Panthers Look To Bounce Back After Overtime Loss

Eastern Illinois at Southeast Missouri Houck Field (8,000) • Cape Girardeau, Mo. October 14, 2023 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Quarterback Pierce Holley passed for a season-high 359 yards on Saturday in the Panthers overtime loss to UT Martin. Holley was named the Big South-OVC Football Association Player of the Week on Monday. It was the second straight year that an EIU quarterback has passed for more than 300-yards against the Skyhawks defense. Holley finished the day 29-of-48 with four touchdown passes. The last time EIU had a quarterback throw four touchdown passes in a game was late September 2018 when Harry Woodbery had five touchdown passes against Tennessee Tech. Holley is currently 8th in the FCS in passing yards (256.8 ypg) and 17th in touchdown passes.
- Russell Dandy has lived up to his last name on defense turning into one of the top shut down corners in the Big South-OVC. Dandy had seven solo tackles on Saturday against UT Martin but also added two pass break-ups to his season total. Dandy ranks 8th in the FCS in passes defended with ten pass break-ups and one interception. The ten pass break-ups moved the fifth year corner into a tie for eighth on the EIU single season list where he is tied Ray McElroy who had ten pass break-ups in both 1993 and 1994. Ben Brown holds the EIU single season record with 16.
- Eastern Illinois added to its team turnover total on Saturday with four turnovers gained against UT Martin. The Panthers forced four fumbles recovering three of them with one NiJhay Burt interception added in. EIU now leads the FCS ranks with 17 turnovers gained this season. The turnovers this season have come in bunches with multiple turnovers gained in four games. EIU is second nationally in fumbles recovered (8) and second nationally in passes intercepted (9).
- Eastern Illinois lost its homecoming game in overtime for the second straight season as the Panthers lost 28-27 on Saturday to No. 18 UT Martin. Last season the Panthers lost in double overtime to Lindenwood. The Panthers last overtime win was against UT Martin on Oct. 20, 2018 with a 24-21 win. The Panthers are 9-9 all-time in overtime games including a 3-0 record during the 2017 season when they played one overtime game and two double overtime contests.
- Justin Bowick had another big day for the Panthers offense on Saturday as the sophomore wide receiver hauled in five passes for 67 yards and two touchdowns. The previous week Bowick had four catches for 130 yards and a score at Northwestern State for his second career 100-yard receiving day. Bowick leads the Big South-OVC in touchdown receptions (15th nationally) and has 21 catches for 325 yards this season with both totals ranking in the top ten in the conference.

- For the fourth time this season linebacker Elijawah Tolbert has led or been tied for the team lead in tackles for a game for Eastern Illinois. On Saturday against UT Martin, Tolbert had seven tackles with one forced fumble. On the season he leads the Panthers with 53 tackles and his two forced fumbles this season tie him for 24th in the FCS. He is second in the Big South-OVC in total tackles ranking 34th nationally. Last season Tolbert was a first-team All-OVC linebacker finishing with 70 tackles, 6.5 tackles for loss and three interceptions. Following EIU's season opening win this year over Indiana State he was named the FCS National Defensive Player of the Week.
- Joel Barrows was the Panthers top returning sack artist from last season with three. On Saturday against UT Martin he picked up a second for the second straight week as EIU matched its season high with three team sacks. Barrows added a forced fumble giving him two this season which ranks 24th in the FCS. For the season Barrows is seventh on the team with 19 tackles and the Panthers leader with two sacks.
- Kaelin Drakeford was once again in the right place at the right time as the safety recovered one of three fumbles the Panthers defense scooped up on Saturday against UT Martin. It was the second fumble recovery this season for Drakeford which ranks him third in the FCS behind Wyatt Pedigo (North Dakota State) and Noah Washington (Morgan State) both with three. Drakeford has played in all six games this year with 15 tackles, two tackles for loss and two pass break-ups added to his fumble recovery total.
- Junior college wide receiver Eli Mirza continues to be a top target for the Panthers offense hauling in ten passes for 119 yards on Saturday against UT Martin. It was the second straight week a Panthers wide receiver cracked the century mark in receiving yardage and the first EIU receiver with double figure catches since Isaiah Hill caught 13 balls against Murray State in the final game of the 2021 season. This season Mirza leads the Panthers with 35 receptions which ranks 26th in the FCS. He is 40th in the FCS in receiving yards with 367 which includes one touchdown reception while he has another rushing touchdown this year.
- Justin Thomas has had a knack from catching passes his entire career. A Division III All-American transfer to Eastern Illinois last fall before getting hurt after four games, Thomas has now caught at least one pass in all six of his games at EIU. Combine that with the streak Thomas brought with him from Albion and the wide receiver now has a catch in 31 consecutive games with his last game without a reception coming on Nov. 3, 2018 against Finlandia. Thomas is currently 10th among all active college football players in receiving yards with 3,011 and 17th in receptions with 196. Both of those totals rank second among FCS players.
- Eastern Illinois started the same group on the offensive line for the second consecutive week with Nic DiSanto, Jack Valente, Drew Wilder, Sebastian Pares and Chad Strickland starting up front for the Panthers. EIU had opened the first five weeks of the season with a different starting offensive line combination in each of the five games. That cohesion up front helped the Panthers increase their total offensive yard numbers from 349 yards against Northwestern State to 391 yards against UT Martin. Last season EIU had eight different starting offensive line combinations in 11 games only starting the same group in back-to-back games twice during the season.
- Running back MJ Flowers started his third straight game in the backfield as he was held to 25 yards rushing on a tough day in the backfield against UT Martin. Flowers had a breakout game two weeks ago with 272 yards rushing against McNeese which ranks as the highest single game total in the FCS this season. He was named the FCS National Freshman of the Week following that effort and has been named the Big South-OVC Freshman of the Week three times. Flowers leads EIU with 369 rushing yards this season which is second in the FCS ranks among freshman behind Eli Gillman of Montana. Flowers has also been a weapon out of the backfield with 23 receptions for 116 yards.
- For the second time this season the sack club was open for the Panthers defense as they matched their season high with three sacks against UT Martin on Saturday. The total matched EIU's three sacks in the season opening win over Indiana State. Joel Barrows moved into the team lead with one sack while Colby Smith and Drake Van Hyfte added solo sacks for the Panthers defense. As a team EIU now has nine sacks this season recorded by eight different players with six of the nine sacks recorded by players on the defensive line.
- Daniel Luoma assumed kickoff duties for the Panthers prior to the start of the season opener at Indiana State when starting kicker Stone Galloway suffered a pregame injury. Luoma who is from Finland, handled kickoff duties in 2021 averaging 59.2 yards per kickoff with eight touchbacks. This season Luoma has averaged 61.2 yards per kickoff with six touchbacks to date. In addition to his kickoff duties, Luoma is also a blocking tight end on offense and part of both the Panthers punt team and kickoff return team. At Northwestern State he had the rare opportunity to not only handle kickoff duties, but also was the returner for EIU on short kick recording a return of seven yards.
- Braylon Willis made his first start of the season for the Panthers on Saturday at defensive end. Willis finished the game with four tackles, one tackle for loss, one fumble recovery and one pass break-up. He now has 16 tackles this season with 2.5 tackles for loss.
- Eastern Illinois was back up over the 30-minute mark for time of possession on Saturday as the Panthers are averaging 32:04 minutes per game which ranks 24th in the FCS. However that mark ranks just third in the Big South-OVC behind Bryant (19th at 32:31) and Southeast Missouri (20th at 32:19).

- Eastern Illinois went for two on its first possession of overtime last Saturday against UT Martin. The Panthers had an incomplete pass on the two-point attempt and are now 0-for-4 this season on two-point conversion attempts. EIU's last successful two-point conversion came last November at McNeese with Cooper Willman hitting Nile Hill for the score on a pass. EIU's last successful two-point conversion on a run was more than 20-years ago when J.R. Taylor scored against Murray State on Nov. 23, 2002. This season 39 teams at the FCS level have converted a two-point conversion including Big South-OVC members Bryant (2) and Lindenwood (1). Georgetown and Montana are the national leaders with three successful conversions each.
- Mark Aitken added two more kick returns to his season total on Saturday averaging 21 yards per return. Aitken currently ranks 58th in the FCS and fifth in the Big South-OVC in kick return average at 20.4 yards per return. Last season he was a second team All-OVC kick returner averaging 24 yards per return. His biggest return this season has been 44 yards at Northwestern State. Aitken now has 592 career kick return yards and needs 216 more kick return yards this season to crack the EIU career top ten. In addition to being EIU's primary kick returner, Aitken is one of the Panthers team captains and a starter at safety with 25 tackles, an interception and a forced fumble this season.
- Brett Galetti has increased his role as the Panthers long snapper this season. At the start of the season Jack Valente, a second team All-OVC performer at long snapper handled those duties. Valente is also a starter at tackle on the EIU offensive line. When Valente was injured early in the year, Galetti moved in to assume the role starting with snaps on punts to begin with before now snapping on both punts and field goals/extra points.
- Eastern Illinois offensive lineman Chad Strickland has been named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy, the academic Heisman Trophy. Strickland, a preseason All-Big South-OVC Football selection, earned his undergraduate degree in pre-physical therapy with a 3.82 GPA and is currently enrolled in the master's program. He was one of 39 players selected from the FCS level and one of three from the Big South-OVC Football Association joining William McRainey from Gardner-Webb and Bradley Clark from Tennessee Tech.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference have merged into a joint conference for the sport of football with ten member schools for the 2023 season. The new Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb with affiliate members Bryant and Robert Morris (Pa.) also playing previously in the Big South. Next season (2024) will again see membership change with Western Illinois joining as a football playing member and Bryant exiting the conference.
- Eastern Illinois has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson and defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. All three were teammates under head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football has expanded its international pool of players as part of their 2023 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland and Jaxson Isaac from Canada. The last two seasons Luoma was a reserve tight end and served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks in 2021. Isaac, another tight end, joined the roster last season using a redshirt season after playing in four games. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage in 2021. The newest international Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's. The last player from Australia to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2023 season with five players in total selected. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Chad Strickland (OL) were voted team captains in the spring following the spring game. Joining that list following fall camp are Justin Thomas (WR), Stone Galloway (K) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL).
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, DeWayne Cooks Jr., Russell Dandy, Juwon Farri, Pierce Holley, Anthony Imperio, Jonah O'Brien, Sebastian Pares, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus and Justin Thomas.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 57-38 career record. SOUTHEAST MISSOURI HEAD COACH TOM MATUKEWICZ

Tom Matukewicz is in his tenth season as the head coach at Southeast Missouri having led the Redhawks to back-to-back FCS playoff appearances in 2018 and 2019 and again last season. Matukewicz was a long time assistant coach as a member of head coach Jerry Kill's staff at both Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois. He was the defensive coordinator at Toledo for two seasons before taking over at SEMO. Matukewicz is a 1997 graduate of Fort Hays State in Kansas. He is 52-56 overall, 39-27 in the OVC.

SCOUTING SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Southeast Missouri was picked to win the Big South-OVC Football Association regular season title but the Redhawks enter mid-October sitting a 1-4 following three consecutive close losses to Southern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Central Arkansas. Geno Hess is the active rushing leader in the FCS with 4,486 yards returning for his fifth season with 375 yards this season. Paxton DeLaurent has passed for 1,351 yards with Damoriea Vick the top target with 42 receptions. The defense has been led by Lawrence Johnson with 32 tackles. SEMO's defense has recorded just two sacks this season for 11 yards.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri will be meeting for the 31st time on Saturday with the Panthers holding a 18-12 all-time series lead. SEMO has won five straight in the series including a 31-7 win over the Panthers last November. EIU has not won in Cape Girardeau since October 18, 2014, a 52-13 Panthers win. The two schools first met in a home-and-home series in 1956 and 1957 with SEMO winning both of those contests.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
