Panthers Host Southeast Missouri For Homecoming

Eastern Illinois vs. No. 13 Southeast Missouri O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. October 5, 2024 • 2 pm • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois hosts No. 13 Southeast Missouri on Saturday for the Panthers 2024 homecoming contest. This will be EIU's second game this season against a nationally ranked opponent. The Panthers lost at home last weekend to Lindenwood dropping their Big South OVC opener falling to 1-4 overall, 0-1 in the conference. Southeast Missouri has won three in a row with a non-conference shutout win over Northwestern State. The Redhawks enter at 4-1 overall, 1-0 in the conference.
- Pierce Holley passed for 326 yards and two touchdowns on Saturday against Lindenwood marking the third time in Holley's EIU career that he has passed for 300 or more yards. Last season Holley eclipsed the 300-yard mark in back-to-back weeks throwing for 359 against UT Martin and 346 against Southeast Missouri. Earlier this year he became the 16th player in school history to pass for 3,000 or more yards in a career. Holley currently ranks 12th on the EIU career list with 3,721 yards needing 99 passing yards to crack the Panthers top ten. He has 7,898 career passing yards including his three seasons at Georgetown.
- MJ Flowers posted his second 100-yard rushing game this season finishing with 123 yards on the ground against Lindenwood. It was the fifth time in his EIU career with a 100 or more yards including a career high 272 last season against McNeese. Flowers ranks 25th on the EIU career rushing chart with 1,350 yards joining the 1,000 yard club in the season opener at Illinois. Flowers is 34th in the FCS in rushing this season and second in the Big South OVC.
- Moses Alexander has been around the football all season on the defensive side of the ball. On Saturday he picked off a pass for the lone turnover by either team in the game against Lindenwood. It was the third turnover gained by the transfer corner from Houston to go along with his two fumble recoveries. One of those fumble recoveries he took to the house 60-yards for a touchdown in the home win over Indiana State. Alexander ranks second in the FCS this season in fumbles recovered and his 30 tackles rank him fourth on the team.
- Punter Jacob Horvath continues to be a weapon for the Panthers special teams as he averaged 48.4 yards per punt on Saturday against Lindenwood. For the season Horvath ranks sixth in the FCS with a punting average of 46.8 yards per punt. He has eight punts over 50 yards with a long of 76. He has also pinned eight punts inside the 20-yard line. He was the Big South OVC Special Teams Player of the Week two weeks ago. The EIU single season punting average record is 44.6 by Kevin Cook in 2007.

- Linebacker Anthony Shockey continues to have a nose for the football this season as he leads the Panthers in tackles with 42. Shockey finished with ten tackles against Lindenwood marking the second straight week he has posted a ten tackle game. He has four career double figure tackle games with a high of 11 last season at Bowling Green. 28 of Shockey's 42 tackles have been solo stops which ranks 8th in the FCS.
- Eli Mirza has caught multiple passes in every game in his EIU career extending that streak to 16 straight games with seven catches for 69 yards and a touchdown against Lindenwood. Mirza now has 80 career catches for 916 yards. He needs 84 yards to become the 34th player in school history with 1,000 or more career receiving yards. The last to join the club was tight end James Sheehan in 2019. Mirza ranked 22nd in the FCS in receptions last year and his top game was ten catches for 119 yards against UT Martin.
- Kaelin Drakeford made plays once again for the Panthers defense finishing with a team-high 11 tackles against Lindenwood including helping with a goal line stop on fourth-and-one. Last week at Illinois State, Drakeford was involved in both EIU turnovers gained forcing a fumble that was recovered in the end zone and picking off a pass. Drakeford has 31 tackles to rank second on the EIU team this fall.
- Entering the fifth game of the 2024 season, EIU was one of six teams that had not returned a punt during the year with four of the six teams playing as Big South OVC members. That changed on Lindenwood's first punt of the game as Cooper Willman returned a punt 25 yards. He would add one other punt return in the game and EIU quickly jumped from no punt returns to 16th in the FCS (1st in Big South/OVC) in punt return average. Willman, who was a second team All-OVC punt returner two years ago, also added five catches for 71 yards and his second touchdown reception this season.
- Eastern Illinois will play its second nationally ranked FCS team this season when the Panthers welcome No. 13 Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field on Saturday. EIU is 26-78 all-time against FCS ranked opponents including the loss earlier this season to No. 15 Illinois State. The Panthers last win over a nationally ranked opponent was last season with a 14-13 win over No. 14 Illinois State. Prior to that, the last win over a nationally ranked foe was Sept. 30, 2017 with an overtime road win at Tennessee State. EIU had lost 15 straight to nationally ranked opponents between those two games.
- EIU continues to be one of the least penalized teams in the FCS. The Panthers are currently 20th in the FCS in fewest penalty yards per game at 40.4. EIU had its highest game in terms of both penalties and yards last week against Lindenwood with six penalties for 62 yards. EIU's lowest total this year was two penalties for 15 yards at Northwestern.
- The Panthers defense was able to get to the quarterback just one time on Saturday afternoon with Malik Rainey credited with a 12-yard sack. On the season EIU has registered six total sacks with Nicholas Oliveira-Chace the team leader with 3.5 which ranks the defensive end 46th in the FCS and second in the Big South OVC. Oliveira-Chace also leads EIU with five tackles for loss and is sixth on the team with 19 tackles.
- While EIU's defense only managed to get one sack on Saturday, the Panthers offensive line also only surrendered one sack marking the third time this season that unit up front has allowed only one sack in a game. On the season EIU ranks 51st in the FCS and third in the Big South OVC in fewest sacks allowed.
- Time of possession had been a statistic that EIU had not won in its opening four games of the season with the Panthers offense averaging just over 25 minutes per game with a season low of 23:59 time of possession in the opener at Illinois. The Panthers were able to establish a ground game against Lindenwood on Saturday holding the ball for 30:38, EIU's first time of possession advantage this year.
- EIU's defense picked up its seventh turnover of the season on Saturday with Moses Alexander's interception. The Panthers rank 35th in the FCS and third in the Big South OVC in turnovers gained this season. Alexander has three of the seven turnovers gained joined by NiJhay Burt with two interceptions and Kaelin Drakeford with one interception.
- Terrance Gipson continues to develop into an offensive weapon for the Panthers as he was the top receiver on Saturday with nine catches for 93 yards. Earlier this year Gipson had a 100-yard receiving day in the home win over Indiana State. Gipson, who started his career as a quarterback at SMU, currently leads the Panthers with 21 catches for 235 yards and an 11.2 yards per reception average.
- Eastern Illinois matched its total for fewest tackles for loss allowed in a game this season with just three Lindenwood tackles for loss on Saturday. The total matched the three allowed to Illinois in the season opener as the fewest allowed this season. EIU is allowing just four tackles for loss per game this season which ranks 23rd in the FCS and first in the Big South OVC. The highest number surrendered this season was six to Indiana State.
- On the flip side EIU was held to its season low for tackles for loss by its defense as the Panthers finished with two against Lindenwood on Saturday. Malik Rainey had one with a sack while Drake Van Hyfte and Tre'jon Lewis combined on the other. For the season EIU has been averaging five tackles for loss per game which is sixth in the Big South OVC. Nicholas Oliveira-Chace leads the team with five with Anthony Shockey (2.5), Van Hyfte (3) and Nick Coates (2) all collecting multiple tackles for loss this year.

Eastern Illinois Returning All-Conference Players

- This will be the 104th homecoming game for Eastern Illinois football when the Panthers host Southeast Missouri on Saturday afternoon. EIU is 52-43-8 all-time in homecoming games but the Panthers enter the 2024 homecoming game having lost four straight homecoming games. EIU's last win for homecoming was in 2018 with a 24-21 overtime win against UT Martin. This will be the fourth time EIU has hosted Southeast Missouri for its homecoming having previous wins in 2001 (W 12-0), 2008 (W 24-21) and 2013 (55-33).
- Kick returner Mark Aitken entered the season with 755 career kick return yards at Eastern Illinois. He needed 53 kick return yards to move into 10th on the EIU career kick return yards chart. He has two kick returns for 15 yards this season and now needs 38 yards to crack the top ten. Aitken was a second team All-OVC selection at kick returner in 2022. He has a 21.6 yards per return average for his Panther career with a long return of 80 yards in 2022 against Northwestern State. Frank Cutolo (1998-01) currently sits in 10th place on the EIU charts with 808 career kick return yards.

SEASON LONG NOTES

- Sixth year offensive lineman Elkhanan Tanelus was nominated as EIU's candidate for the William Campbell trophy, presented to the top academic football player in the nation. Tanelus already has both a bachelor's and master's degree from EIU and is pursuing a certificate in business technology this fall.
- Eastern Illinois football will not leave the state of Illinois during its first six games of the 2024 season which includes three road games and three home games at O'Brien Field. EIU's three road contests take place at Illinois, Northwestern and Illinois State which are a combined 355 miles from the Charleston campus. EIU welcomes Indiana State, Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field for home games during those six weeks. EIU's first venture outside the Prairie State will be on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State where the Panthers will face TSU at Nissan Stadium, located 337 miles from Charleston. It is EIU's longest stretch of games played in the state to open a season since 1941 when the Panthers played all seven games of the year in the State of Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years including this season with two games against teams in the Big Ten Conference. EIU faced Illinois for the season opener and traveled to Northwestern in week three of the season. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025, Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027 and Kentucky in 2028.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football last season playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson, defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson and the newest addition quarterback Jacob Rosenstiel.. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. Rosenstiel's father Bob was a tight end for the Panthers in the mid-1990s going on to play briefly in the NFL for the Oakland Raiders. All four played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo crossing over with each other at some point in their Panther careers.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and Globe. EIU's roster features players from 20 different states spanning from California and Oregon on the West Coast to Massachusetts in the Northeast, Florida in the Southeast and Virginia on the East Coast. The farthest reaching Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia who is returning for his second year. The last player from Australia prior to Horvath to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019. In recent year's EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland and The Netherlands.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2024 season with five players in total selected including two who served as team captains during the 2023 season. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL) are team captains for the a second straight season. They are joined by Pierce Holley (QB), Anthony Manaves (TE) and Anthony Shockey (LB).
- Eastern Illinois football has 15 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Mark Aitken, Joel Barrows, Kaelin Drakeford, Pierce Holley, Jamal Jeffers, Tre'jon Lewis, Anthony Manaves, Sebastian Pares, Jerrad Price, Anthony Shockey, Joseph Solomon, Jordan Sprycha, Elkhanan Tanelus, Cooper Willman and Kendi Young.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 62-43 (11-16 at EIU, 3rd year) career record. SOUTHEAST MISSOURI HEAD COACH TOM MATUKEWICZ

Tom Matukewicz is in his 11th season as the head coach at Southeast Missouri having led the Redhawks to back-to-back FCS playoff appearances in 2018 and 2019 and again in 2022. Matukewicz was a long time assistant coach as a member of head coach Jerry Kill's staff at both Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois. He was the defensive coordinator at Toledo for two seasons before taking over at SEMO. Matukewicz is a 1997 graduate of Fort Hays State in Kansas. He is 59-60 overall, 42-30 in the OVC with the Redhawks once again nationally ranked.

SCOUTING SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Southeast Missouri enters on a three-game win streak with a healthy Paxton DeLaurent having passed for 1,305 yards and 13 touchdowns through five games this season. Dorian Anderson had 32 receptions and five touchdowns. Mitchell Sellers has four touchdown grabs. Payton Brown has 256 yards rushing and four scores on the ground. Bryce Norman leads the Redhawks defense with 47 tackles. Khalani Riddick is just behind him with 43 stops. SEMO has 13 sacks as a team this season.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri will be meeting for the 32nd time on Saturday with the Panthers holding a 18-13 all-time series lead. SEMO has won six straight in the series including a 35-28 win over the Panthers last October. EIU's last win in the series was a 19-16 win in Charleston on Sept. 23, 2017. The two schools first met in a homeand-home series in 1956 and 1957 with SEMO winning both of those contests.

SERIES DID YOU KNOW FACTS...

- 1.) Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri will be playing for the 15th time on Saturday when one of the two schools are nationally ranked. Only once in the previous 14 meetings has the unranked team pulled an upset with SEMO beating 13th ranked EIU 21-14 during the 2016 season. EIU is 9-1 when it is the ranked team. SEMO is 4-0 when it is the ranked team.
- 2.) Both Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri are both involved in long standing rivalry games turned trophy games with members of the Missouri Valley Football Conference. EIU plays Illinois State in the Mid-America Classic which had its 112th game this September. SEMO and Southern Illinois play in the War for the Wheel which had its 92nd game this September.
- Eastern Illinois will play an eight game conference schedule this season marking the first time since the 2019 season that the Panthers will play that many conference contests. Since the 2019 season, EIU has been limited to the number of conference contests due to COVID-19 in 2020 and conference realignment over the last four years. During its first season as a league the Big South OVC Football Association only scheduled six conference contests due to previous schedule conflicts with members schools. Including Eastern Illinois, five football playing members from the 2019 OVC still remain in the current Big South/OVC Association.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth all-time among FCS schools.
