Panthers Wrap Up 2024 Home Schedule With Senior Day

Eastern Illinois vs. Charleston Southern O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. November 16, 2024 • 12 pm • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois plays its final home game of the 2024 season as the Panthers host the southern most school in the Big South OVC in Charleston Southern. This will be the first meeting between the two schools who have both suffered a handful of close loses that sees both of them at the bottom of the conference standings. EIU is coming off a road loss at Gardner-Webb while Charleston Southern lost its final home game to UT Martin. The Panthers will honor 27 members of this year's senior class prior to the start of the contest.
- Cooper Willman landed himself in the record books on Saturday as the wide receiver finished with a school record 291 yards receiving on 11 catches with three touchdowns. More impressive is that he had just two catches for 39 yards at halftime, so did the bulk of his damage in the second half. The 291 yards is the most in the FCS this season and is the record of the two-year old Big South OVC Football Association. The total ranks third all-time in OVC history with the two other games both over 300 yards. Willman broke the record set by Erik Lora (269) during the 2012 season and during the game became the 35th player in school history with more than 1,000 receiving yards in his career. Willman has now has 55 receptions for 853 yards and eight touchdowns ranking in the FCS Top 15 in both receptions (13th) and receiving yards (15th) this year. Willman is looking to post just the 10th 1,000 yard receiving season in EIU history needing 147 more yards this season.
- Pierce Holley passed for more than 300 yards in a game for the sixth straight week finishing with 458 yards on Saturday at Gardner-Webb. It was the sixth most passing yards in a game by a Panthers quarterback as Holley has now passed for 2,828 yards this season. He is on the verge of becoming just the fourth quarterback in program history to pass for 3,000 yards in a season joining Sean Payton, Tony Romo and Jimmy Garoppolo (combined six times among those three). With two games remaining in the regular season, Holley is chasing the career 10,000 yards passing mark (has 9,746) along with landing high both the EIU single season and career record top ten lists.
- CJ Nelson became an underlying story on Saturday as the transfer receiver had his best day in a Panthers uniform finishing with 101 yards on five catches with a touchdown. Nelson has appeared in nine games this season with two starts at Tennessee State and at Gardner-Webb. He has 17 receptions for 250 yards, a 14.7 yards per catch average. Nelson becomes the fifth different EIU player to record a 100-yard receiving game this season joining Cooper Willman (3), Quenton Rogers, Alex Ginnever and Terrance Gipson.

- While Cooper Willman and CJ Nelson both individually finished with more than 100 yards receiving it marked the second time this season that the Panthers have had two 100-yard receivers in the same game. Both Willman and Quenton Rogers passed the century mark on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State. It marks the 22nd time in school history that EIU has had two receivers finish with more than 100 yards in the same game and only the second time in school history one of the two had more than 200 yards in the contest. The combined 392 yards between Willman and Nelson is the second most in a game when two receivers both go over the 100 yard mark in a contest.
- Jacob Horvath launched three punts with consistency on Saturday at Gardner-Webb as the sophomore averaged 48.3 yards per punt with a long of 51 yards. On the season the Australian native ranks 13th in the FCS with a 44.7 yards per punt average. With two games remaining on the season Horvath is chasing the Panthers single season punting average record of 44.6 set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season. Even if Horvath falls short of the record he is on pace to finish as one of just four punters in school history to average 43 yards or better for punting average for the season joining former NFL All-Pro punter Jeff Gossett (43.0 in 1977), Cook (44.6 in 2007) and Trey Wilhoit (44.0 in 2022).
- Eastern Illinois was in the big play business for the second week in a row on offense as Pierce Holley connected with Cooper Willman for an 80-yard touchdown strike in the fourth quarter. It was the ninth time in school history EIU has scored on a passing touchdown of 80 or more yards. The previous week Holley hooked up with MJ Flowers for a 64-yard touchdown pass in the third quarter. The Panthers defense was the first unit to turn in a big play for a score this season when Moses Alexander scooped up a fumble and raced 60 yards for a score in the home win over Indiana State.
- Nicholas Oliveira-Chace added to his season tackles for loss total as he recorded one of the Panthers seven tackles for loss in the game at Gardner-Webb. The senior defensive lineman leads EIU in both tackles for loss (8.5) and sacks (5.5) this season. He ranks 12th in the Big South OVC in tackles for loss while landing at fourth on the league leaders list for sacks. The 5.5 sacks this season are the most by a Panthers player since Jarvis Williams had 5.5 to lead EIU during 2016. Oliveira-Chace ranks eighth on the team with 31 tackles this year.
- Freshman Isaiah Houi made his first start on Saturday at Gardner-Webb finishing with three tackles, a tackle for loss and two pass break-ups. Houi was called into more extensive action in the home win over Western Illinois when starting corner NiJhay Burt was called for targeting. Houi finished that game with three tackles and two pass break-ups. Prior to the time against WIU, Houi had played on special teams in three games making one tackle. His four pass break-ups this season already lead the team as EIU has 31 for the season.
- Protecting the quarterback was something EIU had done extremely well in the early portion of the season allowing just one each against Illinois and Indiana State in the opening two weeks of the year and then three against the Panthers second Big Ten opponent in Northwestern. On Saturday at Gardner-Webb, EIU allowed a season high 11 sacks to the Runnin' Bulldogs which dropped the Panthers to 112th in the FCS in sacks allowed at 3.20 per game. Since the 2002 season EIU has allowed eight or more sacks in game only two other times with eight sacks by Illinois State last season and eight by Tennessee Tech in 2010.
- Eastern Illinois was effective on third down for the second consecutive week as the Panthers converted 8-of-14 for 57 percent in Saturday's game at Gardner-Webb. That percentage was coming off a 10-of-14 day (71) percent against Western Illinois. EIU has converted at 50 percent or better in three of its last four games increasing its season percentage to 40 percent. The last time EIU converted at 50 percent or better on third down in back-to-back games was during the 2015 season in games against Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri on October 3 and 10.
- Eastern Illinois defense was unable to come up with a turnover for the fourth straight game. On the season EIU has eight turnovers gained after ranking second in the FCS in turnovers gained last year with 25. NiJhay Burt and Moses Alexander are tied as the teams individual leader's in turnovers gained with three each. Burt has three interceptions which ranks him 32nd in the FCS. Alexander has two fumble recoveries and one interception. The other two turnovers gained came on interceptions. Since 2001 EIU has had two other seasons where the Panthers have had stretches of three straight games without a turnover with three games in the middle of the 2011 season and three games to open the 2018 season.
- Anthony Shockey is still within range of joining the 100 tackle club for the season as the senior linebacker enters the final two weeks of the season with 81 total tackles. Shockey ranks 46th in the FCS in total tackles and third in the Big South OVC. He is looking to become just the 40th player in school history to record 100 tackles in a season. This season he has posted three double figure tackle games and has five double figure tackle games in his career. Shockey has made 206 tackles in his career with 19.5 tackles for loss.
- Eastern Illinois will have several super seniors as part of its class playing the final two games of the year. Three players will be finishing up their sixth season as members of the Panthers football program, all coming in as part of former head coach Adam Cushing's first recruiting class. Based on a combination of redshirt years and the COVID-19 season Anthony Manaves, Anthony Shockey and Elkhanan Tanelus are all in their sixth year having played their first season in 2019. Quarterback Pierce Holley is also in his sixth season have started at Georgetown in 2019 while safety Mark Aitken is his sixth season having began his career in 2019 at Northern Illinois.

- The injury bug has bitten the Eastern Illinois roster this season as the Panthers entered their bye week with a handful of key injuries that needed the week of rest or may be lost for the season. That trend carried over the last three weeks as now through ten weeks of the 2024 season EIU has had 34 missed games by starters on the offensive and defensive sides of the ball. On the offense the wide receiver corps has been hit the hardest with 19 missed games on that side of the ball. On the defensive side of the ball a total of 15 games have been missed by starters with most in the secondary.
- Kick returner Mark Aitken entered the season with 755 career kick return yards at Eastern Illinois. He needed 53 kick return yards to move into 10th on the EIU career kick return yards chart. He has two kick returns for 15 yards this season and now needs 38 yards to crack the top ten. Aitken was a second team All-OVC selection at kick returner in 2022. He has a 21.6 yards per return average for his Panther career with a long return of 80 yards in 2022 against Northwestern State. Frank Cutolo (1998-01) currently sits in 10th place on the EIU charts with 808 career kick return yards.

SEASON LONG NOTES

- Sixth year offensive lineman Elkhanan Tanelus was nominated as EIU's candidate for the William Campbell trophy, presented to the top academic football player in the nation. Tanelus already has both a bachelor's and master's degree from EIU and is pursuing a certificate in business technology this fall.
- Eastern Illinois football will not leave the state of Illinois during its first six games of the 2024 season which includes three road games and three home games at O'Brien Field. EIU's three road contests take place at Illinois, Northwestern and Illinois State which are a combined 355 miles from the Charleston campus. EIU welcomes Indiana State, Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field for home games during those six weeks. EIU's first venture outside the Prairie State will be on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State where the Panthers will face TSU at Nissan Stadium, located 337 miles from Charleston. It is EIU's longest stretch of games played in the state to open a season since 1941 when the Panthers played all seven games of the year in the State of Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years including this season with two games against teams in the Big Ten Conference. EIU faced Illinois for the season opener and traveled to Northwestern in week three of the season. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025, Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027 and Kentucky in 2028.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football last season playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson, defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson and the newest addition quarterback Jacob Rosenstiel.. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. Rosenstiel's father Bob was a tight end for the Panthers in the mid-1990s going on to play briefly in the NFL for the Oakland Raiders. All four played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo crossing over with each other at some point in their Panther careers.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and Globe. EIU's roster features players from 20 different states spanning from California and Oregon on the West Coast to Massachusetts in the Northeast, Florida in the Southeast and Virginia on the East Coast. The farthest reaching Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia who is returning for his second year. The last player from Australia prior to Horvath to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019. In recent year's EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland and The Netherlands.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2024 season with five players in total selected including two who served as team captains during the 2023 season. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL) are team captains for the a second straight season. They are joined by Pierce Holley (QB), Anthony Manaves (TE) and Anthony Shockey (LB).
- Eastern Illinois football has 15 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Mark Aitken, Joel Barrows, Kaelin Drakeford, Pierce Holley, Jamal Jeffers, Tre'jon Lewis, Anthony Manaves, Sebastian Pares, Jerrad Price, Anthony Shockey, Joseph Solomon, Jordan Sprycha, Elkhanan Tanelus, Cooper Willman and Kendi Young.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 63-47 (12-20 at EIU, 3rd year) career record. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN HEAD COACH GABE GIARDINA

Gabe Giardina returned for his third stint at Charleston Southern in November 2022 and first as the head coach of the Buccaneers program. Giardina served previous stints as the running backs coach from 2008-11 and offensive coordinator from 2013-16. He is currently in his second season as the CSU head coach with a 5-16 record including a 2-11 mark in the Big South OVC. Giardina took over the program following a successful six-year run as the head coach at Albany State where he posted a winning record in five seasons with the 2020 season not played due to COVID-19. He led the Rams program to an NCAA Division II playoff appearance in 2021. In eight years as a collegiate head coach Giardina has a 42-33 record.

SCOUTING CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern plays its final Big South OVC game of the season on Saturday at Eastern Illinois with the Buccaneers scheduled to end the regular season next week at Florida State. CSU enters at 1-9 overall, 0-7 in the conference but four of their losses have come by five points or less this season. As a defensive unit CSU ranks 33rd in the FCS in turnovers gained and fourth in the country in fumbles recovered with 11. Ja'Kobe North has 32 tackles and ranks 11th in the country with passes defended with 12 pass break-ups. Steve Zayachkowsky leads the defense with 65 tackles. The Buccaneers special teams are led by one of the top punters in FCS in Gilbert Brown who ranks fourth in the FCS with a 46.1 yards per punt average. On offense Autavius Ison has rushed for 714 yards. Quarterback duties have been split between Rob McCoy and Kaleb Jackson with both passing for more than 575 yards and four touchdowns each.

THE SERIES

This will be the first meeting between Eastern Illinois and Charleston Southern and marks the second straight week EIU has faced a former member of the Big South Conference that is now playing in the joint Big South OVC Football Association. EIU played Gardner-Webb for the first time last week losing 31-28. Last season EIU played the other two former Big South members Bryant and Robert Morris beating both teams who left the Big South OVC after just one season. This will be EIU's second ever game against a team from the state of South Carolina losing to the flagship school of the state the SEC's South Carolina Gamecocks, 46-0, on Sept. 4, 2021.

SERIES DID YOU KNOW FACTS...

- 1.) There are 22 United States cities with the name Charleston but only two that are homes to NCAA Division I institutions. Charleston, Illinois is home to Eastern Illinois while Charleston, South Carolina has three Division I schools that call it home in Charleston Southern, College of Charleston and The Citadel. The city of Charleston, West Virginia is home to two Division II schools.
- 2.) Charleston Southern is the furthest geographic member that Eastern Illinois faces in the Big South OVC Football Association. The listed distance between the schools is 845 miles. Last week's opponent, Gardner-Webb, sits 656 miles from EIU's campus. The Panthers farthest traditional OVC rival is Tennessee Tech at 361 miles while EIU's closest OVC rival is now Lindenwood at 155 miles.
- Eastern Illinois will play an eight game conference schedule this season marking the first time since the 2019 season that the Panthers will play that many conference contests. Since the 2019 season, EIU has been limited to the number of conference contests due to COVID-19 in 2020 and conference realignment over the last four years. During its first season as a league the Big South OVC Football Association only scheduled six conference contests due to previous schedule conflicts with members schools. Including Eastern Illinois, five football playing members from the 2019 OVC still remain in the current Big South/OVC Association.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.

RECAP

Eastern Illinois rallied from a 31-7 deficit midway through the third quarter and had a chance to win the game on a fourth quarter drive that ended with an interception in the endzone and a 31-28 loss at Gardner-Webb. Cooper Willman had a record setting day with a program record 291 yards receiving and three touchdowns, the final one bringing EIU to within 31-28 with 4:59 remaining in the game. Willman's total is the third most in OVC history and sets a Big South OVC record. Pierce Holley passed for 458 yards and CJ Nelson finished with 101 yards receiving to give the Panthers two receivers over the 100 yard mark. EIU was in the game despite allowing 11 sacks which made the end of the day rushing total stand at seven yards.
