# Panthers Host Bryant For Hall Of Fame Game

Eastern Illinois vs. Bryant O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. October 21, 2023 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

#### NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois returns home to face Bryant for the Panthers Hall of Fame Game on Saturday afternoon. The Panthers lost at Southeast Missouri on Saturday as a pass was knocked down in the end zone on the final play of the game. It marked the second straight week EIU's game has come down to the final play of the contest as the Panthers fell to 4-3 overall, 0-2 in the Big South-OVC Football Association. Bryant enters at 3-3, 1-0 in the Big South-OVC after a win over Robert Morris last weekend.
- Pierce Holley passed for 346 yards and two touchdowns on Saturday at Southeast Missouri putting up his second straight 300-yard passing performance. Last week against UT Martin he passed for 359 yards and four touchdowns earning Big South-OVC Football Offensive Player of the Week honors. He has currently passed for 1,905 yards this season which ranks fifth in the FCS. He added two touchdown passes to his season total with his 13 touchdowns currently 12th in the FCS. Holley has been sharp most of the season with a completion percentage of 62.1 percent going 167-of-269 with five interceptions. The last EIU quarterback with back-to-back 300-yard passing games was Jimmy Garoppolo during the 2013 season against Tennessee State (410 yds / Oct. 26) and Tennessee Tech (399 yards / Nov. 2).
- · Pierce Holley was dialed in to not one but two receivers on Saturday at Southeast Missouri as Justin Thomas and DeAirious Smith both finished with more than 100 yards receiving in the game. Thomas had five catches for 103 yards and a touchdown with a long reception of 43 yards. Smith hauled in four passes for 118 yards with a long reception of 46 yards. It marked the 21st time in school history that EIU had two receivers finish with more than 100 yards receiving in a game. The last time was Oct. 6, 2018 when Alexander Hollins and Aaron Gooch both had more than 100 yards receiving against Murray State.
- Safety Blake Ruffin had his second big game for the Panthers defense over the last three weeks as he finished with ten tackles Saturday at Southeast Missouri. In the Panthers road win at Northwestern State on Sept. 30, Ruffin had 13 tackles with an interception earning Big South-OVC Football Defensive Player of the Week honors. This past week Ruffin added his third interception of the season setting up EIU's first touchdown of the game. Ruffin later added a big tackle for loss on third down stopping a SEMO drive and giving EIU the ball for one final drive. Ruffin's three interceptions rank him 14th in the FCS while his 48 tackles are second on the EIU team.

- Eastern Illinois defense added two more turnovers to its season total on Saturday at Southeast Missouri with a Blake Ruffin interception and fumble recovery by Russell Dandy. The Panthers now have five games with multiple turnovers gained this season and lead the FCS with 19 total takeaways. EIU has been diplomatic in types of turnovers forced this year ranking second in the nation in both interceptions (10) and fumble recoveries (9). Montana is the national leader in interceptions with 11 while Marist leads the nation in fumble recoveries with ten.
- Justin Bowick hauled in his fifth touchdown pass of the season on Saturday at Southeast Missouri as he finished the game with two receptions for ten yards. It marked the third straight game the sophomore wide receiver has caught a touchdown pass as he ranks 11th in the FCS in touchdown receptions this season. The five touchdown receptions are the most in a season for an EIU receiver since 2018 when Alexander Hollins hauled in 16 touchdowns to earn All-American honors. Bowick has 23 catches for 335 yards this year.
- Joel Barrows was in on one of the Panthers two team sacks on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. Barrows was EIU's returning leader in sacks from last season with three. This year the defensive end has a team high 2.5 sacks as the Panthers have registered 11 sacks as a team. No other player on the EIU roster has more than one sack this season. Barrows has added 21 tackles with two forced fumbles to his stat line this season.
- Russell Dandy did not have a pass break-up at Southeast Missouri but did add two solo stops with a fumble recovery to his season stats. Dandy has been one of the top corners in the Big South-OVC this season ranking ninth in the FCS in passes defended with ten pass break-ups and one interception. The ten pass break-ups rank the fifth year player tied for eighth on the EIU single season list. Dandy has 23 tackles this year.
- Running back MJ Flowers continues to be one of the more dynamic freshmen in the FCS this season as he currently leads the Panthers with 409 rushing yards while ranking second with 27 pass receptions. He has amassed 552 all-purpose yards this season which ranks seventh nationally among FCS freshmen. He is fourth nationally among FCS freshman in rushing yards with a season-high 272 yards against McNeese. Flowers has been named the Big South-OVC Football Freshman of the Week three times and once was named the FCS National Freshman of the Week.
- Kevin Daniels plowed in for a one-yard touchdown at Southeast Missouri as part of his 28 yard day on the ground. A transfer from Northern Arizona where he earned All-American honors, Daniels now has 12 career touchdowns with 1,521 career rushing yards. Daniels has rushed for 238 yards this season at EIU missing one game due to injury. He rushed for a season high 78 yards in week two at Bowling Green.
- Justin Thomas hauled in a touchdown in the fourth quarter on Saturday as part of his 103 yard receiving day at Southeast Missouri. A former Division III All-American, Thomas now has 3,114 career yards and 201 career receptions which rank him tenth among active football players and second at the FCS level. He has caught at least one pass in 32 straight games and Saturday was his ninth career 100-yard receiving day. Thomas has four touchdowns this season which ranks him 21st in the FCS while he has 46 career touchdown receptions.
- DeAirious Smith had four catches for 118 yards on Saturday against Southeast Missouri. It was the second career 100-yard receiving day for the junior who caught six passes for 109 yards as a freshman against Tennessee Tech. This season Smith has 18 receptions for 349 yards with his 18.4 yards per catch average ranking 25th in the FCS.
- Linebacker Elijawah Tolbert added eight tackles to his season total on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. The junior linebacker leads EIU with 61 tackles this season which is second in the Big South-OVC and 39th in the FCS. He is tied for the team lead with four tackles for loss adding 1.5 TFL last Saturday. Tolbert was a first team All-OVC linebacker last season and earned FCS National Defensive Player of the Week honors following the Panthers week one shutout win over Indiana State.
- Due to an injury in the defensive backfield, Collin Tyson had increased playing time on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. Normally a starter on the Panthers special teams units, Tyson finished with four tackles, a half tackle for loss and two pass break-ups. Tyson had one total tackle on special teams is six games prior to his extended playing time on Saturday.
- Transfer defensive lineman Nicholas Oliviera-Chace continues to make an impact up front for EIU this season. He has been the only defensive lineman to start in all seven games making seven tackles with a sack and tackle for loss on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. He currently ranks fifth on the team with 27 tackles and leads the Panthers with five tackles for loss (ranks 10th in the Big South-OVC).
- Eli Mirza continues to be a top receiving target for the Panthers offense with five catches for 78 yards on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. Mirza is EIU's leader on the season with 40 receptions for 445 yards. He currently ranks 25th in the FCS and second in the Big South-OVC in receptions.
- Mark Aitken added two more kick returns to his career total on Saturday as he now has 205 return yards on 11 kick returns this season for a 18.6 yards per return average. Aitken was a second team All-OVC kick returner last season and has 613 career kick return yards. As a team captain on defense, Aitken is fourth on the team with 30 tackles with one interception and one forced fumble.

- Last season Eastern Illinois lost the services of veteran offensive lineman Elkhanan Tanelus in the second game of the season against Chattanooga. Tanelus has started 25 career games during his Panthers career between the center and guard position. He returned for the first time this season on Saturday at Southeast Missouri. Tanelus now gives the Panthers some added depth on the line after they lost the services of starting guard Max Stineman to injury two weeks ago.
- Eastern Illinois has been able to add depth to its defensive front line as the season has progressed after losing a couple of players during fall camp. Zed Asowata has joined the team up front during the past three games making five tackles with one tackle for loss. EIU also had starting lineman Colby Smith return this week after missing the last couple of games with injury. Smith has nine tackles with a tackle for loss and forced fumble this season.
- Eastern Illinois continues to be among the nation's best in time of possession as the Panthers are averaging 31:43 minutes per game which ranks 28th in the FCS. The Big South-OVC has four teams ranked in the Top 30 of the FCS in time of possession led by Tennessee Tech in 22nd, Southeast Missouri in 23rd and Robert Morris in 24th. UT Martin and Bryant rank just behind in 32nd and 33rd with both averaging more than 31 minutes per game.
- Eastern Illinois welcomes Bryant to O'Brien Field for this year's 2023 EIU Athletic Hall of Fame Game. This year's Hall of Fame Class will be inducted at a banquet on Friday evening and then honored once again at halftime of Saturday's home football game. The 2023 HOF Class includes former football All-American offensive lineman Collin Seibert along with two-time U.S. Olympian Lauren Doyle, All-American high jumper Haleigh Knapp, OVC Baseball Player of the Year Jordan Kreke, OVC Softball Pitcher of the Year Hanna Mennenga and Division II National Champion Wrestler Mark Gronowski.
- Eastern Illinois offensive lineman Chad Strickland has been named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy, the academic Heisman Trophy. Strickland, a preseason All-Big South-OVC Football selection, earned his undergraduate degree in pre-physical therapy with a 3.82 GPA and is currently enrolled in the master's program. He was one of 39 players selected from the FCS level and one of three from the Big South-OVC Football Association joining William McRainey from Gardner-Webb and Bradley Clark from Tennessee Tech.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference have merged into a joint conference for the sport of football with ten member schools for the 2023 season. The new Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb with affiliate members Bryant and Robert Morris (Pa.) also playing previously in the Big South. Next season (2024) will again see membership change with Western Illinois joining as a football playing member and Bryant exiting the conference.
- Eastern Illinois has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson and defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. All three were teammates under head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football has expanded its international pool of players as part of their 2023 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland and Jaxson Isaac from Canada. The last two seasons Luoma was a reserve tight end and served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks in 2021. Isaac, another tight end, joined the roster last season using a redshirt season after playing in four games. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage in 2021. The newest international Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's. The last player from Australia to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2023 season with five players in total selected. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Chad Strickland (OL) were voted team captains in the spring following the spring game. Joining that list following fall camp are Justin Thomas (WR), Stone Galloway (K) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL).
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, DeWayne Cooks Jr., Russell Dandy, Juwon Farri, Pierce Holley, Anthony Imperio, Jonah O'Brien, Sebastian Pares, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus and Justin Thomas.

#### EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 57-38 career record. #### **BRYANT HEAD COACH CHRIS MERRITT**

Chris Merritt is in his fifth season as the head coach at Bryant leading the program through its transition in conferences. Bryant was originally a member of the Northeast Conference before moving to the Big South and part of its merger to the Big South-OVC Football Association. Next season Bryant heads to the Colonial Athletic Association. Merritt played football at Indiana and began his coaching career as an assistant at Eastern Illinois on head coach Bob Spoo's staff. He was a successful high school coach at Columbus High School in Miami, Florida. He enters the week with a career record of 20-24.

#### SCOUTING BRYANT

Bryant enters the game the week 3-3 on the season and 1-0 in the Big South-OVC Football Association following a win last weekend over Robert Morris. Quarterback Zevi Eckhaus, a former Jerry Rice Award finalist, was named the OVC Offensive Player of the Week this week. He has passed for 1,295 yards with nine touchdowns while also ranking as the Bulldogs leading rusher with 257 yards. His top receiving target this season has been Jalen Powell with 20 catches. On defense Kenny Dyson Jr. and Michael Otty have wreaked havoc with a combined 12.5 tackles for loss and ten sacks. Chris Yates is the leading tackler with 34 stops.

#### THE SERIES

This will be the first meeting between Eastern Illinois and Bryant. The Panthers have never played a team from the New England area with Bryant located in Smithfield, Rhode Island. The closest geographical opponent EIU has ever faced was Delaware in the 1978 NCAA Division II National Championship game which was played in Texas. The closest game EIU has ever played to Bryant's location was the Panthers trip to Penn State in 2009. State College, Penn., is located about six and half hours from Bryant.

# MERRITT AND EIU TIES

A former college player at Indiana University, Bryant head coach Chris Merritt had his first collegiate coaching job at Eastern Illinois working on the staff of long-time head coach Bob Spoo. Current Eastern Illinois head coach Chris Wilkerson was a player on those Panthers teams when Merritt worked at EIU in 1993 and 1994. Merritt also sent a number of his high school players on to compete at Eastern Illinois most notably wide receiver Erik Lora who set the FCS record for single season receptions and ranks as both EIU's and the OVC's all-time leader in career receptions.

#### **OVC CELEBRATES 75TH ANNIVERSARY**

The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrated its 75th anniversary during the 2022-23 academic year. The OVC is the eighth oldest NCAA Division I conference. Eastern Illinois is entering its 28th season as a member of the OVC. The EIU football team has won seven OVC championships with former head coach Bob Spoo one of two EIU members of the OVC Hall of Fame. EIU has had four OVC Defensive Players of the Year and four OVC Offensive Players of the Year including 2002 Walter Payton Award winner Tony Romo and 2013 Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo.

#### SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
