reynae Hutchinson (SB/Volleyball), Todd Moroney (XC/Track), Devon Bissell (W Soccer) and Betty Ralston (Coach).
- Eastern Illinois has 12 players on its current roster that have already completed their undergraduate degree and are playing as graduate students this fall. The list includes Ben Solomon, Isaiah Hill, James Ubaike and Steven Frank who all completed their undergraduate degrees at EIU. Joining that list as graduates from other schools now playing at EIU are Jay Vallie, Elijah Benoit, Justin Growel, Chris Katrenick, Logen Neidhardt, Markenzy Pierre, Tyler Ringwood and Kobe Rodgers.
- Ben Solomon was a nominee for this year's Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Solomon was one of three nominee's from the Ohio Valley Conference and 17 players from the FCS ranks. Solomon has been a leader for the Panthers Uplifting Athletes Chapter spearheading two campaigns over the last two summers (Walk for Life & Lift for Life).
- Eastern Illinois has a strong tradition of NFL players as several former Panthers get opened the NFL season last weekend. Former Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo is with the San Francisco 49ers while linebacker Kamu Grugier-Hill plays with the Houston Texans. In addition the Panthers have alumni serving in administrative and coaching roles with New Orleans Saints head coach Sean Payton, Chicago Bears general manager Ryan Pace and Houston Texans offensive coordinator Tim Kelly. EIU was once again the only school in the nation with an alumnus as an NFL general manager, head coach and starting quarterback on opening day.

EIU HEAD COACH ADAM CUSHING

Adam Cushing was hired as the 25th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Dec. 9, 2018. A Chicago native, Cushing made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as the Panthers brought in more than 40 new players that first season with a majority from the state of Illinois. Cushing came to EIU following a 15-year stint as an assistant coach at Northwestern where he coached the offensive line since 2009. UT MARTIN HEAD COACH JASON SIMPSON

Jason Simpson is currently the longest tenured head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference entering his 16th season with UT Martin. In his debut season of 2006, Simpson earned OVC Coach of the Year honors as he led the Skyhawks to a share of the OVC Championship and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance. He has posted a record of 94-78 with an OVC mark of 73-46. In 2019 he became UTM's career leader in coaching wins and currently ranks fifth in OVC history. Simpson is a 1995 graduate of Southern Mississippi where he played baseball.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

UT Martin is off to a good start once again under head coach Jason Simpson as the Skyhawks have climbed into the FCS National Rankings. Part of the success has been behind the play of quarterback Keon Howard who ranks 25th in the FCS in total offense with 287 rushing yards and 1,022 passing yards. Howard has six rushing touchdowns and eight touchdown passes. The defense has been balanced with Deven Sims the team leader with 36 tackles. JaQuez Akins is the leader in sacks with three to go with 17 tackles.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will be meeting for the 27th time with UT Martin having won two straight in the series and four of the last five. EIU holds a 15-11 all-time series lead with the Panthers last win in the series coming in 2018, a 24-21 overtime win at O'Brien Field. UT Martin's last win in Charleston was Nov. 5, 2016 when the Skyhawks picked up a 33-17 win. EIU leads the all-time series at O'Briend Field. 9-3.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.



Brandon Easterling had a big punt return at the end of the quarter which set Dayton up with a short field that they converted into a field goal. EIU would score in the final minutes but failed on the onside kick attempt allowing Dayton to run out the clock.
