EIU Opens Wilkerson Era At Northern Illinois

Eastern Illinois (1-10, 1-5 OVC) at Northern Illinois (9-5, 6-2 MAC) O'Brien Field (10,000) • DeKalb, Ill. September 1, 2022 • 7 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois begins the Chris Wilkerson era as the Panthers open the 2022 season at Northern Illinois. Wilkerson is a former EIU player (1991-94, 1995 graduate) who was hired as the 26th head coach in program history in January 2022. Wilkerson was an assistant coach under Bob Spoo from 1995-2001 and most recently served as the head coach at the University of Chicago posting a 51-27 record in nine seasons.
- Eastern Illinois will open the season against an FBS opponent for the fourth time in the last ten seasons when the Panthers kickoff at Northern Illinois on Thursday night. EIU last opened a season against an FBS opponent in 2018 at Arkansas. EIU played in 2014 at Minnesota after opening the 2013 season with a win at San Diego State. EIU has opened a season against an FBS opponent a total of 11 times with a 2-9 record in those openers (1996 win at Western Michigan).
- Eastern Illinois had six players named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team heading into this season. Wide receiver Isaiah Hill and tight end Jay Vallie were selected on the offensive side of the ball. Defensive linemen Jordan Miles and Tim Varga were joined on the defensive preseason All-OVC team by safety Jordan Vincent and corner Russell Dandy. Transfer Foday Jalloh was named a top newcomer to watch this season.
- Eastern Illinois led the Ohio Valley Conference in team tackles for loss last season making 71 which ranked 33rd in the FCS during the regular season. The Panthers return the two OVC co-leaders in individual tackles for loss from last season in linebacker Colin Bohanek and defensive end Jordan Miles. Both players had 11 tackles for loss to tie for the conference lead. Bohanek was also second on both the EIU roster and OVC in total tackles with 89.
- Wide receiver Isaiah Hill ended last season with three straight games with double figure catches and 100 or more yards receiving. After missing a large portion of the year with injury he returned in the final five games and led EIU with 39 catches for 493 yards. Hill became the 34th player in program history to pass the 1,000 yard receiving mark for his career and enters the 2022 season ranked 29th on the career chart with 1,062 yards on 96 receptions with 14 touchdowns.

- Eastern Illinois scored three non-offensive touchdowns last season as the Panthers had a total of 20 touchdowns overall for the season. Bryce Dewberry had a 90 yard fumble return for touchdown in the road win at Tennessee Tech. Tyris Harvey had a 29 yard interception return for touchdown at Austin Peay. DeAirious Smith returned a block punt seven yards against Illinois State for a special teams touchdown.
- Tim Varga and Jordan Miles both tied for the team lead in sacks last season with both player recording four which ranked both players tied for fourth in the OVC. Varga had 46 total tackles for the year ranking fourth on the team while Miles was sixth with 38 tackles. Colin Bohanek was the only other player on the EIU roster with more than one sack last season finishing with 3.5. As a team EIU had 16 sacks for a total of 117 yards spread among eight players.
- Running back Jaelin Benefield was limited to only four games played last season due to an early season injury. Benefield finished with 171 yards to rank second on the team while catching eight passes for 29 yards. When healthy during the 2019 and 2020 seasons he was the team's leading rusher and second leading receiver in 2019. He was second on the team in rushing yards in the COVID shortened 2020 season. For his career Benefield has rushed for 831 yards and six touchdowns. He has caught 56 passes for 388 yards and two scores.
- Eastern Illinois offensive line has gained experience over the last couple of years with several players starting as true freshmen in 2019 and playing against more experienced defensive players. Three of EIU's projected starting linemen Elkhanan Tanelus, Chad Strickland and Anthony Imperio have all played for the last three years with Tanelus and Strickland set to be starters for their fourth seasons for the Panthers.
- Eastern Illinois defense ranked third in the OVC last season in turnovers gained as the Panthers finished the year with 18 turnovers gained. The Panthers had four interceptions and 14 fumble recoveries. Russell Dandy returns as the team leader with two interceptions. Bryce Dewberry and Blake Ruffin return as the team leaders with two fumble recoveries each.
- Eastern Illinois managed just four interceptions last season but the Panthers did provide good pass coverage with 30 pass break-ups. Tyris Harvey was the team leader with six pass break-ups and one interception returned for a touchdown at Austin Peay. Blake Ruffin was second on the team with five pass break-ups. Six total EIU players had multiple pass break-ups last season.
- Defensive back Mark Aitken will be heading back to face his former school in the season opener. Aitken began his college career playing at Northern Illinois starting in the 2019 season opener before suffering a season ending injury. After not playing in the COVID 2020 season he returned to the field suiting up for EIU in 2021 making 21 tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and four pass break-ups.
- Following Isaiah Hill in the line-up, EIU lost its next three top pass catchers from last season. DeAirious Smith and DeWayne Cooks both return after ranking fifth and sixth on the team in receptions last season for a combined 27 receptions for 350 yards and three touchdowns. EIU does regain the services of tight end Jay Vallie who missed 2021 due to injury. The graduate transfer from Dayton was the Panthers top receiver during the 2020 COVID shortened season with 18 receptions for 190 yards and three touchdowns.
- EIU added five FBS transfers to the Panthers roster for this upcoming season. Joining EIU are quarterbacks Dom Shoffner (Charlotte) and Jonah O'Brien (Colorado State) along with Ira Armstead (Virginia) who transferred to EIU in the spring as a quarterback but has moved to wide receiver. On the defensive side EIU added Tre'jon Lewis (Texas Tech) and Elijah Ball (Purdue). The Panthers now have nine total FBS transfers on the roster.
- EIU added 12 junior college transfers to the roster this season with a number of them expected to make an immediate impact. Listed in the Panthers first two-deep of the season are incoming junior college players Max Stineman (OL), Terrance Shaw (OL), Colby Smith (DL), Braylon Willis (DL), Alexandar Oyawale (LB) and Trey Wilhoit (P).
- Eastern Illinois will be looking to snap a four game season opening losing streak when they kickoff the season on Thursday at Northern Illinois. EIU's last season opening win was in 2017 when the Panthers beat Indiana State 22-20 on a last second touchdown pass. EIU is 1-7 in openers since the 2013 season when EIU had run off a streak of three straight season opening wins in 2011, 2012 and 2013.

- Stone Galloway had two field goals in the Panthers final game of 2021 against Murray State hitting from 28 and 30 yards. For the season he was 8-of-13 making his last four kicks and six of his last seven attempts. His season long was 44 yards against Illinois State. Galloway is 13-of-20 for his career and needs three field goals this season to move into the EIU career top ten. Galloway led the Panthers in scoring last season with 38 points marking the first time since the 2014 season that a kicker had led EIU in scoring (Nick Bruno).
- Zach Weir returns as the most experienced quarterback on the EIU roster after appearing in four games last season with one start. He passed for 386 yards and one touchdown. EIU has two transfer quarterbacks on the roster in Jonah O'Brien and Dom Shoffner. O'Brien began his career at EIU and was on the roster at Colorado State the last two years. As a freshman in 2019 he passed for 84 yards in one game at EIU. Shoffner transferred from Charlotte where he last played in 2020 passing for 32 yards. He began his career in 2018 at North Carolina Central passing for passing 350 yards and then had one year in junior college.
- Eastern Illinois has two legacy players on its roster this season with freshmen Carson Fichtel and Mike Smith Jr. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Smith's father Mike was a defensive back for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Both fathers were teammates of current EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson.
- Eastern Illinois football once again has jumped into the international pool of players as part of their 2022 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland. Last year, Luoma who is a reserve tight end served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks. The Panthers added Jaxson Isaac to the roster just before fall camp. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage last season. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing a FBS team for the 44th time when the Panthers kickoff the season on Thursday night. EIU is 6-37 all-time in previous games against FBS opponents. Five of the six FBS wins for EIU have come against teams in the Mid-American Conference including the most recent, a 21-17 win at Miami (Ohio) in 2016. EIU has additional FBS wins against Akron (1989), Western Michigan (1996), Northern Illinois (1998), Eastern Michigan (2004) and San Diego State (2013).
- Eastern Illinois head coach Chris Wilkerson has faced Northern Illinois on two other occasions while at EIU. He was a player on the Panthers 1994 team that lost at NIU. He was an assistant coach on the 1998 team that beat Northern Illinois, 24-10. EIU assistant coaches Adam Gristick and DJ Bland were both starters on the Panthers 2013 team that lost a thrilling game at Northern Illinois. EIU was led by quarterback Jimmy Garoppolo, the 2013 Walter Payton Award winner, while NIU was led by quarterback Jordan Lynch, a candidate for the Heisman Trophy that season.
- Eastern Illinois will be opening the football season on a Thursday night for the 20th time in school history. The Panthers are 11-8 in those previous Thursday night season openers including 10-5 against FCS programs. EIU's last Thursday night opener was in 2019 when the Panthers opened the season at Chattanooga. EIU's last Thursday night opening win was in 2017 when EIU beat Indiana State, 22-20 with a last second touchdown pass.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2022 season as voted on by the team during the spring. Defensive players Jordan Vincent, Colin Bohanek and Tim Varga were selected along with offensive players Jaelin Benefield and Jay Vallie.
- The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrating its 75th anniversary this season and the conference football alignment has a new member with Lindenwood joining. EIU will host Lindenwood this year as the Panthers homecoming opponent on Oct. 15 but their meeting will not count as an OVC game due to a late adjustment to the OVC schedule and teams only playing five conference games. The OVC and Big South have announced a future scheduling agreement which will include schedules for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.
- Eastern Illinois football has six players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The six graduate players are Elijah Benoit, Isaiah Hill, Foday Jalloh, Markenzy Pierre, Justin Thomas and Jay Vallie. They are part of the 810 players at the FCS level competing this season with their degree already in-hand.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returns home and becomes the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 51-27 career record entering the 2022 season. NORTHERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH THOMAS HAMMOCK

Thomas Hammock enters his fourth season leading his alma mater with the Huskies coming off an appearance in the Tailgreeter Cure Bowl and Mid-American Conference Championship. A former running back at Northern Illinois, Hammock was a long time assistant coach with stops in the Big Ten at Wisconsin and Minnesota along with a stint in the NFL with the Baltimore Ravens. He is a 2002 graduate of NIU and enters the 2022 season with a 14-18 career record.

SCOUTING NORTHERN ILLINOIS

Northern Illinois is coming off a 9-5 season where the Huskies were the Mid-American Conference Champions and played Coastal Carolina in the Tailgreeter Cure Bowl. Quarterback Rocky Lombardi passed for nearly 2,600 yards last season with 15 touchdowns and is on the preseason Unitas Award Watch list. He returns two of his top three targets from last year in Trayvon Rudolph (51 rec/892 yds/7 TD) and Cole Tucker (41 rec/575 yds/3 TD). C.J. Brown the Huskies leading tackler last year with 109 tackles returns to guide the defense.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Northern Illinois will be meeting for the 38th time when the two schools kickoff the 2022 season Thursday night. NIU holds a 26-10-1 all-time lead in the series with five of the contests played against the Huskies as an FBS member. EIU does have one win over NIU at the FBS level, a 24-10 win in DeKalb in 1998. NIU has won eight of the last night meetings which date back to the time when the schools were both members of the IIAC.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

OVC SUCCESS

Eastern Illinois was the OVC's most successful school in terms of wins during the first decade of the 2000's as the Panthers posted 72 wins during that span. EIU leads the conference with the most post-season appearances since the Panthers joined the league in 1996.

COVID YOUTH

Eastern Illinois football is bringing one of its own back home as Panthers Athletic Director Tom Michael has announced the hiring of Chris Wilkerson as the 26h head coach in EIU football history.

Wilkerson played for the Panthers from 1991-94 earning his degree from EIU in 1995. He began his coaching career on the staff of Bob Spoo working with the Panthers from 1995-2001. He led the special teams unit all seven years and also had stints as defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and defensive line coach. The Panthers reached the NCAA FCS playoffs four times and won a pair of conference championships during his tenure. Wilkerson's defenses and special teams were regularly ranked in the national top 20 in numerous categories.

Wilkerson comes to EIU after a successful run as the head coach at the University of Chicago where he has posted winning seasons in seven of his eight seasons including an 8-2 record this past season with an offense that featured the leading rusher in Division III football. He has a 51-27 record in nine seasons as the UChicago head coach with the team not competing during the 2020 season due to COVID-19.

"I'm excited to welcome Chris Wilkerson back home as the next head football coach at Eastern Illinois," said Michael. "The passion with which Chris played the game as a Panther, the passion with which he speaks about EIU, show what a truly special place EIU is. He brings with him a proven track record of building a program with success on both sides of the football. I have no doubt that Chris will bring that same passion back to this program on the field when the Panthers suit up this fall."

"My family and I are extremely humbled and honored to be coming home to Eastern Illinois University and look forward to leading our football family into the future! This opportunity is something I have dreamed about since 1995. I understand the passion, and pride the EIU Football family has for our program. We understand the accomplishments of our football alumni as well as the storied tradition of Panther Football. Our staff will work tirelessly, thoughtfully and with passion to help our collegiate athletes reach their fullest potential," said Wilkerson. "Eastern Illinois University represents excellence in academics and athletics but most importantly excellent PEOPLE! I want to thank President Glassman, Joe Dively, Athletic Director Tom Michael, Deputy Athletic Director Mark Bonnstetter, Tony Romo and all those involved in the search process for this amazing opportunity and a chance to come HOME! I look forward to building relationships with our current players and reconnecting those Panther Football Alumni and together resurrecting our proud Football Tradition."

"Chris was on Coach Spoo's staff when I was a student-athlete. I thought very highly of him at that time and have followed his coaching career," said former EIU All-American quarterback and recent College Football Hall of Fame inductee Tony Romo. "He has the football knowledge on both sides of the ball that will enable the EIU program to be successful. He is the right person to lead our program and I'm excited to have him back home as our next head football coach."

"I am thrilled to learn of Chris Wilkerson being hired as head football coach at Eastern Illinois University. There is not anyone who has more invested in Panther football than Chris – having been a player; graduate assistant; full-time assistant; and defensive coordinator for the Panthers, Chris not only has an unparalleled knowledge of what it takes to be successful at EIU, his love and loyalty for Eastern athletics is real and authentic. Simply put, Chris Wilkerson is the right guy, with the right skill set, at the right time to lead Panther football. Chris, his wife Sharna and family will be wonderful representatives of Eastern Illinois University and Panther athletics as the "first family" of Panther football," said former EIU offensive coordinator and current Syracuse football Director of Player Personnel, Roy Wittke.

His teams have excelled on the field and in the class room at UChicago since Wilkerson took over the program in 2013. His first season the Maroons posted a 6-4 record including the second 4-0 start to a season in the program's modern era. He has guided the school through three different conference affiliations with a 39-15 record in conference play. In all Wilkerson has coached three Division III All-Americans, five Academic All-Americans, nine All-Region selections, four Conference Players of the Year and 94 All-Conference selections during his time at UChicago.

Prior to his arrival at UChicago, he previously served on Dartmouth College's coaching staff from 2005-13 and was named Associate Head Coach in 2007. During his tenure at Dartmouth, Wilkerson's broad range of responsibilities included defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator, running backs coach, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator. The team was ranked in the top 10 nationally in a number of categories, including punt return average, blocked kicks, individual rushing average and fewest fumbles lost. His pass defense ranked 14th in the country in his debut season.

Wilkerson coached the defense and special teams at San Jose State University from 2002-04. In 2003, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given annually to the nation's top assistant coach.

Wilkerson and his wife, Sharna (a former EIU softball player), have three children – Isabella. Pevton and Charlotte.
