

Series Record: 30-20 in favor of Austin Peay Last Meeting: Feb. 1, 2020: EIU won 76-47

The Panthers finish out their time at Lantz with a match up against the Governors of Austin Peay. In the last meeting of the teams, Eastern Illinois handled APSU with a nearly 30 point victory. In the 76-47 win, Morgan Litwiller put up a career-high 18 points shooting 60% from the field. Karle Pace put up the game-high 19 points and dished out six assists. For the Governors, they couldn't get the ball in the basket; shooting 28% on the entire game. Eastern looks to sweep Austin Peay in the season series for the first time in 8 years. Jennifer Nehls will be recognized for her contributions to EIU before the game. Karle Pace will also be recongized for her 1,000 career-points milestone.

OVC SUCCESS

Eastern has played solid thus far in conference play. The Panthers have seen plenty of growth throughout the season from top to bottom. The team has had ups and downs, but have ultimately progressed leaps and bounds. The Panthers are in the middle of the pack for seeding at the OVC tournament, and will look to make some noise in the OVC tournament in a few weeks.

THE NEXT GENERATION

The Panthers three freshman have made a huge impact on the team. Lariah Washington has been phenomenal this season. Morgan Litwiller has stepped into the role of a starter for the Panthers and has played well. Litwiller has scored double-digit points in four of the eight games she has started. Paige Schumann has gotten into 22 games so far this season and has been stellar defensively, hounding opposing guards the length of the court. Panther fans should be very excited for the years to come with Coach Bollant's team.

EASTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH MATT BOLLANT

Matt Bollant completed his second season going 11-18 overall with the Panthers. He joined EIU as the ninth head coach in program history following a five year stint as head coach at Illinois. In his first season with the Illini, Bollant led them to the post season for the first time in three years finishing with a winning Big Ten record for the first time in ten seasons. Before his time at Illinois, he was head coach at Green Bay. He guided the Phoenix to five straight Horizon League titles and had four straight trips to the NCAA tournament. While at Green Bay his record was 148-19 overall and 85-5 in the HL. He was named Horizon League Coach of the Year four times. Bollant started his head coaching career at Bryan College in 2002. He led the Lady Lions to four straight NAIA tournaments. Bollant holds a 368-211 overall record as he enters his third season. A HISTORIC PACE

Karle Pace is one of the best scorers in the OVC this season, as she has

racked up 407 points this season. She now has 1045 career points and is the 25th EIU women's basketball player to hit that mark. Pace is just a junior and will have next season to move up the record books. Pace currently sits at the 23rd spot in all-time career points, and is only 16 points away from moving up into the 22nd spot. Pace is also tied for the third spot in school history for season three pointers made with 59. She only needs one more to tie for the second spot. Pace has made a three in 17 consecutive games dating back to Dec. 20th.

SCOUTING THE GOVERNORS

The Governors leading scorer, Arielle Gonzalez-Varner, is averaging 10.5 points and 7.6 boards per- game. Austin Peay as a whole does not really have a few players that standout directly. Instead the team as a whole contributes very well to the scoring and rebounding totals. Austin Peay is not a good rebounding team, which is great for the Panthers as that has been a weakness this season. The Governors are not a good defensive team either, as they let up the highest field goal percentage to opponents in the OVC. The only issue for EIU is that the Governors live and die by the three ball. They take the seventh most threes in DI, and if they are hot, they could be a problem to play. The Panthers will want to make sure they get hands in the faces of their shooters.

SERIES HISTORY

The Governors lead the series 30-20 with the last match up being earlier this season: February 1. The Panthers won 76-47.

• Jordyn Hughes tied her career-high 24 points against Lipscomb and shot 70% from the field. Hughes got her sophomore season off with a bang and continues to be instant offense coming off of the Panthers bench.

- Karle Pace enters the top 10 in three-pointers made in school history with 123 total made over her career.
- The Panthers knocked off UT Martin shooting 54% from the field and had five players score in double digits in the 74-70 win.
- Taylor Steele returned to play against SIUE after taking five weeks off due to an illness. Steele scored a season-high 17 points against Murray State.
- Lariah Washington has been awarded the OVC Freshman of the Week four times this season. She is one of four EIU women's basketball players to receive this honor at least four times.
- Sophomore guard, Kira Arthofer has taken over the lead ball handler role since the departure of Grace Lennox. Arthofer has gotten the start in every game this season.
- Morgan Litwiller has jumped into the starting role and has put up an average of 11 points in her eight games started.
- Abby Wahl scored her career-high against Wisconsin, finishing the day with 23 points. Wahl has had a much bigger role in the offense this year.
- Claudia Stan had here biggest outing against Evansville, where she scored 12 points and 3 rebounds.
- Lariah Washington scored a career-high for any active EIU player with 35 points against Murray State, the second-most for any EIU freshman.
- Karle Pace has 1045 career points and is the 25th EIU women's basketball player to hit that mark.
- The Panthers finished the Compass Tournament in third place, along with Abby Wahl being named to the All-Tournament team.
- In Jennifer Nehls final season she has been all over the place for the Panthers. Nehls has started five game and played in all 25.
