Panthers / Redbirds Meet In Mid-America Classic

Eastern Illinois (0-2) at Illinois State (1-1) Hancock Stadium (13,391) • Normal, Ill. September 17, 2022 • 6:30 p.m. • TV: Marquee Network / ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois and Illinois State will meet for the 110th time in the Mid-America Classic on Saturday night. The rivalry is the eighth longest played non-Ivy League FCS series between schools (16th overall among FCS schools counting Ivy League). The schools first met in 1901 with EIU winning 28-0. The schools began playing for a traveling trophy in the rivalry with the 100th meeting of the series on Sept. 1, 2011 (a 33-26 EIU win). The two schools have missed playing just three times since World War II in 1996 due to conference realignment, in 2001 due to 9/11 and in 2020 due to COVID.
- Eastern Illinois head coach Chris Wilkerson and Illinois State head coach Brock Spack have a long standing relationship. When Spack was an assistant coach at Eastern Illinois under head coach Bob Spoo, he recruited Wilkerson to play at Eastern Illinois in 1990. Spack served as Wilkerson's position group coach when Wilkerson redshirted the 1990 season at EIU before Spack left for an assistant coaching stop at Purdue.
- Jonah O'Brien passed for two touchdowns in Saturday's loss to No. 10 Chattanooga as he passed for 183 yards. O'Brien now has five touchdown passes this season which ranks him 12th in the FCS in touchdown passes. O'Brien has connected with five different receivers for touchdown passes. Last season EIU's offense had just eight touchdown passes for the entire season with four different players scoring with touchdown receptions.
- Punter Trey Wilhoit had a solid day for the Panthers against No. 10 Chattanooga as he had six punts for an average of 46 yards per punt. He had a long punt of 62 yards while pinning another punt inside the 20-yard line. In the season opener at Northern Illinois, Wilhoit had one punt for 54 yards. He is one punt attempt shy of qualifying for the national FCS leaders where he would rank tied for second at 47.1 yards per punt.
- Colin Bohanek led the Panthers defense with ten tackles against No. 10 Chattanooga including a first quarter interception that led to the opening EIU score. It was the second career interception for the sophomore linebacker. The ten tackles marked the fourth time Bohanek has recorded double digit tackles in his EIU career. Last year he was second in the OVC with 89 tackles.

- Stone Galloway continued his hot start to the season as he knocked home both field goal attempts on Saturday against Chattanooga. Galloway is now 4-for-4 this season having made eight straight dating back to last season. Galloway ranks second in the FCS for field goals made and is 48th in the FCS in scoring with 17 points. His long field goal this season was 44 yards coming in the second half against Chattanooga.
- Elijah Ball, a transfer from Purdue, made his first start of the season for EIU sliding in at the safety spot for the injured Kaelin Drakeford. Ball responded with four tackles in the game. He made six tackles in his debut last week at Northern Illinois and currently ranks fifth on the team in tackles with ten, one of five Panthers currently in double figures.
- Tim Varga recorded 1.5 tackles for loss on Saturday against Chattanooga as part of his five tackle game against the Mocs. Last season Varga had six tackles for loss while tying for the team lead in sacks with four. Varga is one of the Panthers five team captains this season and was an Academic All-District selection last season. He has eight tackles and one pass break-up to go with his 1.5 tackles for loss this season.
- After rushing for 100 yards in the season opener at Northern Illinois, Markenzy Pierre was held to 66 yards on 17 carries on Saturday against Chattanooga. Pierre currently ranks 29th in the FCS in rushing yards and third in the OVC. He is averaging 5.4 yards per carry. Last season in eleven games Pierre rushed for 125 yards on 39 carries for a 3.2 yards per carry average.
- Justin Thomas was the Panthers leading receiver for the second straight game hauling in six passes for 39 yards against Chattanooga. Thomas leads EIU with 12 receptions for 122 yards this season with his 12 receptions ranking 23rd in the FCS. Thomas is a graduate transfer from Albion College where he earned Division III All-American honors last year and finished his career as the programs all-time leader in receiving yards and touchdown receptions.
- Eastern Illinois opened week one of the 2022 season going 8-of-12 on 3rd downs to rank second in the FCS. The Panthers were held to just 4-of-14 on 3rd down against Chattanooga last week but continue to lead the OVC in 3rd down conversions at 46.2 percent, a total that ranks 22nd in the FCS. Last season EIU converted at 25.2 percent on 3rd downs ranking 120th in the FCS.
- Eastern Illinois had two turnovers on Saturday against Chattanooga with a Colin Bohanek interception in the first quarter and Henry Woods Jr. fumble recovery in the third. EIU did not have any turnovers gained in the week one loss at Northern Illinois. Last season EIU ranked third in the OVC with 18 turnovers gained. The Panthers had five games with two or more turnovers gained in 2021.
- EIU had three pass break-ups on Saturday against Chattanooga as the Panthers now have eight for the season. Nick Coates, Russell Dandy and Mark Aitken all broke up a pass against the Mocs. Coates is now tied for the team lead in pass break-ups with Tyris Harvey with both players with two this season.
- Running back Jaelin Benefield went over the 900 yard mark for his career in Saturday's game with Chattanooga. Benefield now has 914 career yards serving as a versatile weapon able to both run and catch out of the backfield. As a freshmen in 2019 he was EIU's leading rusher with 402 yards. He battled injuries the next two seasons including the spring 2021 COVID year. Benefield has two career 100 yard games at EIU and would become the 30th back in Panther history over the 1,000 yard mark for his career.
- Nile Hill and DeAirious Smith both hauled in touchdowns on Saturday against Chattanooga on their lone receptions of the evening. Hill caught a 31-yard pass while Smith hauled in a 16-yard pass. It was Hill's first career touchdown pass as the converted defensive back has caught five passes for 70 yards this season. It was the first game of the season for Smith who last season caught 14 passes for 209 yards and a team-high three touchdowns.
- Zay Gentry took over as the Panthers primary kick returner on Saturday against Chattanooga. Gentry had five returns for 72 yards for an average of 14.4 yards per return. His long return was 21 yards. Gentry also plays as a back-up safety and on EIU's kick coverage team making one tackle in the contest.
- Eastern Illinois won the time of possession battle for the second straight week holding the ball for 31:36 against Chattanooga. EIU is 41st in the FCS in time of possession at 31:02 per game.

2022 OVC Players of the Week

Sept. 4 - Stone Galloway (Special Teams)

- Eastern Illinois head coach Chris Wilkerson is familiar with the Mid-America Classic both as a player and an assistant coach with the Panthers as he embarks on his first rivalry game meeting as EIU's head coach. Wilkerson was 2-1-1 in the series as a player while posting a 2-3 record against Illinois State as an assistant coach. EIU assistant coaches Adam Gristick and DJ Bland also both appeared in four Mid-America Classic games each as players.
- Henry Woods Jr. helped EIU secure one of its two turnovers in Saturday's game against Chattanooga. Woods recovered a muffed punt in the second half which set up a Panthers third quarter field goal. Last season Woods appeared in six games primarily on special teams finishing the year with two tackles.
- Eastern Illinois offensive line has gained experience over the last couple of years with several players starting as true freshmen in 2019 and playing against more experienced defensive players. Three of EIU's projected starting linemen Elkhanan Tanelus, Chad Strickland and Anthony Imperio have all played for the last three years with Tanelus and Strickland set to be starters for their fourth seasons for the Panthers.
- EIU added five FBS transfers to the Panthers roster for this upcoming season. Joining EIU are quarterbacks Dom Shoffner (Charlotte) and Jonah O'Brien (Colorado State) along with Ira Armstead (Virginia) who transferred to EIU in the spring as a quarterback but has moved to wide receiver. On the defensive side EIU added Tre'jon Lewis (Texas Tech) and Elijah Ball (Purdue). The Panthers now have nine total FBS transfers on the roster.
- EIU added 12 junior college transfers to the roster this season with a number of them expected to make an immediate impact. Listed in the Panthers first two-deep of the season are incoming junior college players Max Stineman (OL), Terrance Shaw (OL), Colby Smith (DL), Braylon Willis (DL), Alexandar Oyawale (LB) and Trey Wilhoit (P).
- Eastern Illinois had six players named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team heading into this season. Wide receiver Isaiah Hill and tight end Jay Vallie were selected on the offensive side of the ball. Defensive linemen Jordan Miles and Tim Varga were joined on the defensive preseason All-OVC team by safety Jordan Vincent and corner Russell Dandy. Transfer Foday Jalloh was named a top newcomer to watch this season.
- Eastern Illinois has two legacy players on its roster this season with freshmen Carson Fichtel and Mike Smith Jr. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Smith's father Mike was a defensive back for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Both fathers were teammates of current EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson.
- Eastern Illinois football once again has jumped into the international pool of players as part of their 2022 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland. Last year, Luoma who is a reserve tight end served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks. The Panthers added Jaxson Isaac to the roster just before fall camp. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage last season. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2022 season as voted on by the team during the spring. Defensive players Jordan Vincent, Colin Bohanek and Tim Varga were selected along with offensive players Jaelin Benefield and Jay Vallie.
- The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrating its 75th anniversary this season and the conference football alignment has a new member with Lindenwood joining. EIU will host Lindenwood this year as the Panthers homecoming opponent on Oct. 15 but their meeting will not count as an OVC game due to a late adjustment to the OVC schedule and teams only playing five conference games. The OVC and Big South have announced a future scheduling agreement which will include schedules for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.
- Eastern Illinois football has seven players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Elijah Benoit, Bryce Dewberry, Isaiah Hill, Foday Jalloh, Markenzy Pierre, Justin Thomas and Jay Vallie. They are part of the 810 players at the FCS level competing this season with their degree already in-hand.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returns home and becomes the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 51-27 career record entering the 2022 season. ILLINOIS STATE HEAD COACH BROCK SPACK

Brock Spack is in his 14th year as head coach at Illinois State coaching the Redbirds. Spack is a former assistant coach at Eastern Illinois where he worked under former head coach Bob Spoo. Spack is 8-4 in previous meetings against EIU and has a 90-61 overall record, the 90 wins are the most in ISU history. He was an All-Big Ten linebacker for the Boilermakers in the early 1980's before embarking on a coaching career that has included stops at Eastern Illinois, Wyoming and Purdue. Spack has led ISU to five FCS playoff appearances including the 2014 FCS National Championship Game.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS STATE

Illinois State enters at 1-1 on the season with a loss at Big Ten member Wisconsin to open the year before a home win over Valparaiso last weekend. Zeke Vandenburgh leads an aggressive Redbirds defense with 22 tackles this season including four sacks. Dillon Gearhart has added three sacks and Sy Dabney two sacks. On offense running back Wenkers Wright has rushed for a team high 117 yards with quarterback Zack Annexstad passing for 382 yards.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Illinois State will be meeting for the 110th time in the Mid-America Classic. Illinois State leads the all-time series 58-42-9 and has won four straight in the series following a 31-24 Redbirds win in 2021. The two schools first met in 1901 with a 28-0 EIU victory and have met one time in the FCS playoffs with Illinois State winning that 2006 match-up 24-13. EIU and ISU did not meet in 2020 as both schools elected to only play conference games, it was the first time since 2001 that the two schools did not meet on the gridiron and only the third time since World War II (did not meet in 1996).

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

Eastern Illinois was the OVC's most successful school in terms of wins during the first decade of the 2000's as the Panthers posted 72 wins during that span. EIU leads the conference with the most post-season appearances since the Panthers joined the league in 1996.

COVID YOUTH

With the NCAA granting a COVID year of eligiblity to players active during the 2020 season, EIU was in a rebuilding phase so the Panthers have a large number of players who are listed as sophomores on their active roster. A total of 29 of those players are in their third year in the program with the added COVID year with an additional amount true sophomores in their second year in the program.

NCAA PLAYOFF APPEARANCES

Eastern Illinois football is bringing one of its own back home as Panthers Athletic Director Tom Michael has announced the hiring of Chris Wilkerson as the 26h head coach in EIU football history.

Wilkerson played for the Panthers from 1991-94 earning his degree from EIU in 1995. He began his coaching career on the staff of Bob Spoo working with the Panthers from 1995-2001. He led the special teams unit all seven years and also had stints as defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and defensive line coach. The Panthers reached the NCAA FCS playoffs four times and won a pair of conference championships during his tenure. Wilkerson's defenses and special teams were regularly ranked in the national top 20 in numerous categories.

Wilkerson comes to EIU after a successful run as the head coach at the University of Chicago where he has posted winning seasons in seven of his eight seasons including an 8-2 record this past season with an offense that featured the leading rusher in Division III football. He has a 51-27 record in nine seasons as the UChicago head coach with the team not competing during the 2020 season due to COVID-19.

"I'm excited to welcome Chris Wilkerson back home as the next head football coach at Eastern Illinois," said Michael. "The passion with which Chris played the game as a Panther, the passion with which he speaks about EIU, show what a truly special place EIU is. He brings with him a proven track record of building a program with success on both sides of the football. I have no doubt that Chris will bring that same passion back to this program on the field when the Panthers suit up this fall."

"My family and I are extremely humbled and honored to be coming home to Eastern Illinois University and look forward to leading our football family into the future! This opportunity is something I have dreamed about since 1995. I understand the passion, and pride the EIU Football family has for our program. We understand the accomplishments of our football alumni as well as the storied tradition of Panther Football. Our staff will work tirelessly, thoughtfully and with passion to help our collegiate athletes reach their fullest potential," said Wilkerson. "Eastern Illinois University represents excellence in academics and athletics but most importantly excellent PEOPLE! I want to thank President Glassman, Joe Dively, Athletic Director Tom Michael, Deputy Athletic Director Mark Bonnstetter, Tony Romo and all those involved in the search process for this amazing opportunity and a chance to come HOME! I look forward to building relationships with our current players and reconnecting those Panther Football Alumni and together resurrecting our proud Football Tradition."

"Chris was on Coach Spoo's staff when I was a student-athlete. I thought very highly of him at that time and have followed his coaching career," said former EIU All-American quarterback and recent College Football Hall of Fame inductee Tony Romo. "He has the football knowledge on both sides of the ball that will enable the EIU program to be successful. He is the right person to lead our program and I'm excited to have him back home as our next head football coach."

"I am thrilled to learn of Chris Wilkerson being hired as head football coach at Eastern Illinois University. There is not anyone who has more invested in Panther football than Chris – having been a player; graduate assistant; full-time assistant; and defensive coordinator for the Panthers, Chris not only has an unparalleled knowledge of what it takes to be successful at EIU, his love and loyalty for Eastern athletics is real and authentic. Simply put, Chris Wilkerson is the right guy, with the right skill set, at the right time to lead Panther football. Chris, his wife Sharna and family will be wonderful representatives of Eastern Illinois University and Panther athletics as the "first family" of Panther football," said former EIU offensive coordinator and current Syracuse football Director of Player Personnel, Roy Wittke.

His teams have excelled on the field and in the class room at UChicago since Wilkerson took over the program in 2013. His first season the Maroons posted a 6-4 record including the second 4-0 start to a season in the program's modern era. He has guided the school through three different conference affiliations with a 39-15 record in conference play. In all Wilkerson has coached three Division III All-Americans, five Academic All-Americans, nine All-Region selections, four Conference Players of the Year and 94 All-Conference selections during his time at UChicago.

Prior to his arrival at UChicago, he previously served on Dartmouth College's coaching staff from 2005-13 and was named Associate Head Coach in 2007. During his tenure at Dartmouth, Wilkerson's broad range of responsibilities included defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator, running backs coach, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator. The team was ranked in the top 10 nationally in a number of categories, including punt return average, blocked kicks, individual rushing average and fewest fumbles lost. His pass defense ranked 14th in the country in his debut season.

Wilkerson coached the defense and special teams at San Jose State University from 2002-04. In 2003, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given annually to the nation's top assistant coach.

Wilkerson and his wife, Sharna (a former EIU softball player), have three children – Isabella. Pevton and Charlotte.
