#### **EIU Renews Long Time Conference Rivalry With WIU**

Eastern Illinois vs. Western Illinois O'Brien Field (10,000) • Charleston, Ill. November 2, 2024 • 2 pm • TV: ESPN+

#### NOTES TO KNOW

- Eastern Illinois renews a long-time rivalry with Western Illinois on Saturday afternoon as the Panthers welcome the Leathernecks to Charleston for Family Weekend. EIU is 1-7 on the season, 0-4 in the Big South OVC following a road loss at UT Martin. WIU is 3-5, 2-2 in the Big South OVC after a shootout loss to Lindenwood. This marks the third different conference that the two schools have faced each in as members starting with the IIAC followed by years in the Gateway Conference and now Big South OVC. It will be the first time they have met as conference foes since the 1995 season. WIU has won the five meetings in-between conference contests including a win in the 2002 FCS playoffs, the last collegiate game for quarterback Tony Romo.
- Cooper Willman continues to become the Panthers go to receiver as the season progresses as the senior finished with career highs of 11 receptions and 143 yards with a touchdown at UT Martin. It was the second consecutive 100-yard receiving day for Willman who had eight catches for 141 yards at Tennessee State. The last EIU wide receiver with back-to-back 100-yard receiving games was Isaiah Hill with three straight to end the 2021 season. Willman leads the Panthers with 41 receptions for 543 yards with his receptions ranking 37th in the FCS and receiving yards landing at 41st in the FCS. He now has 75 career catches for 923 yards as he looks to become the 35th EIU player to pass the 1,000 yard receiving mark for their career.
- Pierce Holley passed for 348 yards and two touchdowns at UT Martin marking the fourth straight game Holley has passed for 300 or more yards in a game. It was his sixth career 300-yard game at EIU moving him into fifth all-time on the Panthers list.. Holley ranks tenth this season in the FCS with 2,032 passing yards. He has 4,773 passing yards at EIU to rank sixth on the EIU all-time charts while his 26 touchdown passes at EIU are now tied for 10th. Jimmy Garoppolo was the last EIU quarterback with three or more 300-yard passing games, opening the 2013 season with nine straight 300-yard games.
- Linebacker Anthony Shockey continues to be around the football for the Panthers defense this season as he tied for the team lead with eight tackles on Saturday at UT Martin. It was the third time this season Shockey has led the team in tackles for a game. His 67 tackles lead the Panthers this season and rank second in the Big South OVC and 32nd in the FCS. Shockey has made 40 of his tackles with solo stops with that total leading the conference and 15th in the FCS. He is averaging 8.4 tackles per game and is on pace to finish the year with 100 tackles.

- Eastern Illinois had its second straight big receiving day from the tight end position as junior college transfer Alex Herrera hauled in seven passes for 80 yards including a third quarter touchdown at UT Martin. It was just the second game this season Herrera had appeared in while it was his first reception for the Panthers. In the Oct. 12 game at Tennessee State sophomore Alex Ginnever made his first career start and caught seven passes. Ginnever added two catches on Saturday at UTM as five different receivers had receptions.
- Jacob Horvath averaged 43.4 yards per punt on Saturday at UT Martin as the sophomore from Australia continues to chase the EIU single season record for punting average. Horvath has a season average of 44.9 yards per punt which ranks him tenth in the FCS and second in the Big South OVC. He has 11 punts of more than 50 yards and another 11 punts inside the 20-yard line. The EIU single season record for punting average is 44.6 set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season.
- Julian Patino knocked home his second field goal of the season making a 19-yard kick late in the second quarter at UT Martin. Patino is 2-for-3 on field goals this year with his lone miss a 50-yard attempt at Tennessee State. In his two years as a kicker for the Panthers Patino is 5-of-6 on field goals including a perfect 5-of-5 inside 40-yards. Patino is now 7-of-7 on extra points this year and 19-of-20 for his career.
- MJ Flowers churned out 49 yards on 14 carries on Saturday at UT Martin while also catching nine passes for 53 yards. Earlier this year Flowers set the EIU single game record for receptions in a game by a running back with 11 against Southeast Missouri. He is second on the team with 38 receptions which places him seventh in the Big South OVC. The 49 yards on the ground brought Flowers EIU career total to 1,504 yards placing him 21st on the EIU career charts. He needs 22 yards to join the EIU career Top 20.
- Malik Rainey tied for the team lead in tackles at UT Martin as the nickel finished with eight tackles including six solo stops and one tackle for loss. Rainey has made five consecutive starts at the nickel position with 25 tackles and two tackles for loss in those contests. The eight tackles were a season high with his second best performance a six tackle effort against Southeast Missouri. Rainey now has 31 total tackles for the year after making just five tackles all of last season after transferring from Cincinnati.
- Christopher Sharp made his first career start at corner at UT Martin as the redshirt freshman stepped in and split time at the position with Kiwaun Davis as starter Moses Alexander has been out with injury. Sharp responded with six tackles against the Skyhawks in his first significant action of the season. Sharp had eight total tackles entering the contest with a previous high of three at Tennessee State. Last season as a true freshman Sharp appeared in four games making two tackles and a fumble recovery on special teams.
- Eastern Illinois went its second straight game without forcing a turnover in Saturday's loss at UT Martin. It marked the fourth time in eight games this season that EIU has not been able to force an opponents turnover after EIU ranked in the top five in the FCS last season in turnovers gained. This season EIU has forced eight turnovers with four of them coming in the home win over Indiana State.
- Eastern Illinois defense was held without a sack for just the second time this season as the Panthers were unable to get to the UT Martin quarterback on Saturday. The only other time that has occurred this season was in the season opener at now nationally ranked Illinois. EIU recorded a season high three sacks against Indiana State and had two sacks against Southeast Missouri. Nicholas Oliveira-Chace is the EIU leader this season with 4.5 sacks which ranks second in the Big South OVC and 53rd in the FCS.
- Eastern Illinois has won the time of possession battle in each of the last two games against Tennessee State and UT Martin after holding that advantage just once in the opening six games of the season. However, the Panthers have struggled with starting position of offensive drives compared to their opponents. Against UT Martin EIU began its offensive drives on average at its own 25 yard line compared to UTM beginning at its 40-yard line. For the season EIU has only had better starting field position than its opponent in two games holding a two-yard advantage against both Indiana State and Northwestern. For the season EIU's average starting position for drives is the 27 compared to opponents starting at the 32.
- Eastern Illinois was held under 100 yards rushing for the third straight game as the Panthers finished with 48 yards on 21 carries. EIU's season low for rushing this year was 19 yards on 21 carries against Southeast Missouri. EIU has been held below the 100-yard rushing mark as a team in six of its eight games this year with the Panthers rushing offense averaging 69.3 yards per game which is second to last in the FCS. Running back MJ Flowers has one 100-yard rushing day this season with 123 yards against Lindenwood, his fourth career 100-yard day on the ground.
- Corner NiJhay Burt is currently tied for the Big South OVC lead in interceptions with three which ranks 19th in the FCS. Burt nearly added to that total with a play on the ball at UT Martin which ended as a pass break-up for Burt. This season the converted safety to corner is third on the team with 46 tackles including 2.5 tackles for loss, five passes defended and a forced fumble.

## Eastern Illinois Returning All-Conference Players

- The injury bug has bitten the Eastern Illinois roster this season as the Panthers entered their bye week with a handful of key injuries that needed the week of rest or may be lost for the season. That trend carried over to UT Martin as now through eight weeks of the 2024 season EIU has had 22 missed games by starters on the offensive and defensive sides of the ball. On the offense the wide receiver corps has been hit the hardest with eleven missed games including six by starter DeAirious Smith. On the defensive side of the ball a total of eleven games have been missed by starters.
- Kick returner Mark Aitken entered the season with 755 career kick return yards at Eastern Illinois. He needed 53 kick return yards to move into 10th on the EIU career kick return yards chart. He has two kick returns for 15 yards this season and now needs 38 yards to crack the top ten. Aitken was a second team All-OVC selection at kick returner in 2022. He has a 21.6 yards per return average for his Panther career with a long return of 80 yards in 2022 against Northwestern State. Frank Cutolo (1998-01) currently sits in 10th place on the EIU charts with 808 career kick return yards.

#### **SEASON LONG NOTES**

- Sixth year offensive lineman Elkhanan Tanelus was nominated as EIU's candidate for the William Campbell trophy, presented to the top academic football player in the nation. Tanelus already has both a bachelor's and master's degree from EIU and is pursuing a certificate in business technology this fall.
- Eastern Illinois football will not leave the state of Illinois during its first six games of the 2024 season which includes three road games and three home games at O'Brien Field. EIU's three road contests take place at Illinois, Northwestern and Illinois State which are a combined 355 miles from the Charleston campus. EIU welcomes Indiana State, Lindenwood and Southeast Missouri to O'Brien Field for home games during those six weeks. EIU's first venture outside the Prairie State will be on Oct. 12 at Tennessee State where the Panthers will face TSU at Nissan Stadium, located 337 miles from Charleston. It is EIU's longest stretch of games played in the state to open a season since 1941 when the Panthers played all seven games of the year in the State of Illinois.
- Eastern Illinois jumps back into games with the Power Four FBS Conferences over the next several years including this season with two games against teams in the Big Ten Conference. EIU faced Illinois for the season opener and traveled to Northwestern in week three of the season. Other future FBS games on the EIU schedule include a trip to play at Alabama in 2025, Minnesota in 2026, Illinois in 2027 and Kentucky in 2028.
- The Ohio Valley Conference and Big South Conference merged into a joint conference for the sport of football last season playing its inaugural season with ten members. Gardner-Webb was the league's first champion. Conference realignment once again impacted the FCS as Bryant and Robert Morris exited the league after one season and Western Illinois joined for the 2024 season. The Big South-OVC Football Association features OVC member schools Eastern Illinois, Lindenwood, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, UT Martin and Western Illinois. The Big South is represented by Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The league announced in July 2024 that the partnership would be extended to 2030 (previous deal was to 2026) with the OVC Conference Office overseeing the day-to-day operation of the league.
- Eastern Illinois once again has several legacy players on its roster this season with offensive lineman Carson Fichtel, linebacker Jared Pilson, defensive lineman Peyton Wilkerson and the newest addition quarterback Jacob Rosenstiel. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Pilson's father Jamie was a running back for the Panthers in the early 1990's while Wilkerson's father Chris is the Panthers head coach and a former EIU defensive lineman in the 1990's. Rosenstiel's father Bob was a tight end for the Panthers in the mid-1990s going on to play briefly in the NFL for the Oakland Raiders. All four played at EIU for head coach Bob Spoo crossing over with each other at some point in their Panther careers.
- Eastern Illinois football continues to expand its reach across both the United States and Globe. EIU's roster features players from 20 different states spanning from California and Oregon on the West Coast to Massachusetts in the Northeast, Florida in the Southeast and Virginia on the East Coast. The farthest reaching Panther is punter Jacob Horvath from Australia who is returning for his second year. The last player from Australia prior to Horvath to play for the Panthers was long snapper Bryce Coulson in 2019. In recent year's EIU has had players on its roster from Canada, Finland and The Netherlands.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2024 season with five players in total selected including two who served as team captains during the 2023 season. Mark Aitken (SAF) and Tre'jon Lewis (DL) are team captains for the a second straight season. They are joined by Pierce Holley (QB), Anthony Manaves (TE) and Anthony Shockey (LB).
- Eastern Illinois football has 15 players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. This year's graduate players are Mark Aitken, Joel Barrows, Kaelin Drakeford, Pierce Holley, Jamal Jeffers, Tre'jon Lewis, Anthony Manaves, Sebastian Pares, Jerrad Price, Anthony Shockey, Joseph Solomon, Jordan Sprycha, Elkhanan Tanelus, Cooper Willman and Kendi Young.

#### EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returned home and became the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 62-46 (11-19 at EIU, 3rd year) career record. #### WESTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH JOE DAVIS

Former Eastern Illinois offensive coordinator Joe Davis is in his first season as the head coach at Western Illinois having led the Leathernecks to a 3-5 record including a 2-2 mark in the Big South OVC. Davis was the offensive coordinator on head coach Chris Wilkerson's staff for the last two years helping the team post an 8-3 record last year with running back MJ Flowers finishing as the runner-up for the Jerry Rice Award. Davis has had multiple stops as a coordinator at the FCS level with FCS playoff appearances in stops at Northern Iowa and UAlbany. He is a 2002 graduate of Adrian College and played professionally in Europe in the Arena Football League prior to coaching.

#### SCOUTING WESTERN ILLINOIS

Western Illinois has put up offensive numbers in the Big South OVC including a career passing day by Nathan Lamb last weekend at Lindenwood. The quarterback has passed for 1,954 yards and 12 touchdowns this season with Matthew Henry and Eli Aragon the top targets. Henry has 41 catches for 689 yards while Aragon has five touchdown receptions. Cameren Smith leads the ground game with 625 yards. On defense the Leathernecks are led by Ryan Crandall with 65 tackles including 7.5 tackles for loss. Jalen Riven has 5.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks.

#### THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and Western Illinois meet as conference opponents for the first time in nearly 30 years as they face off in Big South OVC action this weekend. WIU holds a 42-21-4 all-time lead in the series having won five straight and nine of the last ten. EIU's last win in the series was Nov. 4, 1995, a 20-17 win in the last meeting between the schools as Gateway Conference opponents.

#### SERIES DID YOU KNOW FACTS...

1.) Eastern Illinois and Western Illinois first played on the gridiron in during the 1930 season with EIU posting a 23-0 win. The two schools begin playing routinely during the 1934 season and faced each other nearly every season until 1996 when EIU departed for the Ohio Valley Conference. For many years prior to EIU leading the Gateway Conference, the schools played for the Mayor's Cup traveling trophy.

2.) Joe Davis is one of two former Eastern Illinois assistant coaches that has faced the Panthers this season. Davis was the EIU offensive coordinator in 2022 & 2023. The other former EIU assistant coach is Illinois State head coach Brock Spack who was an assistant at EIU in the late 1980's. EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson was also an EIU assistant coach following a playing career for the Panthers.

• Eastern Illinois will play an eight game conference schedule this season marking the first time since the 2019 season that the Panthers will play that many conference contests. Since the 2019 season, EIU has been limited to the number of conference contests due to COVID-19 in 2020 and conference realignment over the last four years. During its first season as a league the Big South OVC Football Association only scheduled six conference contests due to previous schedule conflicts with members schools. Including Eastern Illinois, five football playing members from the 2019 OVC still remain in the current Big South/OVC Association.

#### SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. EIU's longest streak of consecutive games without being shutout was 197 from 1977-1997 which ranks fourth alltime among FCS schools.

#### **OVC SUCCESS**
