

Series Record: Eastern Kentucky leads 20-19 Last Meeting: Jan 9. 2020, EIU won 83 - 63

The Panthers return to Lantz to battle against the Eastern Kentucky Colonels for the second time this season. In their first match up, EIU dominated EKU as they blew them out by 20 points. Eastern Kentucky has struggled all season to find their grove and have won only two games in conference play. EIU is coming off of a big win over Austin Peay last Saturday and will bring the energy to a rowdy home crowd. The Panthers will look to start a streak as this week's schedule holds two teams they have previously beaten. The Panthers will face Morehead State following Thursday's game.

OVC SUCCESS

Eastern has played solid thus far in conference play. The Panthers have seen plenty of growth throughout the season from top to bottom. The team has had ups and downs, but have ultimately progressed leaps and bounds. The Panthers are in the middle of the pack for seeding at the OVC tournament, and barring some catastrophic disaster the team will look to make some noise in the OVC tournament in a month.

THE NEXT GENERATION

The Panthers three freshman have made a huge impact on the team. Lariah Washington has been phenomenal this season. Morgan Litwiller has stepped into the role of a starter for the Panthers and has played well. She is coming off of a career-high 18 points on Saturday afternoon against Austin Peay. EASTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH MATT BOLLANT

Matt Bollant completed his second season going 11-18 overall with the Panthers. He joined EIU as the ninth head coach in program history following a five year stint as head coach at Illinois. In his first season with the Illini, Bollant led them to the post season for the first time in three years finishing with a winning Big Ten record for the first time in ten seasons. Before his time at Illinois, he was head coach at Green Bay. He guided the Phoenix to five straight Horizon League titles and had four straight trips to the NCAA tournament. While at Green Bay his record was 148-19 overall and 85-5 in the HL. He was named Horizon League Coach of the Year four times. Bollant started his head coaching career at Bryan College in 2002. He led the Lady Lions to four straight NAIA tournaments. Bollant holds a 368-211 overall record as he enters his third season.

A HISTORIC PACE

Karle Pace is one of the best scorers in the OVC this season, as she has racked up 313 points this season. She now has 951 career points and is moving ever closer to the 1,000 career point mark. Pace would be the 25th EIU women's basketball player to hit that mark. Pace is just a junior and will have next season to move up the record books. Pace is also inching towards a top 10 spot on the all time steals list. She is currently at 114 career steals and needs about 64 more to hit the mark.

SCOUTING THE COLONELS

Eastern Kentucky is back for more; this time at Lantz Arena. In the last two meetings, EIU has dominated EKU, winning both match ups by 20 points. The Colonels are likely going to push the tempo and make EIU run the same way they did a month ago. The Panthers will need to keep their composure and not get overly excited as EKU did mount a comeback late. Teri Goodlet had become the leading scorer in OVC play for the Colonels and will look for easy buckets usuing her speed. I'Liyah Green is still one of the better players on EKU and does just about everything head coach Samantha Williams has asked of her this season. Green is averaging 9 points and eight rebounds in conference play so far, and has been named the OVC Newcomer of the Week twice this season.

SERIES HISTORY

The Panthers and Colonels have faced of 39 times with the series in favor of EKU 19-20. The Panthers won the last match up 83-63.

- Jordyn Hughes tied her career-high 24 points against Lipscomb and shot 70% from the field. Hughes got her sophomore season off with a bang and continues to be instant offense coming off of the Panthers bench.
- Karle Pace is leading the Panthers in points per-game with 14.5, and the leader in steals per-game with 2.1 per-game.
- The Panthers knocked off UT Martin shooting 54% from the field and had five players score in double digits in the 74-70 win
- Grace McRae made her comeback, McRae has now played in the past six games for the Panthers and has increased her minutes since her return from injury.
- Freshman Lariah Washington has started every game for the Panthers this season. Washington has been awarded the OVC Freshman of the Week three times this season.
- Sophomore guard, Kira Arthofer has taken over the lead ball handler role since the departure of Grace Lennox. Arthofer has gotten the start in every game this season.
- Morgan Litwiller had a career night against EKU with 16 points, seven rebounds and two blocks.
- Abby Wahl scored her career-high against Wisconsin, finishing the day with 23 points. Wahl has had a much bigger role in the offense this year.
- Claudia Stan had here biggest outing against Evansville, where she scored 12 points and 3 rebounds.
- Lariah Washington scored a career-high for any active EIU player with 35 points against Murray State, the second-most for any EIU freshman.
- Karle Pace has 951 career points and is coming up on the 1,000 point mark. Pace would be the 25th EIU women's basketball player to hit that mark.
- The Panthers finished the Compass Tournament in third place, along with Abby Wahl being named to the All-Tournament team.
