Panthers Return To OVC Play With Music City Trip

Eastern Illinois (2-4, 1-0 OVC) at Tennessee State (2-4, 1-0 OVC) Nissan Stadium (69,143) • Nashville, Tenn. October 22, 2022 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois played its first overtime contest since the 2018 season as the Panthers lost in double overtime to OVC newcomer Lindenwood, 37-34. The game was a non-conference contest between the two schools as EIU dropped to 2-4 on the season. EIU heads to Tennessee State this weekend as one of four teams that are currently undefeated in OVC play as EIU is 1-0 after a win at Murray State back on Sept. 24. EIU will face one of those other undefeated conference teams as TSU has won two straight and stands at 2-4 overall, 1-0 in the OVC. The other two undefeated OVC teams are UT Martin (3-0) and Southeast Missouri (2-0).
- Alexandar Oyawale was named the Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week after being part of a solid Panthers defensive effort that had five sacks and four turnovers gained. Oyawale had one of the five sacks in the contest and forced one of the turnovers with a forced fumble. In the fourth quarter he would scoop up another fumble and return it 40 yards for a touchdown. The last EIU player to return a fumble for a touchdown was Bryce Dewberry last year at Tennessee Tech.
- Trey Wilhoit was named the Ohio Valley Conference Special Teams Player of the Week earning the honor for the second time this year. Wilhoit had five punts in the game against Lindenwood averaging 43 yards per punt with a long of 59 yards. He pinned two punts inside the 20-yard line including one downed inside the 1-yard line. Wilhoit is 14th in the FCS this season in punting averaging 43.4 yards per punt with a long of 62 yards.
- Eastern Illinois forced multiple turnovers in a game for a the fourth straight game as the Panthers had four turnovers gained on Saturday against Lindenwood. EIU had two interceptions and two fumble recoveries, one which was returned for a touchdown. On the season EIU now has 16 turnovers gained which ranks fourth in the FCS this season. The national leader is Mercer with 18 followed by East Tennessee and Furman, both with 17.
- Quarterback Jonah O'Brien engineered three of the Panthers four touchdowns on Saturday against Lindenwood scoring on a pair of short rushing touchdowns and throwing for a third to DeAirious Smith. O'Brien was 14-of-21 passing in the game for 152 yards. For the season he ranks eighth in the FCS in completion percentage at 70 percent. He now has four rushing touchdowns this season tying him for the team lead with fellow quarterback Dom Shoffner.

- Eastern Illinois defense picked off multiple passes for the fourth straight game with two picks against Lindenwood. EIU has 11 interceptions this season which ranks third in the FCS. The school record for interceptions in a season is 31 set during the 1980 season. The last time EIU had four straight games with multiple interceptions was during the 2014 season when the Panthers had multiple interceptions against Ohio (2), Eastern Kentucky (2), Southeast Missouri (4) and Tennessee State (2). EIU finished the 2014 season with 15 interceptions.
- Stone Galloway knocked home both of his field goal attempts last Saturday against Lindenwood converting from 31 and 22 yards during the contest. Galloway is 8-for-8 this season and has made 12 straight field goals dating back to last season. He is currently one of just four kickers in the FCS that are perfect on field goals this year and leads that group with the most attempts. He is also perfect on extra points this year going 18-of-18 and leading EIU in scoring with 42 points.
- Ira Armstead served as the Panthers primary kick returner on Saturday against Lindenwood with two kick returns including one for 42 yards. Armstead came to EIU last spring as a transfer quarterback from Virginia. This fall he converted to a wide receiver and has seen some playing time over the past two weeks at corner including a start at that spot against Lindenwood. Armstead is the fourth different player to serve as the primary kick returner in a game this season.
- Jack Valente has become one of the Panthers most versatile lineman as he started at his third different spot in the offensive line this past weekend against Lindenwood. Due to injuries at several different spots Valente has had to slide in to start games at both center and tackle in addition to his normal starting spot at guard. In addition Valente serves as the long snapper for the Panthers field goal and punt units.
- Preseason All-OVC selection Isaiah Hill returned to the Panthers line-up for the first time this season in the game against Lindenwood. Hill missed the first five games of the season due to an injury suffered late in fall camp. Hill made an immediate impact leading EIU with five catches for 77 yards in the game. The five receptions pushed him over the 100 career catch mark at EIU while he moved up to 25th on the EIU career receiving yards list.
- Joel Barrows collected one of the Panthers five sacks on Saturday against Lindenwood forcing the fumble that was scooped up by Alexandar Oyawale and returned for a touchdown. Barrows finished the game with four total tackles adding two quarterback hurries. Barrows is now tied for the team lead for sacks with Cameron Leach with two. Leach recorded his second sack of the season against Lindenwood as part of his three tackle day.
- After recording just two sacks in their first four games of the season, EIU's defense has registered nine sacks over the last two weeks with four against Northwestern State and five against Lindenwood. EIU's last five sack game was last season in the OVC road win at Tennessee Tech. The last time EIU had four or more sacks in back-to-back games was during the 2017 season against Tennessee Tech (Oct. 7 / 5 sacks) and Murray State (Oct. 14 / 4 sacks).
- Eastern Illinois had two players Nick Coates and Tyris Harvey both finish with ten tackles on Saturday against Lindenwood. It was the second straight game that Coates has tied for the team lead in tackles as he now ranks fourth on the EIU defense with 36 tackles. Harvey is now sixth on the EIU roster with 20 tackles this season. The last time EIU had multiple players finish with double figure tackles was the final game of the 2021 season when Jason Johnson and Colin Bohanek each had double figures.
- Colin Bohanek had one of EIU's two interceptions on Saturday against Lindenwood as the linebacker finished the game with six tackles. It was the second interception of the season for Bohanek who is tied for second on the team in interceptions. Last season he was tied for the OVC lead in tackles for loss and this season ranks as the Panthers leader in that category with 4.5 TFL. He is second on the team with 43 tackles.
- Eastern Illinois played the seventh double overtime game in program history this past weekend in its game with Lindenwood. EIU's last double overtime game was a 27-24 win over Murray State in 2017. The loss to Lindenwood snapped a three game double overtime win streak by the Panthers as they are now 3-4 all-time in double overtime contests. EIU played three overtime games during the 2017 season winning all three including two in double overtime.
- Eastern Illinois is riding a four game win streak over Tennessee State in games played at Nissan Stadium as the Panthers prepare to visit Nashville this weekend. Three of those four wins have come in overtime against TSU with EIU winning in 2017 (20t), 2015 (0t) and 2010 (0t). The last EIU loss at Nissan Stadium was in 2008, a 45-24 TSU win. All time EIU is 7-3 against TSU when facing the Tigers in the Tennessee Titans home.
- Former Eastern Illinois player Tim Kelly is currently the passing game coordinator for the Tennessee Titans.

- Kicker Stone Galloway was among a group of six FCS kickers recognized for their performances in September on the Fred Mitchell Award Watch List. Galloway is 8-for-8 on field goal attempts this season and 18-for-18 on extra points. He currently leads the Panthers in scoring with 42 points. Galloway has made 12 straight field goals dating back to last season. This season he ranks 17th in the FCS in field goals made and is tied for first in field goal percentage as one of four players that are perfect on field goal attempts this season. He now has 21 career field goals to rank 8th on the EIU career list.
- Eastern Illinois wide receiver Isaiah Hill was named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy released on Sept. 28. Hill is one of 37 candidates from the FCS level and two selected from the Ohio Valley Conference. Hill, a preseason All-OVC selection at wide receiver, earned his undergraduate degree in criminal justice and is currently enrolled in the MBA program. Hill made his first appearance of the 2022 season this past Saturday with five receptions for 77 yards. He went over the 100 career reception mark in the game and now has 101 receptions and 1,139 yards.
- Eastern Illinois offensive line has gained experience over the last couple of years with several players starting as true freshmen in 2019 and playing against more experienced defensive players. Three of EIU's projected starting linemen Elkhanan Tanelus, Chad Strickland and Anthony Imperio have all played for the last three years with Tanelus and Strickland set to be starters for their fourth seasons for the Panthers.
- EIU added five FBS transfers to the Panthers roster for this upcoming season. Joining EIU are quarterbacks Dom Shoffner (Charlotte) and Jonah O'Brien (Colorado State) along with Ira Armstead (Virginia) who transferred to EIU in the spring as a quarterback but has moved to wide receiver. On the defensive side EIU added Tre'jon Lewis (Texas Tech) and Elijah Ball (Purdue). The Panthers now have nine total FBS transfers on the roster.
- EIU added 12 junior college transfers to the roster this season with a number of them expected to make an immediate impact. Listed in the Panthers first two-deep of the season are incoming junior college players Max Stineman (OL), Terrance Shaw (OL), Colby Smith (DL), Braylon Willis (DL), Alexandar Oyawale (LB) and Trey Wilhoit (P).
- Eastern Illinois had six players named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team heading into this season. Wide receiver Isaiah Hill and tight end Jay Vallie were selected on the offensive side of the ball. Defensive linemen Jordan Miles and Tim Varga were joined on the defensive preseason All-OVC team by safety Jordan Vincent and corner Russell Dandy. Transfer Foday Jalloh was named a top newcomer to watch this season.
- Eastern Illinois has two legacy players on its roster this season with freshmen Carson Fichtel and Mike Smith Jr. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Smith's father Mike was a defensive back for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Both fathers were teammates of current EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson.
- Eastern Illinois football once again has jumped into the international pool of players as part of their 2022 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland. Last year, Luoma who is a reserve tight end served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks. The Panthers added Jaxson Isaac to the roster just before fall camp. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage last season. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2022 season as voted on by the team during the spring. Defensive players Jordan Vincent, Colin Bohanek and Tim Varga were selected along with offensive players Jaelin Benefield and Jay Vallie.
- The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrating its 75th anniversary this season and the conference football alignment has a new member with Lindenwood joining. EIU will host Lindenwood this year as the Panthers homecoming opponent on Oct. 15 but their meeting will not count as an OVC game due to a late adjustment to the OVC schedule and teams only playing five conference games. The OVC and Big South have announced a future scheduling agreement which will include schedules for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.
- Eastern Illinois football has seven players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Elijah Benoit, Bryce Dewberry, Isaiah Hill, Foday Jalloh, Markenzy Pierre, Justin Thomas and Jay Vallie. They are part of the 810 players at the FCS level competing this season with their degree already in-hand.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returns home and becomes the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 51-27 career record entering the 2022 season. TENNESSEE STATE HEAD COACH EDDIE GEORGE

Former Heisman Trophy winner and NFL running back Eddie George is in his second season as the head coach at Tennessee State. This is George's first coaching job and he has led the Tigers to a 7-10 record midway through his second season. He holds a 4-3 record in the OVC as the Tigers are off to a 1-0 start in league play. George was the 1995 Heisman Trophy winner playing at Ohio State. He would go on to have a long career primarily with the Tennessee Titans rushing for more than 10,000 career yards.

SCOUTING TENNESSEE STATE

Tennessee State opened the OVC season with a win over Tennessee Tech as the Tigers have won two straight heading into this weekend's game. TSU has regained the services of quarterback Draylen Ellis who has passed for 877 yards and rushed for another 94 accounting for eight touchdowns. Devon Starling and Jalen Rouse lead the Tigers running back group with Zach Dobson and Cam Wyche the top receiving targets. The defense is led by Jahsun Bryant with 36 tackles while Tadarrius Patterson has 5.5 tackles for loss and 3 sacks.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State will be meeting for the 26th time as this year's game will return to Nissan Stadium. EIU last played TSU in the downtown NFL stadium in 2017, a double overtime Panthers win. EIU holds a 15-10 all-time lead in the series but TSU has won the last two in the series and three of the last four meetings. Prior to a TSU win in 2018, EIU had won six straight in the series.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

Eastern Illinois football is bringing one of its own back home as Panthers Athletic Director Tom Michael has announced the hiring of Chris Wilkerson as the 26h head coach in EIU football history.

Wilkerson played for the Panthers from 1991-94 earning his degree from EIU in 1995. He began his coaching career on the staff of Bob Spoo working with the Panthers from 1995-2001. He led the special teams unit all seven years and also had stints as defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and defensive line coach. The Panthers reached the NCAA FCS playoffs four times and won a pair of conference championships during his tenure. Wilkerson's defenses and special teams were regularly ranked in the national top 20 in numerous categories.

Wilkerson comes to EIU after a successful run as the head coach at the University of Chicago where he has posted winning seasons in seven of his eight seasons including an 8-2 record this past season with an offense that featured the leading rusher in Division III football. He has a 51-27 record in nine seasons as the UChicago head coach with the team not competing during the 2020 season due to COVID-19.

"I'm excited to welcome Chris Wilkerson back home as the next head football coach at Eastern Illinois," said Michael. "The passion with which Chris played the game as a Panther, the passion with which he speaks about EIU, show what a truly special place EIU is. He brings with him a proven track record of building a program with success on both sides of the football. I have no doubt that Chris will bring that same passion back to this program on the field when the Panthers suit up this fall."

"My family and I are extremely humbled and honored to be coming home to Eastern Illinois University and look forward to leading our football family into the future! This opportunity is something I have dreamed about since 1995. I understand the passion, and pride the EIU Football family has for our program. We understand the accomplishments of our football alumni as well as the storied tradition of Panther Football. Our staff will work tirelessly, thoughtfully and with passion to help our collegiate athletes reach their fullest potential," said Wilkerson. "Eastern Illinois University represents excellence in academics and athletics but most importantly excellent PEOPLE! I want to thank President Glassman, Joe Dively, Athletic Director Tom Michael, Deputy Athletic Director Mark Bonnstetter, Tony Romo and all those involved in the search process for this amazing opportunity and a chance to come HOME! I look forward to building relationships with our current players and reconnecting those Panther Football Alumni and together resurrecting our proud Football Tradition."

"Chris was on Coach Spoo's staff when I was a student-athlete. I thought very highly of him at that time and have followed his coaching career," said former EIU All-American quarterback and recent College Football Hall of Fame inductee Tony Romo. "He has the football knowledge on both sides of the ball that will enable the EIU program to be successful. He is the right person to lead our program and I'm excited to have him back home as our next head football coach."

"I am thrilled to learn of Chris Wilkerson being hired as head football coach at Eastern Illinois University. There is not anyone who has more invested in Panther football than Chris – having been a player; graduate assistant; full-time assistant; and defensive coordinator for the Panthers, Chris not only has an unparalleled knowledge of what it takes to be successful at EIU, his love and loyalty for Eastern athletics is real and authentic. Simply put, Chris Wilkerson is the right guy, with the right skill set, at the right time to lead Panther football. Chris, his wife Sharna and family will be wonderful representatives of Eastern Illinois University and Panther athletics as the "first family" of Panther football," said former EIU offensive coordinator and current Syracuse football Director of Player Personnel, Roy Wittke.

His teams have excelled on the field and in the class room at UChicago since Wilkerson took over the program in 2013. His first season the Maroons posted a 6-4 record including the second 4-0 start to a season in the program's modern era. He has guided the school through three different conference affiliations with a 39-15 record in conference play. In all Wilkerson has coached three Division III All-Americans, five Academic All-Americans, nine All-Region selections, four Conference Players of the Year and 94 All-Conference selections during his time at UChicago.

Prior to his arrival at UChicago, he previously served on Dartmouth College's coaching staff from 2005-13 and was named Associate Head Coach in 2007. During his tenure at Dartmouth, Wilkerson's broad range of responsibilities included defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator, running backs coach, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator. The team was ranked in the top 10 nationally in a number of categories, including punt return average, blocked kicks, individual rushing average and fewest fumbles lost. His pass defense ranked 14th in the country in his debut season.

Wilkerson coached the defense and special teams at San Jose State University from 2002-04. In 2003, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given annually to the nation's top assistant coach.

Wilkerson and his wife, Sharna (a former EIU softball player), have three children – Isabella. Pevton and Charlotte.
