# 2024 Season Opens August 29 at Illinois

Eastern Illinois at Illinois Memorial Stadium (60,670) • Champaign, Ill. August 29, 2024 • 8:10 pm • TV: Big Ten Network

#### NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois came up just short of making its 17th FCS Playoff appearance last season as EIU posted an 8-3 record and was listed as one of the first four teams left out of the NCAA Championship field. EIU was ranked No. 24 in the final AFCA FCS Coaches Top 25 poll. This season EIU returns a good number of key contributors on both sides of the football but a second place prediction in the preseason Big South / OVC Football poll had the Panthers listed as the third team also receiving votes in both this year's STATS Perform Media Top 25 and FCS Coaches Top 25 polls.
- Eastern Illinois opens its 123rd season of collegiate football on August 29 as the Panthers will kick off under the lights at Memorial Stadium against Big Ten member Illinois. It will mark the fourth time in program history EIU has opened a season against a member of the Big Ten Conference. EIU opened last season with a 27-0 win at Indiana State snapping what had been a five-game losing skid in season openers. EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson enters his third season and is 1-1 in season openers with the Panthers. He was named the Big South / OVC Football Association Coach of the Year last season and finished sixth in voting for the Eddie Robinson FCS Coach of the Year Award.
- A key piece to the early season excitement about Eastern Illinois football is returning quarterback Pierce Holley. Holley was a second team All-Big South/OVC selection last year after passing for 2,741 yards and 17 touchdowns. Those numbers landed him on the EIU single season top ten list in several categories including passing yards (7th). Holley was named the Big South/OVC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year for 2024 and to the watch list for the 2024 Walter Payton Award.
- Elijawah Tolbert tested the waters of the transfer portal following an All-Big South/OVC season last year spending spring practice at Missouri State. Tolbert transferred back to EIU during the summer and has been named a third team preseason All-American. The senior linebacker, who is a two-time first team All-Conference selection, was also named to the watch list for the 2024 Buck Buchanan Award. Tolbert made a team-high 87 tackles last season with seven tackles for loss.
- Eastern Illinois defense was one of the best in the FCS last season in terms of generating turnovers. EIU finished the season ranked second in the nation with 25 turnovers gained. The Panthers had 14 interceptions and 11 fumble recoveries. EIU returns eight starters from that defensive unit including the front seven. EIU must replace two All-American starters at both safety and corner as only graduate student Mark Aitken returns as a starter in the backfield. In addition to being returning starters, all eight are veteran players in the EIU program and currently either graduate students or seniors.

- MJ Flowers turned in one of the best freshman performances in school history as the running back finished as the runner-up for the FCS Jerry Rice Award presented to the top FCS freshman. Flowers rushed for 854 yards with eight touchdowns. Twice during the season he rushed for more than 200 yards with a season high of 272 against McNeese State the third best total in school history. He had four rushing touchdowns and 201 yards against Tennessee State, the four rushing touchdowns tied for the third most in an EIU game.
- Eli Mirza was one of the Panthers top offensive targets last season as he earned first team All-Big South/OVC honors. Mirza led the Panthers with 61 receptions for 721 yards. He had three touchdown receptions and added another score on the ground. He had a season high ten receptions for 119 yards against UT Martin. Mirza ranked 22nd in the FCS in receptions and 39th in receiving yards last season.
- Part of EIU's offensive success last season was built around the Panthers offensive line playing together more often. From that offensive unit EIU returns starting center Drew Wilder (11 games) starting guard Sebastian Pares (10 games), starting tackle Nic DiSanto (9 games) along with Jack Valente (6 games) and Elkhanan Tanelus (3 games).
- Drake Van Hyfte closed out the 2023 season with a bang as the redshirt junior had five tackles include three sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss in the Panthers final road game victory. The three sacks in a game were the most by a Panther since the 2021 season. Van Hyfte finished as the team leader with nine tackles for loss which ranked 14th in the Big South/OVC. He recorded 6.5 of his season tackles for loss in the final three games.
- EIU football will definitely have a veteran presence this season as 30 of the members on the current roster are either graduate students or seniors (15 of each). A total of 57 members on the Panthers roster are upper classmen this season with 35 of those having appeared in games in previous seasons. Joel Barrows, Anthony Manaves, Anthony Shockey and Elkhanan Tanelus will all be entering their sixth year at EIU having been part of former head coach Adam Cushing's first recruiting class. Eight additional players are entering their fifth year at EIU having joined the Panthers during the 2020 COVID season.
- Eastern Illinois will have to replace two starting All-Americans in the defensive backfield with the loss of safety Blake Ruffin and corner Russell Dandy. EIU returns just one starter from its defensive backfield in Mark Aitken but does have safety Kaelin Drakeford, a starter in 2020 and 2021 returning. The Panthers shored up the corner spot with the relocation of safety NiJhay Burt along with FBS transfers Moses Alexander and Kiwaun Davis. The group is rounded out by FCS transfer Kaleb Lyons who led the FCS in interceptions last season to earn All-America honors.
- As a defensive unit Eastern Illinois registered 68 tackles for loss last season which ranked 37th in the FCS. The Panthers return 75 percent of that production from last season including the team's top six tackle for loss leaders led by Drake Van Hyfte (9), Elijawah Tolbert (7), Anthony Shockey (7), Nicholas Oliveira-Chace (7), Joel Barrows (5.5) and Phoenix Porter (5). Tolbert and Barrows both earned All-Conference honors.
- One question mark for Eastern Illinois this season will be who takes over the Panthers kicking duties and how successful are they in that role. EIU graduated Stone Galloway who was an All-OVC kicker in 2022 but struggled last season going 4-of-14 following a preseason injury. Julian Patino returns after rejoining EIU early in the year. Patino was 3-of-3 on field goals and 12-of-13 on extra points.
- Eastern Illinois was able to play turnover free football for a large portion of the season as the Panthers led the FCS in turnover margin. EIU turned the ball over only ten times for the entire season playing turnover free football in four games including the final two games of the season. On the year EIU had 25 turnovers gained and only ten turnovers lost (plus 1.36).
- Eastern Illinois will play two FBS schools this season as part of the Panthers 12-game regular season schedule. Both opponents come from the Big Ten Conference with the season opener at Illinois and week three at Northwestern. This will mark the eighth time EIU has played a 12-game regular season. Of those eight 12-game regular seasons, this will mark the sixth time EIU has played two FBS schools in the same season and first time both of those FBS schools have been from the same conference.
- When Eastern Illinois kicks off on Thursday night against Illinois it will mark the 46th time that EIU has faced an FBS opponent. The first game for the Panthers against an FBS school was at Toledo during the 1984 season. EIU is 6-39 all-time against FBS schools with the last win coming on Sept. 10, 2016 at Miami (Ohio), a 21-17 win. EIU also has FBS wins over San Diego State (2013), Eastern Michigan (2004), Northern Illinois (1998), Western Michigan (1996) and Akron (1989).
- In addition to senior Eli Mirza, Eastern Illinois returns two other experienced receivers in DeAirious Smith and Cooper Willman along with veteran tight end Anthony Manaves. Smith hauled in 28 passes last year for 494 yards with his 17.6 yards per catch average ranked 24th in the FCS. Willman started 11 games in 2022 before missing most of last year with injury. Manaves has appeared in 39 games with 23 starts.
- EIU's plus six win total last season was nearly enough to place the Panthers into the FCS playoff field as the Panthers went from two wins in 2022 to eight wins in 2023. The plus six wins were tied for the second best turnaround in school history with the 2000 team that improved from two wins in 1999 to eight wins in 2000. The school record is plus 11 wins by the 1978 National Championship team (1 win in 1977 / 12 wins in 1978).

#### MILESTONE MOMENTS ... Players nearing EIU milestones in upcoming games

- Running back MJ Flowers enters the season with 962 career rushing yards at Eastern Illinois. He needs 38 yards to become the 31st player in program history to crack the 1,000 yard mark for their career. The last to do it was Jaelin Benefield in 2022. EIU has 12 players (22 total times) that have rushed for more than 1,000 yards in a single season.
- Quarterback Pierce Holley enters the season with 2,741 career passing yards at Eastern Illinois. He needs 259 yards to become the 16th player in program history to crack the 3,000 yard mark for their career. The last to do it was Harry Woodbery in 2020. EIU has three players (six total times) that have passed for more than 3,000 yards in a single season.
- Kick returner Mark Aitken enters the season with 755 career kick return yards at Eastern Illinois. He needs 53 kick return yards to move into 10th on the EIU career kick return yards chart. Aitken was a second team All-OVC selection at kick returner in 2022. He has a 21.6 yards per return average for his Panther career with a long return of 80 yards in 2022 against Northwestern State. Frank Cutolo (1998-01) currently sits in 10th place on the EIU charts with 808 career kick return yards.

#### SEASON LONG NOTES

- Eastern Illinois football will not leave the state of Illinois during its first six games of the 2024 season which includes three road games and three home games at O'Brien Field. EIU's three road contests take place at Illinois, Northwestern and Illinois State which are a combined 355 miles from the Charleston campus. EIU welcomes Indiana State, Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field for home games during those six weeks. EIU's first venture outside the Prairie State will be on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State where the Panthers will face TSU at Nissan Stadium, located 337 miles from Charleston. It is EIU's longest stretch of games played in the state to open a season since 1941 when the Panthers played all seven games of the year in the State of Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years including this season with two games against teams in the Big Ten Conference. EIU will face Illinois for the season opener and Northwestern in week three of the season. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025, Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027 and Kentucky in 2028.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football last season playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson, defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson and the newest addition quarterback Jacob Rosenstiel.. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. Rosenstiel's father Bob was a tight end for the Panthers in the mid-1990s going on to play briefly in the NFL for the Oakland Raiders. All four played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo crossing over with each other at some point in their Panther careers.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and Globe. EIU's roster features players from 20 different states spanning from California and Oregon on the West Coast to Massachusetts in the Northeast, Florida in the Southeast and Virginia on the East Coast. The farthest reaching Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia who is returning for his second year. The last player from Australia prior to Horvath to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019. In recent year's EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland and The Netherlands.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2024 season with five players in total selected including two who served as team captains during the 2023 season. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL) are team captains for the a second straight season. They are joined by Pierce Holley (QB), Anthony Manaves (TE) and Anthony Shockey (LB).
- Eastern Illinois football has 15 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Mark Aitken, Joel Barrows, Kaelin Drakeford, Pierce Holley, Jamal Jeffers, Tre'jon Lewis, Anthony Manaves, Sebastian Pares, Jerrad Price, Anthony Shockey, Joseph Solomon, Jordan Sprycha, Elkhanan Tanelus, Cooper Willman and Kendi Young.

#### EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 61-39 (10-12 at EIU, 3rd year) career record. #### **BRET BIELEMA**

Bret Bielema enters his fourth season as the head coach at Illinois. The long-time college head coach has posted an 18-19 record in three seasons with the Fighting Illini including a trip to the ReliaQuest Bowl at the end of the 2022 season. Bielema coached seven seasons at Wisconsin leading the Badgers to seven straight bowl games including three trips to the Rose Bowl. He was the head coach at Arkansas for five years taking the Razorbacks to three bowl games. He holds a 115-77 record as a college head coach. Bielema is an Illinois native (Prophetstown) that played college football at Iowa.

#### **SCOUTING ILLINOIS**

Illinois returns some key pieces from last year's team that posted a 5-7 record and came up just short of making a second straight bowl appearance. The Fighting Illini return quarterback Luke Altmyer who passed for 1,883 yards and 13 touchdowns last season. Gone from the roster are his top two targets but Illinois does return Pat Bryant (43 receptions) and running back Kaden Feagin (438 yards). On defense three of the top five tacklers return led by Miles Scott and Xavier Scott. Seth Coleman had 50 tackles last season including a team high nine tackles for loss.

#### THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Illinois will be meeting for the third time with the Fighting Illini holding a 2-0 all-time series lead. The two schools first met to open the 2006 season in what was the Panthers first-ever game against a Big Ten Conference opponent. Illinois won that first meeting 42-17. EIU again made the short trip up I-57 in 2008 losing 47-21. EIU is 0-9 all-time against Big Ten Conference schools having not scored in their last two games against Big Ten opponents (2015 & 2019)

• Eastern Illinois will play an eight game conference schedule this season marking the first time since the 2019 season that the Panthers will play that many conference contests. Since the 2019 season, EIU has been limited to the number of conference contests due to COVID-19 in 2020 and conference realignment over the last four years. During its first season as a league the Big South OVC Football Association only scheduled six conference contests due to previous schedule conflicts with members schools. Including Eastern Illinois, five football playing members from the 2019 OVC still remain in the current Big South/OVC Association.

#### SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
