EIU Makes First Trip To Tar Heel State, Faces Gardner-Webb

Eastern Illinois at Gardner-Webb Spangler Stadium (9,000) • Boiling Springs, NC November 9, 2024 • 12:30 pm • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois makes its first ever trip to the state of North Carolina as the Panthers head to Boiling Springs, NC in the western portion of the state to face Gardner-Webb. Both teams are coming off wins over regional rivals last weekend with EIU beating Western Illinois while Gardner-Webb picked up a win over Charleston Southern. This will be the first meeting between the two schools as GWU was one of four schools that merged with the OVC as former Big South members. With the unbalanced schedule last season, EIU did not face GWU as the Runnin' Bulldogs went 5-1 in the league and captured the inaugural Big South OVC title.
- MJ Flowers was a huge part of the Panthers offense on Saturday in the win over Western Illinois as he finished with 280 all-purpose yards and three touchdowns. Those numbers earned the sophomore running back Big South OVC Offensive Player of the Week honors. The 280 all-purpose yards are the fifth most by an FCS player this season. He just missed his third career 200-yard rushing game finishing with 194 yards. Flowers added 86 yards on three receptions. He is now second in the conference in rushing yards with 726 while his nine touchdowns are the second most in the league and 28th in the FCS. Flowers has 1,698 career rushing yards which ranks 19th on the EIU all-time list needing 111 yards to move up another spot on the chart.
- Tight end Alex Ginnever made his first collegiate catch in the Panthers Oct. 12 game at Tennessee State finishing that contest with seven catches for 43 yards. This past Saturday he added another pair of collegiate firsts with two touchdown catches and a 100 yard receiving day on six receptions. Ginnever becomes the fourth different EIU player to record a 100-yard receiving day this year joining Terrance Gipson (100 vs Indiana State), Cooper Willman (141 at Tennessee State & 143 at UT Martin) and Quenton Rogers (103 at Tennessee State). He is the first EIU tight end to record a 100-yard receiving day since Jeff LePak against UT Martin in 2013 (7 receptions for 196 yards).
- Nicholas Oliveira-Chace returned to the sack column on Saturday against Western Illinois as the senior recorded a solo sack and then picked a half tackle for loss in the win over the Leathernecks. Oliveira-Chace is the Panthers leader in both categories this season with his 5.5 sacks ranking second in the Big South OVC and 38th in the FCS. His 7.5 tackles for loss this season is tied for ninth in the conference. He currently has 29 total tackles this year with four additional quarterback hurries. Last season in 11 games Oliveira-Chace made 35 tackles with seven tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks.

- Pierce Holley dialed up his fifth straight 300-yard passing game on Saturday against Western Illinois going 19-of-27 for 338 yards and five touchdowns. He became the seventh different quarterback in program history to throw five or more touchdowns in a game and the first since Harry Woodbery had five against Tennessee Tech on Sept. 29, 2018. Holley continues to move up both the EIU career charts as his 5,111 passing yards rank sixth all-time at EIU and his 31 touchdown passes are eighth. This season Holley currently ranks ninth in the FCS in passing yards, 17th in total offense and 29th in touchdown passes.
- Cooper Willman continues to inch closer to the 1,000 yard mark for career receiving yards as the senior has been the Panthers top target this season. Willman added three catches for 19 yards with a score on Saturday against Western Illinois. With three games remaining for the season Willman now has 942 yards as he tries to become the 35th player in school history to crack the 1,000 yard mark for their EIU career. Willman leads EIU with 44 receptions for 562 yards this year, both of those totals ranking seventh in the Big South OVC.
- Eastern Illinois offense had its breakout game of the season on Saturday against Western Illinois as the Panthers posted season highs of 45 points and 534 yards of total offense. EIU's previous season-high for points was 27 points against both Indiana State and Southeast Missouri; and 458 yards of total offense against Lindenwood. The last time EIU scored 45 or more points in a game was Nov. 9, 2019 with a 49-38 win at Tennessee State. The last time EIU had 500 or more yards of total offense was 518 yards on Oct. 27, 2018 against Eastern Kentucky.
- It has been a tale of two seasons in the turnover department for Eastern Illinois as the Panthers enter the final three weeks of the year. EIU currently ranks 108th in the FCS in turnover margin at a negative -0.67 margin for the year. Against Western Illinois, the Panthers went their third straight game without forcing a turnover while losing one fumble to the Leathernecks. EIU has surrendered 82 points off turnovers this season for an average of 9.1 points off turnovers per game. Compare that to last season when EIU led the FCS in turnover margin at a plus 1.36 ratio allowing just 17 points off turnovers all year (1.5 ppg game avg.).
- Anthony Shockey tacked on eight more tackles to his season total on Saturday against Western Illinois as the senior linebacker leads the Panthers with 75 tackles this year. It marked the fourth time in the last six games that Shockey has led the team or tied for the team lead in tackles for a game. With three games left in the regular season Shockey is chasing the 100 tackle mark for a season looking to become just the 40th Panthers player to reach the century mark in a season. The last to accomplish the 100 tackle in a season mark was Jason Johnson in 2021 (112 tackles).
- Isaiah Houi had his number called from the bench on Saturday against Western Illinois as the true freshman stepped in when starting corner NiJhay Burt was called for a targeting penalty just seconds into the second quarter. Houi responded with his most snaps of the season making three tackles and being credited with two pass break-ups. Prior to his significant time on Saturday, Houi has appeared in just three games making one tackle at Illinois State. He had additional playing time at Illinois and against Southeast Missouri.
- Senior Joel Barrows was a second team All-Big South OVC selection at defensive end last season after ranking second on the team with four sacks. The previous year (2022) Barrows was the Panther team leader in sacks with three. Each of the last two seasons Barrows has finished the year with 5.5 tackles for loss. On Saturday against Western Illinois Barrows finished with four tackles including a tackle for loss giving him two for the season and now 14 for his career with 7.5 career sacks.
- Jacob Horvath continues to chase the EIU single season record for punting average but was only called upon twice in Saturday's home win over Western Illinois. Horvath has a season average of 44.4 yards per punt which ranks him 13th in the FCS and second in the Big South OVC. He has 11 punts of more than 50 yards and another 12 punts inside the 20-yard line. The EIU single season record for punting average is 44.6 set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season.
- Julian Patino knocked home a field goal for the third consecutive game making a 27-yard kick in the win over Western Illinois. Patino is 3-for-4 on field goals this year with his lone miss a 50-yard attempt at Tennessee State. In his two years as a kicker for the Panthers Patino is 6-of-7 on field goals including a perfect 6-of-6 inside 40-yards. Patino is now 13-of-13 on extra points this year and 25-of-26 for his career.
- For the third time this season Eastern Illinois defense held an opponent below 100 yards rushing for the game as the Panthers limited Western Illinois to 86 yards on 28 carries this past Saturday for an average of 3.1 yards per carry. Earlier this year EIU limited Indiana State to 74 yards on 32 carries (2.3 ypc) and Southeast Missouri to 61 yards on 30 carries (2.0 ypc). Overall on the season EIU is giving up 159 yards per game to opponents which ranks 69th in the FCS with opponents averaging 4.5 yards per carry for the year.
- Eastern Illinois offense was clicking on Saturday against Western Illinois especially in terms of converting on third down. EIU was 10-of-14 on third down conversions for a season high 71.4 percent conversion rate. The Panthers only other conversion rate over 50 percent this season was at Tennessee State going 10-of-18 on third down for 55.6 percent. For the season EIU is converting at 37.8 percent on third down which ranks 66th in the FCS and fourth in the Big South OVC. The last time EIU converted at 70 percent or higher on third down in a game was Sept. 29, 2018 against Tennessee Tech going 11-of-15 (73.3 percent) in a 52-38 win.

- The injury bug has bitten the Eastern Illinois roster this season as the Panthers entered their bye week with a handful of key injuries that needed the week of rest or may be lost for the season. That trend carried over the last two weeks as now through nine weeks of the 2024 season EIU has had 29 missed games by starters on the offensive and defensive sides of the ball. On the offense the wide receiver corps has been hit the hardest with 16 missed games including seven by starter DeAirious Smith. On the defensive side of the ball a total of 13 games have been missed by starters.
- Kick returner Mark Aitken entered the season with 755 career kick return yards at Eastern Illinois. He needed 53 kick return yards to move into 10th on the EIU career kick return yards chart. He has two kick returns for 15 yards this season and now needs 38 yards to crack the top ten. Aitken was a second team All-OVC selection at kick returner in 2022. He has a 21.6 yards per return average for his Panther career with a long return of 80 yards in 2022 against Northwestern State. Frank Cutolo (1998-01) currently sits in 10th place on the EIU charts with 808 career kick return yards.

SEASON LONG NOTES

- Sixth year offensive lineman Elkhanan Tanelus was nominated as EIU's candidate for the William Campbell trophy, presented to the top academic football player in the nation. Tanelus already has both a bachelor's and master's degree from EIU and is pursuing a certificate in business technology this fall.
- Eastern Illinois football will not leave the state of Illinois during its first six games of the 2024 season which includes three road games and three home games at O'Brien Field. EIU's three road contests take place at Illinois, Northwestern and Illinois State which are a combined 355 miles from the Charleston campus. EIU welcomes Indiana State, Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field for home games during those six weeks. EIU's first venture outside the Prairie State will be on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State where the Panthers will face TSU at Nissan Stadium, located 337 miles from Charleston. It is EIU's longest stretch of games played in the state to open a season since 1941 when the Panthers played all seven games of the year in the State of Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years including this season with two games against teams in the Big Ten Conference. EIU faced Illinois for the season opener and traveled to Northwestern in week three of the season. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025, Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027 and Kentucky in 2028.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football last season playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson, defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson and the newest addition quarterback Jacob Rosenstiel. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. Rosenstiel's father Bob was a tight end for the Panthers in the mid-1990s going on to play briefly in the NFL for the Oakland Raiders. All four played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo crossing over with each other at some point in their Panther careers.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and Globe. EIU's roster features players from 20 different states spanning from California and Oregon on the West Coast to Massachusetts in the Northeast, Florida in the Southeast and Virginia on the East Coast. The farthest reaching Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia who is returning for his second year. The last player from Australia prior to Horvath to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019. In recent year's EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland and The Netherlands.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2024 season with five players in total selected including two who served as team captains during the 2023 season. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL) are team captains for the a second straight season. They are joined by Pierce Holley (QB), Anthony Manaves (TE) and Anthony Shockey (LB).
- Eastern Illinois football has 15 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Mark Aitken, Joel Barrows, Kaelin Drakeford, Pierce Holley, Jamal Jeffers, Tre'jon Lewis, Anthony Manaves, Sebastian Pares, Jerrad Price, Anthony Shockey, Joseph Solomon, Jordan Sprycha, Elkhanan Tanelus, Cooper Willman and Kendi Young.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 63-46 (12-19 at EIU, 3rd year) career record. GARDNER-WEBB HEAD COACH CRIS REISERT

Gardner-Webb is led by first-year head coach Cris Reisert who has posted a 3-6 record in his first year in Boiling Springs including a 2-3 record in the Big South OVC. Reisert came to GWU following a successful five-year stint as the head coach at Division II Tiffin University where he posted a 40-11 record including a 32-4 mark in conference play. The 40 wins were the most by any Tiffin coach in a five-year span in program history and culminated last season with an 11-1 record while reaching the second round of the NCAA playoffs. As a player at Ohio Dominican he was the 2007 NAIA National Player of the Year earning his degree from Ohio Dominican in 2009. Reisert has had assistant coaching stops at Ball State, Elon and Ohio Dominican.

SCOUTING GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb entered the 2024 season coming off consecutive conference championships and FCS playoff appearances. The Runnin' Bulldogs won the final Big South Conference title in 2022 and then were co-champions of the inaugural Big South OVC Football Association in 2023. This season they are 3-6 overall, 2-3 in the Big South OVC under a new head coach. Balanced offense has been part of the GWU story with three running backs over 300 yards this season and quarterback Tyler Ridell passing for 1,795 yards. Three receivers have 20 or more catches this season. On defense Gardner-Webb has been disruptive ranking 15th in the FCS in tackles for loss and 16th in the country in sacks. Trevor Moffitt and Jackson Marshall both have 7.5 tackles for loss with Moffitt the leading tackler with 49 stops.

THE SERIES

This will be the first meeting between Eastern Illinois and Gardner-Webb in football as the two schools did not meet last season in the inaugural Big South OVC season that saw teams only play six conference games. EIU was 2-0 against former Big South members last season with wins over Bryant and Robert Morris, both schools which were just one year members of the Big South OVC. EIU will face the other Big South holdover, Charleston Southern, on November 16 in Charleston, Illinois.

SERIES DID YOU KNOW FACTS...

- 1.) This will mark the first time in program history EIU football has played a game in the state of North Carolina or against a program from the state. EIU does have two other major team sports who have faced the Runnin' Bulldogs with men's basketball picking up a win over Gardner-Webb and the EIU softball team posting a 2-4 all-time record against GWU.
- 2.) Both Eastern Illinois and Gardner-Webb posted conference wins in regional rivalry games last weekend. EIU beat Western Illinois as the two schools met for the first time as conference rivals since the 1995 season when the rivalry was played annually for the Mayor's Cup. GWU beat Charleston Southern in the inaugural North/South BBQ Bowl. The two schools have met as conference rivals since 2002.
- Eastern Illinois will play an eight game conference schedule this season marking the first time since the 2019 season that the Panthers will play that many conference contests. Since the 2019 season, EIU has been limited to the number of conference contests due to COVID-19 in 2020 and conference realignment over the last four years. During its first season as a league the Big South OVC Football Association only scheduled six conference contests due to previous schedule conflicts with members schools. Including Eastern Illinois, five football playing members from the 2019 OVC still remain in the current Big South/OVC Association.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.
