Nationally Ranked Battle On-Hand For EIU Homecoming Game

No. 25 Eastern Illinois vs. No. 18/23 UT Martin O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. October 7, 2023 • 2 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois football is off to its best start since the 2013 season as the Panthers improved to 4-1 with a road win at Northwestern State. It marked the third straight win for EIU, something that had not happened since the 2016 season. Also not happening since late in the 2016 season was Eastern Illinois appearing in the national rankings, but that changed this week with the Panthers landing at No.25 in the FCS Coaches poll. It marks the 26th different season that EIU has been ranked in the national polls for at least one week.
- Eastern Illinois will be playing its 179th game as a nationally ranked team at the FCS level when the Panthers host UT Martin for homecoming on Saturday. It will mark the second time that the Panthers and Skyhawks have played when both teams have been nationally ranked. The previous time was in 2006 with UTM winning 15-9 in Martin, Tenn. The two teams would end the season splitting the OVC regular-season title with both advancing to the FCS playoffs.
- Safety Blake Ruffin played a big part in Eastern Illinois road win at Northwestern State on Saturday night. On Monday he was named the Big South-OVC Football co-Defensive Player of the Week along with Monroe Beard III of Tennessee State. Ruffin finished the game with 13 tackles as he now ranks second on the Panthers team with 34 stops this season. His interception in the fourth quarter set up a field goal midway through the period that gave EIU a two score lead in the contest. It was his second interception this year as he ranks 25th in the FCS in interceptions this year.
- Running back MJ Flowers had his second consecutive start for the Panthers offense as he finished with 64 all-purpose yards in the road win at Northwestern State. On Monday Flowers was named the Big South-OVC Freshman of the Week for the third consecutive week. Flowers currently leads the Panthers with 344 rushing yards which ranks 41st in the FCS but is second among freshmen in the FCS trailing only Jared White of Montana State with 351 yards. Flowers has also been a versatile weapon catching the ball out of the backfield with 17 receptions for 80 yards.
- Justin Bowick was a big weapon for the Panthers passing game at Northwestern State as the sophomore wide receiver hauled in four passes for 130 yards including a 52-yard touchdown reception. It was his second touchdown reception of the season as Bowick has 16 catches for a team-high 258 yards this season. It was his second career 100-yard receiving day with his breakout performance coming last season at UT Martin with six catches for 177 yards and two touchdowns.

- Turnovers in bunches were once again the trend for Eastern Illinois defense as the Panthers had three takeaways in the win at Northwestern State. EIU now has 13 turnovers gained this season with all of those coming in three games in wins over Indiana State, Illinois State and Northwestern State. The 13 turnovers gained ranks 3rd in the FCS this season behind Morgan State (15) and North Alabama (14). EIU's record for turnovers in a season is 52 in 1980.
- Graduate defensive player Russell Dandy continues to have an outstanding season as a lock-down corner for the Panthers. Dandy had three tackles and was credited with three pass break-ups in the road win at Northwestern State. For the season Dandy has eight pass break-ups to go along with one interception and 14 tackles. He enters the week ranked fourth in the FCS in passes defended. He needs one more pass break-up this season to join the EIU single season Top 10 with Antonie Johnson (2014) ranked tenth on the list with nine. The single season record for pass break-ups at EIU is 16 by Ben Brown in 2004.
- Elijawah Tolbert continues to rack up tackles leading the Eastern Illinois defense. The returning All-OVC linebacker finished with 12 stops at Northwestern State giving him 46 tackles for the season. He currently ranks 28th in the FCS and second in the Big South-OVC in tackles this season. He was named the FCS National Defensive Player of the Week following the Panthers week one win at Indiana State. As a team EIU leads the Big South-OVC in scoring defense allowing 17.8 points per game, 12th best in the FCS.
- Pierce Holley passed for 274 yards at Northwestern State as the transfer quarterback had his second consecutive game without an interception. He now has 1,200 passing yards for the season which ranks first in the Big South-OVC and 14th in the FCS. He added a touchdown pass to his season total giving him seven this year which is third in the conference. Including his two seasons as a starter at Georgetown, Holley now has 5,359 yards passing which ranks 17th among active FCS quarterbacks.
- One of the Panthers top targets on offense this season has been junior college transfer Eli Mirza. The wide receiver currently leads EIU with 25 receptions for 248 yards. His 25 receptions rank third in the Big South-OVC with a high of eight receptions for 52 yards in the home win over McNeese. Mirza also scored his lone touchdown of the season against McNeese on an end-around as he has rushed for 41 yards.
- Kevin Daniels found pay dirt on the ground in the second half at Northwestern State as the transfer running back returned after missing the McNeese game with an injury. Daniels rushed for 37 yards and the score as he went over 200 yard mark (202) for the season at EIU and he closes in on the 1,500 yard mark for his career (1,485) which includes time at Northern Arizona. Daniels became the third Panthers player this season with multiple touchdowns joining Justin Thomas (2 vs Illinois State) and Justin Bowick (Ind. State / NW St).
- Transfer defensive lineman Nicholas Oliveira-Chace continues to give the Panthers production up front as he had four tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss, a forced fumble and fumble recovery in the win at Northwestern State. For the season Oliveira-Chace leads the Panthers with four tackles for loss which is tied for eighth in the OVC. He is one of five Panthers with a fumble recovery this season and one of six with a forced fumble. Oliveira-Chace has 16 tackles which is fifth on the team and first among the defensive line group.
- Joel Barrows was the Panthers top returning sack leader on defense from last season with three. On Saturday at Northwestern State he picked up his first sack of the 2023 campaign with a sack and forced fumble in the opening half against the Demons. Barrows has 14 tackles this year with two tackles for loss. For his career Barrows now has five sacks and 8.5 tackles for loss.
- Last season Mark Aitken was one of the most dangerous return men in the Ohio Valley Conference earning second team All-OVC honors as a kick returner. On Saturday at Northwestern State he got one opportunity to return and flashed that ability from last year with a 44-yard kick return. For the season Aitken is averaging 20.3 yards per return which ranks seventh in the league. As a team captain and starter at safety, he has contributed on defense with 24 tackles, one interception and one forced fumble.
- Eastern Illinois stuffed out the Northwestern State run game on Saturday night as the Panthers allowed a season low 69 yards on 35 rushing attempts for just under 2-yards per carry. For the season EIU is holding opponents to 139.4 yards per game which ranks 40th in the FCS and second in the Big South-OVC. EIU has only allowed one individual 100-yard rusher this season and allowed only two backs to crack the century mark in a game last season.
- Punter Jacob Horvath and tight end / kickoff specialist Daniel Luoma continue to perform well for the Panthers special teams. Horvath had four punts for a 39.2 yards per punt average with two downed inside the 20 at Northwestern State. He is averaging 40.5 yards per punt for the season with a long of 57 yards and nine punts inside the 20-yard line. Luoma has assumed kickoff duties this year and is averaging 61.6 yards per kickoff with six touchbacks. He averaged 61.8 yards per kickoff at Northwestern State with one sent for a touchback.
- After possessing the ball for more than 35-minutes in both of its home wins over Illinois State and McNeese, EIU was on the short end of the time-of-possession game at Northwestern State finishing with 28:25. For the season EIU is averaging 31:56 minutes per game which ranks 24th in the FCS but only fifth best in the Big South-OVC. Bryant (15th) is the conference leader at 32:31 followed by Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Southeast Missouri ranked 20th to 22nd.

- Chris Wilkerson became the seventh Eastern Illinois head coach at the FCS level to lead the Panthers program to a national ranking during the season. The Panthers moved into the AFCA FCS Coaches Top 25 this week at No. 25. EIU's highest ranking in the national polls at the FCS level has been No. 2 for one week during 2002 season and then for seven weeks during the 2013 campaign.
- Kicker Stone Galloway was 1-of-4 on field goal attempts at Northwestern State as he returns from an injury suffered in pregame warm-ups at Indiana State. Galloway's first kick of the season had been a make from 56-yards to beat McNeese at home, the second longest field goal in program history. His made field goal on Saturday in Louisiana gave him 26 for his career and moved him into a tie for fifth on the EIU career field goals made list.
- Eastern Illinois will be hosting UT Martin for the Panthers annual homecoming game. This marks the 104th time that EIU has played a homecoming game. EIU has an all-time record of 52-43-8 in homecoming contests including a 3-1 record when facing UT Martin as its homecoming opponent. EIU last hosted UT Martin on homecoming in 2018 with the Panthers picking up a 24-21 victory in overtime. EIU also beat the Skyhawks on homecoming in 2003 and 2007 with a loss in 2011.
- Eastern Illinois rotation on the offensive line continued at Northwestern State as the Panthers started their fifth different offensive line combination this season. Guard Max Stineman was lost for the season with a leg injury prior to last week's game after making three starts this year. The lone offensive lineman to start all five games this season has been center Drew Wilder. Last year EIU started eight different combinations on the offensive line with the same starting group in back-to-back games only two times during the season. EIU may add some veteran depth in the next week or two when former starter Elkhanan Tanelus is cleared to return from his injury from last season.
- Eastern Illinois offensive lineman Chad Strickland has been named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy, the academic Heisman Trophy. Strickland, a preseason All-Big South-OVC Football selection, earned his undergraduate degree in pre-physical therapy with a 3.82 GPA and is currently enrolled in the master's program. He was one of 39 players selected from the FCS level and one of three from the Big South-OVC Football Association joining William McRainey from Gardner-Webb and Bradley Clark from Tennessee Tech.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference have merged into a joint conference for the sport of football with ten member schools for the 2023 season. The new Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb with affiliate members Bryant and Robert Morris (Pa.) also playing previously in the Big South. Next season (2024) will again see membership change with Western Illinois joining as a football playing member and Bryant exiting the conference.
- Eastern Illinois has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson and defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. All three were teammates under head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football has expanded its international pool of players as part of their 2023 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland and Jaxson Isaac from Canada. The last two seasons Luoma was a reserve tight end and served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks in 2021. Isaac, another tight end, joined the roster last season using a redshirt season after playing in four games. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage in 2021. The newest international Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's. The last player from Australia to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2023 season with five players in total selected. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Chad Strickland (OL) were voted team captains in the spring following the spring game. Joining that list following fall camp are Justin Thomas (WR), Stone Galloway (K) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL).
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, DeWayne Cooks Jr., Russell Dandy, Juwon Farri, Pierce Holley, Anthony Imperio, Jonah O'Brien, Sebastian Pares, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus and Justin Thomas.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 57-37 career record. UT MARTIN HEAD COACH JASON SIMPSON

Jason Simpson is currently the longest tenured head coach in the Ohio Valley Conference entering his 18th season with UT Martin. In his debut season of 2006, Simpson earned OVC Coach of the Year honors as he led the Skyhawks to a share of the OVC Championship and the school's first FCS Playoff appearance. More recently, UTM advanced to the second round of the FCS playoffs in 2021. Simpson has posted a record of 111-85 with an OVC mark of 83-47. In 2019 he became UTM's career leader in coaching wins and currently ranks fourth in OVC history. Simpson is a 1995 graduate of Southern Mississippi where he played baseball.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN

UT Martin is off to a 4-1 start this season as the Skyhawks have landed in both FCS national polls at No. 18 / 23. Running back Sam Franklin is the nation's top ground gainer this season at 157 yards per game and 785 yards total. He has two 200-yard rushing performances this season with six touchdowns. Kinkead Dent has taken most of the snaps under center passing for 984 yards and ten touchdowns. DeVonte Tanksley has been the top target with 21 catches for 304 yards. The defense is led by Jaylon Sharpe and Carson Evans, both with more than 30 tackles this season.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin will be meeting for the 29th time with UT Martin having won four straight in the series and six of the last seven. EIU holds a 15-13 all-time series lead with the Panthers last win in the series coming in 2018, a 24-21 overtime win at O'Brien Field. This will be the second time the two schools have met with both nationally ranked, the other was Oct. 28, 2006 a 15-9 win by UT Martin in Martin, Tenn.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
