

The Panthers (7-6, 1-1 OVC) are headed to Kentucky to take on the Eastern Kentucky Colonels (6-7, 0-2 OVC) on Thursday afternoon for the first game of the double header. Eastern is coming off of a loss to the pre-season champion pick Belmont, while EKU comes off of a loss to Jacksonville State. EKU has not won a game in a month, which the Panthers will look to extend even longer with a victory on Thursday. EIU is looking to start off conference play hot, after a whooping of TSU. The Panthers faltered against Belmont, but the Bruins are arguably the best team in the conference. The Panthers will want to bounce back against an opponent with a lesser record.

VETERAN SUCCESS

Eastern is having a great start to the season, seeing plenty of growth out of the returning players. Wahl has taken huge steps this season. Coach Matt Bollant has ran the offense through Wahl in the post who has produced for the Panthers more often than not. Taylor Steele has been the definition of consistent for EIU this season, scoring the ball when she's been asked to and turning into one of the better rebounders on the team. Pace has also come up big for the Panthers, scoring in isolation with ease and forming one of the better pick and roll tandems with Wahl. Pace is on fire starting conference play



EASTERN ILLINOIS HEAD COACH MATT BOLLANT

Matt Bollant completed his second season going 11-18 overall with the Panthers. He joined EIU as the ninth head coach in program history following a five year stint as head coach at Illinois. In his first season with the Illini, Bollant led them to the post season for the first time in three years finishing with a winning Big Ten record for the first time in ten seasons. Before his time at Illinois, he was head coach at Green Bay. He guided the Phoenix to five straight Horizon League titles and had four straight trips to the NCAA tournament. While at Green Bay his record was 148-19 overall and 85-5 in the HL. He was named Horizon League Coach of the Year four times. Bollant started his head coaching career at Bryan College in 2002. He led the Lady Lions to four straight NAIA tournaments. Bollant holds a 368-211 overall record as he enters his third season.

THE GAME PLAN

The Panthers are the number one scoring defense in the OVC as of now, which could spell disaster for EKU. Eastern will have to continue to dominate defensively to defeat EKU and to make sure they don't fall to a losing record in conference play. Karle Pace has been on a heater as of late, and will look to remain on a tear as one of the best scorers in the OVC. All three of the freshman will also want to continue to improve as they move into bigger roles for EIU. The Panthers have one of the best defenses in the conference and will need to capitalize on the opponents mistakes to score easy buckets.

SCOUTING THE COLONELS

The Eastern Kentucky Colonels are coming off of a four-game losing streak that the Panthers will look to push to five. The Colonels do not have a player who is averaging double-digit points per-game, however their number one scorer Bria Bass is averaging 9.8 points. The Colonels have a lot of players that can make a difference on their team, and not one in particular really pops off the stat sheet. I'Liyah Green looks to be a force on the boards as she averages nearly seven rebounds a game. The Panthers will want to stay in control of the game at all times and force EKU to take tough shots in this game.

SERIES HISTORY

The Panthers and Colonels have faced of 38 times with the series tied at 19 victories a piece. The Panthers won the last match up 80-60.

- Jordyn Hughes tied her career-high 24 points against Lipscomb and shot 70% from the field. Hughes got her sophomore season off with a bang and continues to be instant offense coming off of the Panthers bench.
- Karle Pace is leading the Panthers in assists per-game with 2.8, and steals per-game with 2.2 per-game.
- The Panthers shot 43.9% from the field and 30% from deep against Tennessee State.
- Taylor Steele snagged a career-high 13 rebounds against Lipscomb. Steele is averaging 4.9 rebounds per-game, which is the third most for the Panthers.
- Freshman Lariah Washington has started every game for the Panthers this season. Washington had her break-out game versus Loyola-Chicago, scoring 14 points and grabbing 6 rebounds.
- Sophomore guard, Kira Arthofer has taken over the lead ball handler role since the departure of Grace Lennox. Arthofer has gotten the start in every game this season.
- Each of EIU's freshman players have seen time on the court this season. Morgan Litwiller scored a career-high 9 points against UNO, and Paige Schumann put up her career-high, 7 pts, against Tennessee State.
- Abby Wahl scored her career-high against Wisconsin, finishing the day with 23 points. Wahl is leading the Panthers in points per-game with 13.7, and 6.0 rebounds per-game for the Panthers.
- Claudia Stan had here biggest outing against Evansville, where she scored 12 points and 3 rebounds.
- Lariah Washington recorded her first career double-double against UIC, recording 17 pts and 12 rebs.
- Three Panthers are averaging double-digit points this season. Taylor Steele (10.5), Karle Pace (13.5) and Abby Wahl (13.2).
- The Panthers finished the Compass Tournament in third place, along with Abby Wahl being named to the All-Tournament team.
