Panthers Senior Day May Have Playoff Implications

Eastern Illinois vs. Tennessee State O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. November 11, 2023 • 12 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State meet on Saturday at O'Brien Field with both teams still eying a possible at-large bid to the FCS playoffs at the end of the month. EIU clinched its first winning season since the 2017 campaign with a road win at Lindenwood last Saturday improving to 6-3 on the season, 2-2 in the Big South-OVC. Tennessee State had its four-game win streak snapped with a road loss at Charleston Southern as the Tigers fell to 6-3 overall, 2-2 in the Big South-OVC. Both teams enter the week receiving votes in the two major FCS Top 25 polls.
- Eastern Illinois defense came up with three turnovers gained on Saturday as the Panthers are once again tied for the national lead in takeaways this season with 23 (tied with Richmond). EIU had three interceptions in the game marking the third time this season that they have three or more picks in a game with a season high of four in the opener at Indiana State. The Panthers have been balanced in their types of turnovers with 13 interceptions and ten fumble recoveries. It is the highest team turnovers gained total since the 2015 season when EIU ranked second in the nation with 31 turnovers gained.
- Blake Ruffin added his fourth interception of the season in the fourth quarter at Lindenwood as he has the most interceptions in a season since Jourdan Wickliffe had five picks during the 2015 season. Ruffin leads the Big South-OVC in interceptions and is fourth in the FCS. The sophomore safety has also been one of the Panthers top tacklers this year with 57 tackles which ranks second on the team. 39 of those 57 tackles have been solo stops which is sixth in the league. Ruffin has tacked on four tackles for loss, one sack, three pass break-ups, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery to his season totals.
- Pierce Holley passed for more than 240 yards for the fifth consecutive game and the eighth time this season as the Panthers picked up a 16-10 road win at Lindenwood. Holley was 18-of-34 for 245 yards including one touchdown pass. The graduate transfer ranks 11th in the FCS in passing yards with 2,394 and needs 189 more this season to crack the EIU single season top ten. He is 33rd in the FCS with 14 touchdown passes. Including his two years as a starter at Georgetown, Holley has passed for 6,571 career yards (14th among active FCS OBs) and 35 career touchdowns.
- Russell Dandy added two more pass break-ups to his season total as the fifth year player continues to be one of the top corners in the Big South-OVC this season. Dandy now has 15 pass break-ups this season which ties him for second on the EIU single season record list, one behind record holder Ben Brown (2004). With his one interception this season added in, Dandy currently ranks second in the FCS in passes defended. A preseason All-Conference player, Dandy has 30 tackles this season with two fumble recoveries.

- Eastern Illinois defense was able to get home to the quarterback on Saturday at Lindenwood as the Panthers recorded a season-high six sacks in the contest. It was the highest number of sacks in a game for EIU since the Panthers had six on Oct. 31, 2009 against Murray State. EIU's season high last season was five sacks also against Lindenwood. Phoenix Porter led the way in the game with two sacks while Nicholas Oliveira-Chace had 1.5 sacks. Drake Van Hyfte and Colby Smith were each credited with a solo sack while Joel Barrows had a half-sack. EIU now has 18 teams sacks with Porter and Barrows tied for the team lead with three each.
- Junior wide receiver Eli Mirza continues to be one of the Panthers most consistent receivers this year as he was tied for the team lead with five receptions on Saturday at Lindenwood. Mirza had five catches for 73 yards and one score. For the season Mirza leads the Panthers in both receptions (50) and receiving yards (566) with both totals ranking fourth in the Big South-OVC. He is 26th nationally in receptions.
- Justin Thomas had five receptions for 82 yards on Saturday at Lindenwood as the former NCAA Division III All-American has now caught at least one pass in 34 consecutive games. Thomas has 32 catches for 421 yards with four touchdowns this season. He ranks 11th among all active college football players with 3,235 receiving yards and in the top 20 in both career receptions (211) and touchdowns (46).
- Team captain Mark Aitken had his best day as a kick returner this season on Saturday at Lindenwood with two returns for 71 yards including a season long return of 52 yards. Aitken is averaging 22 yards per return for his career and needs 72 more yards to move into the EIU career top ten for kick return yards. He is also a starter at safety ranking fourth on the team this season with 34 tackles.
- NiJhay Burt came up big on defense again on Saturday as the reserve safety had his third interception of the season to seal the Panthers sixth win of the season. Burt now ranks 30th in the FCS and third in the Big South-OVC in interceptions. He opened the year with a 67-yard interception return for touchdown at Indiana State.
- Junior safety Nick Coates had his first career interception on Saturday finishing the day with four solo tackles. An All-OVC selection last season Coates has made seven starts this season making 26 tackles with two tackles for loss and three pass break-ups.
- Eastern Illinois had its best offensive start of the season on Saturday at Lindenwood scoring three times for 16 points with 176 yards of total offense in the first quarter. EIU's best scoring offensive quarter this season was 17 points in the fourth quarter against McNeese. Last season EIU had two games with three scores in the opening quarter with 21 points against Northwestern State and 17 points at UT Martin.
- Kendi Young has come off the bench the last couple of weeks to provide some offensive punch in the Panthers backfield. Against Bryant he was called into action late in the second quarter and finished the game as EIU's leading rusher with 11 carries for 69 yards. On Saturday at Lindenwood he was the number two running back but again finished as the Panthers leading rusher with 45 yards on nine carries. In his collegiate debut in the COVID spring of 2021, Young ripped off a 72-yard touchdown in his opening game against Southeast Missouri. Last season he rushed for 160 yards on eight carries in a road win at Murray State.
- DeAirious Smith continues to make the most of his receptions this season as the junior had five catches for 67 yards in Saturday's road win at Lindenwood. Smith is currently fourth on the Panthers team with 24 receptions but second in receiving yards with 453. His 18.9 yards per reception rank him 15th in the FCS.
- Linebacker Anthony Shockey posted his second double figure tackle game of the season as he led EIU with ten tackles on Saturday at Lindenwood. Shockey made nine solo stops with one tackle for loss. He is currently third on the team with 46 total tackles. His season high was 11 tackles in the Panthers game at Bowling Green.
- Freshman punter Jacob Horvath was effective in placing the ball in Saturday's road win at Lindenwood. Horvath had five punts on the afternoon with for a 38.2 yard average. Of the five punts, three were downed inside the five yard line with two of them pinned at the one-yard line. For the season Horvath is averaging 37.7 yards per punt with 14 of his 44 punts this season inside the 20-yard line. His season long is 57 yards.
- Defensive lineman Nicholas Oliveira-Chace made an impact up front on Saturday against Lindenwood finishing with four tackles and 1.5 sacks. A transfer from Division II Franklin Pierce, Oliveira-Chace is fifth on the Panthers roster with 33 tackles with a team-high seven tackles for loss and two fumble recoveries.
- Linebacker Phoenix Porter made five tackles in Saturday's win at Lindenwood with two sacks and three tackles for loss. Porter is now tied with Joel Barrows for the team lead in sacks with three. He is sixth on the Panthers roster with 31 tackles this year. The last EIU player with two or more sacks in a game was Jordan Miles with two last season at Tennessee State. The last Panther with three or more tackles for loss was Tre'jon Lewis with three last season at McNeese.
- Eastern Illinois football clinched its first winning season since the 2017 campaign with Saturday's win over Lindenwood. It was the Panthers sixth win of the season. With one more win in its two remaining games EIU would get to the seven win plateau for the first time since the 2015 season when they went 7-4 in the regular season before losing at Northern Iowa in the opening round of the FCS playoffs. Two wins in the final two games would give EIU eight wins for the first time since 2013 when they finished at 12-2.

- MJ Flowers was named to the mid-season Watch List for the Jerry Rice FCS Freshman of the Year Award. Flowers leads the Panthers in rushing yards with 474 this season which ranks sixth in the Big South-OVC and eighth nationally among FCS freshmen. He has also been a target out of the backfield with 29 catches for 161 yards giving him 635 all-purpose yards (tenth nationally among FCS freshmen). Flowers has the third best rushing game performance in the FCS this season with 272 yards against McNeese, that total ranking third best all-time in EIU history.
- Stone Galloway knocked home one field goal in the win over Lindenwood as the senior moved up another spot on the Eastern Illinois career field goals made list. Galloway now has 28 career made field goals and is fourth on the EIU career list. Steve Largent holds the school record with 46 made field goals followed by Nick Bruno (43) and Cameron Berra (34). One of Galloway's made kicks this year was from 56 yards which was the second longest field goal in school history. He had his streak of 43 consecutive points without a miss snapped with a blocked PAT as he is now 10-of-11 on extra points this season and has 53 extra points for his career.
- Eastern Illinois will honor a large group of players prior to this Saturday's game with Tennessee State. The following players are included in this year's class Mark Aitken, Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, Elijah Ball, DeWayne Cooks, Russell Dandy, Lazerick Eatman, Juwon Farri, Stone Galloway, Brandon Guido, Nile Hill, Anthony Imperio, Michael Jarosz, Daniel Luoma, Anthony Manaves, Jonah O'Brien, William Orth, Alex Oyawale, Anthony Shockey, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus, Justin Thomas, Braylon Willis and student assistant coach Ryan Shepard.
- Eastern Illinois faced Bowling Green for the Panthers FBS contest this season as the Panthers played a team from the Mid-American Conference for the second straight year. With the 2024 schedule allowing for 12-games, EIU is scheduled to play two FBS games next season with trips to Illinois and Northwestern. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025 and Minnesota in 2026.
- Eastern Illinois offensive lineman Chad Strickland was a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy, the academic Heisman Trophy. Strickland, a preseason All-Big South-OVC Football selection, earned his undergraduate degree in pre-physical therapy with a 3.82 GPA and is currently enrolled in the master's program. He was one of 39 players selected from the FCS level and one of three from the Big South-OVC Football Association joining William McRainey from Gardner-Webb and Bradley Clark from Tennessee Tech.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference have merged into a joint conference for the sport of football with ten member schools for the 2023 season. The new Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb with affiliate members Bryant and Robert Morris (Pa.) also playing previously in the Big South. Next season (2024) will again see membership change with Western Illinois joining as a football playing member and Bryant exiting the conference.
- Eastern Illinois has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson and defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. All three were teammates under head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football has expanded its international pool of players as part of their 2023 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland and Jaxson Isaac from Canada. The last two seasons Luoma was a reserve tight end and served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks in 2021. Isaac, another tight end, joined the roster last season using a redshirt season after playing in four games. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage in 2021. The newest international Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's. The last player from Australia to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2023 season with five players in total selected. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Chad Strickland (OL) were voted team captains in the spring following the spring game. Joining that list following fall camp are Justin Thomas (WR), Stone Galloway (K) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL).
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, DeWayne Cooks Jr., Russell Dandy, Juwon Farri, Pierce Holley, Anthony Imperio, Jonah O'Brien, Sebastian Pares, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus and Justin Thomas.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 59-39 career record. TENNESSEE STATE HEAD COACH EDDIE GEORGE

Former Heisman Trophy winner and NFL running back Eddie George is in his third season as the head coach at Tennessee State and has the Tigers in the FCS playoff hunt this season. This is George's first coaching job and he has led the Tigers to a 15-16 record heading into the final weeks of his third season including a 7-8 record in conference games. George was the 1995 Heisman Trophy winner playing at Ohio State. He would go on to have a long career primarily with the Tennessee Titans rushing for more than 10,000 career yards.

SCOUTING TENNESSEE STATE

Tennessee State had its three game win streak snapped last Saturday as the Tigers lost on the road at Charleston Southern falling to 6-3 overall, 2-2 in the Big South-OVC. Terrell Allen has been a force leading the TSU defense earning conference player of the week honors three straight weeks and FCS National Defensive Player of the Week honors two weeks ago. He has 53 tackles with 24.5 tackles for loss and 14.5 sacks. Monroe Beard III leads the Tigers with 95 total tackles. Jordan Gant has come on to lead the ground game with 490 yards and ten touchdowns. Draylen Ellis is an experienced signal caller with 928 passing yards.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State will be meeting for the 27th time as the Tigers play a road game in a town named Charleston for the second consecutive week. TSU lost at Charleston Southern last weekend. EIU holds a 15-11 all-time lead in the series but TSU has won the last three in the series and four of the last five meetings. Prior to a TSU win in 2018, EIU had won six straight in the series.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.
