EIU Wraps Up Non-Conference Play At Northwestern State

NOTES TO KNOW

- Freshman MJ Flowers entered Saturday's game against McNeese with four carries for 25 yards on the season. He exited the contest with the third most rushing yards in a single game in EIU history and the most by a college player this season exiting the field with 37 carries for 272 yards and a touchdown. Flowers was named the STATS Perform National Freshman of the Week as well as earning his second straight Big South-OVC Football Freshman of the Week honor. Flowers is currently 33rd in the FCS in rushing yards (297) and 14th in rushing yards per carry (7.22).
- Stone Galloway took the field for his first field goal attempt of the season in the final seconds on Saturday. Galloway, a first-team All-OVC kicker last year, was injured in warm-ups during the season opener at Indiana State on August 31. His first attempt of the year was a 56-yard kick that cleared the cross bar with 20-seconds left in the game. It was the second longest field goal in school history and only the eighth over 50 yards. The last 50-yard field goal made by an EIU kicker was a 52-yard kick by Steve Largent on Oct. 2, 1993 against Indiana State. The field goal by Galloway was the 25th of his career and the longest in FCS this season as he earned Big South-OVC Football Special Teams Player of the Week honors.
- For the second week in a row Eastern Illinois rallied on the final drive for the game winning score. Two weeks ago Pierce Holley found Justin Thomas for a touchdown pass to beat No. 25 Illinois State. This week the Panthers drove the field to beat McNeese on a long field goal by Stone Galloway. EIU trailed in the game 28-7 in the second quarter with the win the largest come back win by EIU since the 2010 season. On Nov. 6, 2010, EIU trailed Tennessee State 28-7 at the half before Jimmy Garoppolo connected with Chris Wright for three second half touchdowns to tie the game and Cameron Berra won it with a 37-yard field goal in overtime. Garoppolo passed for 331 yards in the game while Wright had 217 yards receiving.
- After not collecting a rushing touchdown in its first three games of the season, the Panthers found pay dirt four times on the ground in the win over McNeese. EIU had rushing touchdowns from Pierce Holley, Eli Mirza, MJ Flowers and Juwon Farri as they rushed for a season high 311 yards against the Cowboys. On the season EIU has now had 11 different players score a touchdown with wide receiver Justin Thomas (2) the only player with multiple scores. The 11 different players with a touchdown is first among conference schools just ahead of UT Martin with ten different players who have found the end zone this season.

- Eastern Illinois defense collected just one sack on Saturday against McNeese but it came at the best possible time as Ira Armstead had a sack on the final drive of the game with less than 20 seconds remaining. Armstead, who had two solo tackles in the game, collected just the fourth sack of the season for the Panthers defense joining Blake Ruffin, Phoenix Porter and Jaron Hacha with sacks this season.
- Corner Russell Dandy continues to be around the football for the EIU defense as he had two tackles and a pass break-up in the win over McNeese. Dandy now has five pass break-ups to go along with one interception that ranks him first in the Big South-OVC and 13th in the FCS in passes defended this season. Dandy has added 11 tackles and a fumble recovery to his stats this year. For his career Dandy now has eight career break-ups and three interceptions.
- Junior college wide receiver Eli Mirza has become a top target in the Panthers offense this season hauling in eight passes for 52 yards on Saturday against McNeese. Mirza also added a rushing touchdown with a 12-yard score just before halftime. Mirza currently leads the Panthers with 22 receptions for 201 yards. He is currently third in receiving yards.
- Quarterback Pierce Holley was 21-of-34 for 141 yards in the win over McNeese. While it was Holley's lowest passing total of the season, it was consistent with his completion percentage for the season. Holley is currently 97-of-145 with a season completion percentage of 66.9 percent which ranks the signal caller 25th in the FCS this season. He has passed for 926 yards with six touchdowns, totals that both rank in the Top 30 in the FCS this season. Including his two years as a starter at Georgetown, Holley has now passed for 5,066 yards.
- Juwon Farri had three carries out of the backfield against McNeese with his final carry one of the biggest with a 19-yard run up the middle to tie the game at 28-28. Farri was a two-time FCS All-American at Monmouth and the 2020 Big South Offensive Player of the Year. In a loaded running back room he has rushed for 41 yards this season going over the 2,500 yard mark for his career against McNeese while scoring his 29th career rushing touchdown.
- Linebacker Elijawah Tolbert continues to be consistent and the team leader in tackles for the Panthers defense. Tolbert had a team-high six tackles in Saturday's win over McNeese as he leads the team with 34 tackles this season. Tolbert ranks second in the Big South-OVC in total tackles and 51st in the FCS. He was a first-team All-OVC linebacker last season and was the Stats Perform National Defensive Player of the Week following the season opening win over Indiana State where he had 12 tackles, a forced fumble and interception.
- Joel Barrows played a big part in EIU's defense on Saturday against McNeese finishing with four tackles, a half tackle for loss and two of the Panthers four quarterback hurries on the day. Barrows, who was EIU's returning sack leader from last year with three, has 13 tackles this season with one tackle for loss and a fumble recovery.
- Eastern Illinois defense was not able to force a McNeese turnover on Saturday as both teams played turnover free football. The Panthers ten takeaways this season continues to lead the Big South-OVC and ranks fifth in the FCS. Morgan State is the national leader in turnovers gained with 14.
- EIU's defense once again was steady on third down defense as they held McNeese to 4-of-9 on third down conversions on Saturday. For the season EIU's defense is allowing opponents to convert at just 31.8 percent on third down which ranks 23rd in the FCS and second in the Big South-OVC. Last season EIU had its struggles getting off the field on third down ranking 89th in the FCS allowing opponents to convert at 43 percent.
- Freshman offensive tackle Nic DiSanto got his second start of the season making the start at right tackle as Jack Valente slid over to start at left tackle for Chad Strickland against McNeese. DiSanto's first college start and his first collegiate snaps came at FBS member Bowling Green. EIU has had the injury bug hit its offensive line in bits-and-pieces this year as they have started four different offensive line combinations in four games. Center Drew Wilder is the lone player to start every game this season on the offensive line. Last season EIU had eight different starting offensive line combinations in 11 games with only two games with the same line-up in back to back weeks.
- Wide receiver Justin Thomas hauled in three passes for 28 yards on Saturday against McNeese in his second week back in the active line-up. In his return against Illinois State, Thomas had seven catches for 80 yards including both of the Panthers touchdowns. Thomas, a graduate transfer, was a Division III All-American at Albion and ranks 10th on the NCAA's active player list for receiving yards with 2,922.
- Defensive lineman Drake Van Hyfte has seen increased playing time the last two weeks as the Panthers have missed some defensive linemen due to injury. On Saturday against McNeese he collected one of four EIU tackles for loss finishing the game with three total tackles. Last week against Illinois State he had two tackles with a quarterback hurry.
- EIU's offense has utilized the running back as an additional receiver with the MJ Flowers (12) and Kevin Daniels (11) ranking in the top five on the team in receptions this season. As a unit EIU running backs have caught 24 of the Panthers 97 completed passes this season for 152 yards and a touchdown.

- Eastern Illinois has dominated time of possession in its last two wins over Illinois State and McNeese possessing the football for 11 minutes more than its opponent in both dramatic wins. In both games EIU held the ball for more than 35 minutes in the contest after nearly splitting the time of possession in its opening two road games at Indiana State and Bowling Green. For the season EIU is averaging 32:49 minutes of possession per game which leads the Big South-OVC Football Association and ranks 20th this season in the FCS. The last time EIU had back-to-back games with 35 minutes or more of possession was in late October 2011 against Murray State and UT Martin.
- MJ Flowers big rushing day was the third best single game effort in school history trailing only J.R. Taylor's 308 yards against Florida Atlantic (2002) and Kevin Staple's 283 yards against Grand Valley State (1983). It marked only the fifth time in school history that an EIU running back rushed for more than 250 yards and 22nd time over 200 yards in school history. The last back over the 200-yard mark in a game was Isaiah Johnson with 236 yards against Murray State in 2017.
- Stone Galloway's 56-yard field goal with 20 seconds remaining became his first game winning field goal at Eastern Illinois. Galloway is now 1-of-3 on 50-yard field goal attempts in his career. His previous career long was 44-yards. Galloway is 25-of-33 on career kicks and ranks seventh in career field goals made. The last EIU player to win a game with field goal was Nick Bruno with a 38-yard make in overtime against UT Martin in 2018.
- Punter Jacob Horvath continues to play well during his first season of American football. The freshman from Australia had never seen an American football game in person prior to stepping on the field in the season opener at Indiana State. He responded by being named the Big South-OVC Freshman of the Week. Since that time Horvath has averaged 40.8 yards per punt to rank 40th in the FCS. He has seven punts inside the 20-yard line and two over 50-yards. In addition he has become the holder on field goals and extra points playing a role in both wins by the kicking game the last two weeks.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference have merged into a joint conference for the sport of football with ten member schools for the 2023 season. The new Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb with affiliate members Bryant and Robert Morris (Pa.) also playing previously in the Big South. Next season (2024) will again see membership change with Western Illinois joining as a football playing member and Bryant exiting the conference.
- Eastern Illinois has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson and defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. All three were teammates under head coach Bob Spoo.
- Eastern Illinois football has expanded its international pool of players as part of their 2023 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland and Jaxson Isaac from Canada. The last two seasons Luoma was a reserve tight end and served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks in 2021. Isaac, another tight end, joined the roster last season using a redshirt season after playing in four games. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage in 2021. The newest international Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's. The last player from Australia to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2023 season with five players in total selected. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Chad Strickland (OL) were voted team captains in the spring following the spring game. Joining that list following fall camp are Justin Thomas (WR), Stone Galloway (K) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL).
- Eastern Illinois football has 12 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Alex Alteus, Zed Asowata, DeWayne Cooks Jr., Russell Dandy, Juwon Farri, Pierce Holley, Anthony Imperio, Jonah O'Brien, Sebastian Pares, Chad Strickland, Elkhanan Tanelus and Justin Thomas.
- Eastern Illinois offensive lineman Chad Strickland is the Panthers nominee for the NFF Campbell Trophy, the academic Heisman Trophy. Strickland, a preseason All-Big South-OVC Football selection, earned his undergraduate degree in pre-physical therapy with a 3.82 GPA and is currently enrolled in the master's program.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 56-37 career record. NORTHWESTERN STATE HEAD COACH BRAD LAIRD

Brad Laird is in his sixth season as the head coach at his alma mater, Northwestern State. A quarterback for the Demons in the early 1990's, Laird has spent his entire collegiate coaching career at Northwestern State. He began as a graduate assistant in 1996 and had three different stints as the program's defensive coordinator before becoming the head coach in 2018. Laird has a record of 16-38 after finishing third in the Southland Conference race last season.

SCOUTING NORTHWESTERN STATE

Northwestern State is off to an 0-3 start to the year and will be playing its fourth straight game in The Pelican State as they have played two road games at FBS members Louisiana and Louisiana Tech along with hosting Stephen F. Austin. The Demons defense has allowed 43.3 points per game but does rank in the top 40 in FCS in tackles for loss with 18. Donovan Green is the leader with three TFL while Jared Pedraza, Trevion Sneed and Ty Ely all have 2.5 TFL. Jaeden Ward is the leading tackler with 23 stops. Four backs have split up the carries this season with Scooter Adams the top ball carrier with 128 yards. Tyler Vander Waal has passed for 306 yards with Jaren Mitchell the top target with seven catches.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Northwestern State will be meeting for the second game of a two-year home-and-home series as part of a scheduling alliance between the Ohio Valley Conference and Southland Conference. EIU won last year's opening match-up in Charleston 35-27 to take a 3-1 lead in the all-time series. The previous games in the series all took part in the late 1980's and early 1990's. In the 1993 meeting between the two schools both current head coaches played for the teams they are currently leading. Brad Laird was the Demons quarterback passing for 142 yards and a touchdown. Chris Wilkerson was on the EIU defensive line and made one tackle in the game.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
